आठ पार्किंग और एक ऑटो स्टैंड की व्यवस्था करेगा नगर निगम

गाजियाबाद : शहर के कई इलाकों में जाम की समस्या खत्म करने के लिए नगर निगम पार्किंग और ऑटो स्टैंड की व्यवस्था करने जा रहा है। अगले सप्ताह पार्किंग के ठेके छोडे जाएंगे। श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी पार्क, यशोदा अस्पताल नेहरूनगर, सरस्वती शिशु मंदिर के क्रीड़ा स्थल से गणेश अस्पताल, पुरानी सब्जी मंडी, नवयुग मार्केट स्थित इलाहाबाद बैंक के बाहर, तुलसी निकेतन भोपुरा, अराधना से अप्सरा बॉर्डर और वसुंधरा जोन के कृ ष्णा वाटिका में पार्किंग का इंतजाम किया जा रहा है।

स्वतंत्रता दिवस पर दो बंदियों को मिली आजादी

गाजियाबाद : डासना ऐसे जिला कारागार में स्वतंत्रता दिवस के अवसर पर दो बंदियों को रिहा किया गया। दोनों ने सजा पूरा कर ली थी, लेकिन जुर्माने की राशि का भुगतान न कर पाने के कारण अतिरिक्त सजा पूरी कर रहे थे। जेल अधीक्षक विपिन कुमार मिश्रा ने बताया कि शासन ने पूरे प्रदेश की देवों से 73 बंदियों को रिहा करने का आदेश दिया था। गाजियाबाद जेल में बंद विजयनगर की माता कॉलोनी निवासी सागर लूट के मुकदमे और शाहजहांपुर के निगोही थानाक्षेत्र के जिन्हापुर गांव निवासी नन्हें गैंगस्टर के मामले में सजा पूरी करने के बाद भी जेल में बंद थे।

साहिबाबाद : रोटरी क्लब ऑफ इंदिरापुरम गैलोर ने मंगलवार को वसुंधरा सेक्टर—12 में पौधारोपण किया। इस दौरान कनेर, अर्जुन, अशोक, बेल पत्थर के 8 पौधे लगाए गए। क्लब ने पौधों की देखरेख का भी संकल्प लिया। रोटरी क्लब ऑफ इंदिरापुरम गैलोर के चार्टर प्रेजीडेंट डा.धीरज भार्गव ने बताया कि रोटरी क्लब द्वारा अब तक वसुंधरा सेक्टर—12 व परमानंद वाटिका में करीब 60 पौधे लगाए जा चुके है। इसके साथ ही इनकी देखरेख भी रोटरी क्लब द्वारा की जा रही है। उन्होंने कहा कि वसुंधरा क्षेत्र में बढ़ रहे प्रदूषण को कम करने के लिए सभी को एक-एक पौधा जरूर लगाना चाहिए। जिससे लोगों को शुद्ध वातावरण मिल सकें। वहीं क्लब की पूर्व अध्यक्ष मनीषा भार्गव ने भी लोगों से अधिक से अधिक

पौधे लगाने का अनुरोध किया। अपूर्व राज ने बताया कि शहरीकरण और बढती हुई आबादी के साथ हमारे घर छोटे और घने होते जा रहे है। घर ऐसा होना चाहिए जिसमे आरपार वायु संचार की व्यवस्था हो। आसपास बिल्डिंगों

का जंगल और पेडों का अभाव के कारण शुद्ध खुली ताजी हवा से हम वंचित हो गए है। एयर कंडीशनर लगे कमरों में बंद हम खुली हवा की महक भूल सी गए है। यह बंद-बंद सी हवा हमारे स्वास्थ्य के लिए नुकसानदेह होती जा रही है जो सांस से संबंधित रोगों, एलर्जी, सरदर्द, थकान और अन्य बीमारियों को जन्म दे रही है। इसके अतिरिक्त हमारे रोज के रहन सहन में ऐसी चीजे भी है जो घरो की हवा में विषेले तत्व और गैस धीरे धीरे छोडती रहती है। फार्में ल्डीहाइड. डाई-ऑक्साईड, कार्बन मोनो ऑक्साईड, बेंजीन, नाइट्रोजन ऑक्साईड ऐसी विषैली गैसें है, जो सेहत के लिए हानिकारक है। प्लास्टिक के सामान, मच्छर कोकरोच मारने वाले स्प्रे, वार्निश, नए कालीन, एयर फ्रैशनर आदि में केमिकल पाए जाते है जो हमारे घरो को विषैला कर रहे है। इनसे बचने का उपाय घरो में लगातार साफ हवा का संचार ही है। पौधारोपण में अपूर्व राज, रिंकी रॉड, सविता, इंद्रेश आदि ने सहयोग किया।

गाजियाबाद : महानगर के ट्रांस वीके सिंह के यहां हुई मीटिंग में उठती रही है। शासन से ट्रांस हिंडन क्षेत्र के लिए एक संयुक्त अस्पताल की मंजूरी भी काफी पहले ही मिल चुकी है, लेकिन जमीन न मिलने के कारण अस्पताल की स्थापना नहीं हो पा रही थी। अब खोड़ा नगर पालिका डेढ़ एकड़ जमीन उपलब्ध कराने के लिए राजी हो गई है। मुख्य चिकित्सा अधिकारी ने बताया कि खोड़ा में प्रस्तावित संयुक्त जिला अस्पताल 50 बेड का होगा। मुख्य चिकित्सा अधि ाकारी डा. एनके गुप्ता ने शनिवार को बताया कि स्थानीय सांसद केंद्रीय विदेश राज्य मंत्री जनरल

हिंडन क्षेत्र में काफी समय से खोड़ा नगर पालिका डेढ़ एकड़ बडे सरकारी अस्पताल की मांग जमीन उपलब्ध कराने को राजी हो गई है। सीएमओ ने बताया कि ढाई एकड़ जमीन की मांग रखी थी, लेकिन नगर पालिका के पास केवल डेढ एकड जमीन उपलब्ध है। उन्होंने कहा कि इतनी जमीन पर भी संयुक्त जिला अस्पताल बन जाएगा। खोड़ा कालोनी में ही साढे तीन लाख से अधिक की आबादी है। यह क्षेत्र सघन आबादी वाला है और यहां काफी संख्या में मजदूर और मेहनतकश तबके के लोग रहते हैं। इसके अलावा मकनप्र, इंदिरापुरम, वैशाली और कौशांबी में रहने वालों के लिए खोड़ा काफी नजदीक पडेगा।

गाजियाबाद : प्रताप विहार स्थित न्यू रेनबो पब्लिक स्कूल में बुधवार को संकल्प स्वास्थ्य जागरूकता अभियान व रोटरी क्लब ऑफ गाजियाबाद मेट्रो द्वारा अशोक, बेल पत्थर, कनेर, अर्जुन के 15 पौधे लगाए गए और पर्यावरण संरक्षण का संदेश दिया। इस दौरान पौधों की देखभाल का भी संकल्प लिया। आरएचएएम (संकल्प स्वास्थ्य जागरूकता अभियान) के चेयर डा.धीरज कुमार भार्गव ने कहा कि पौधारोपण बहुत जरूरी है। यदि पर्यावरण सुरक्षित रहेगा तो हम भी सुरक्षित रहेंगे। वृक्ष, वातावरण मे फैली दूषित वायु को शुद्ध करता है। वर्षा ऋतु में वर्षा वायु को रोकता है, जिससे वर्षा की संभावना अधिक होती है। वृक्ष अपनी जड़ों मे मिट्टी को बांधकर रखता है, जिससे मृदा अपरदन नहीं होता है। वृक्ष अपने आसपास के वातावरण (दूषित वायु की स्वच्छता) के साथ साथ भूमि को भी ठंडा रखता है, वर्तमान मे सबसे बड़ी मुसीबत ग्लोबल वार्मिंग की समस्या से कम से कम थोड़ी ही सही पर राहत जरुर दिलायेगा। इन सब फायदों के अलावा यदि वृक्षारोपण एक क्रम मे किया जाये तो सुन्दरता की झलक प्रदर्शित करता है। विभिन्न वृक्षों की छाल, बीज, फल. पत्ते कई प्रकार की दवाइयों मे उपयोग किये जाते है जैसे नीम के पत्तो





को पानी मे उबालकर नहाने से शरीर के रोग दूर होते है, इसी प्रकार उसकी डालियां दातुन के रूप मे उपयोग की जाती है, यह एक आयुर्वेदिक औषधि है। रोटरी क्लब ऑफ गाजियाबाद मेट्रो के अध्यक्ष अंशुल जैन ने बताया कि पेड़-पोधे कार्बन डाइऑक्साइड और ऑक्सीजन का आदान-प्रदान करते हैं। वायु में घुले हुए प्रदूषण को कम करते है। जिससे पर्यावरण शुद्ध होता है। उन्होंने कहा कि





हमारा दायित्व सिर्फ पौधे लगाना गुलशन थापर, तरूण, अपूर्व राज, नहीं, बल्कि उसे बचाना भी होना रोशन सिंह, न्यू रेनबो पब्लिक चाहिए। इस दौरान सभी ने पौधों के देखभाल की भी शपथ ली। इस दौरान रोटरी क्लब ऑफ गाजियाबाद मेट्रो के सैकेटरी

स्कूल की डायरेक्टर मुनीषी अग्रवाल, चेयरमैन कैलाश अग्रवाल, प्रधानाचार्या रूचि अग्रवाल आदि ने भी पौधरोपण किया।

महामाया स्पोर्ट्स स्टेडियम के पीछे 28 एकड़ में बनेगा पार्क

गाजियाबाद : महामाया स्पोर्ट्स स्टेडियम के पीछे 28 एकड़ भूमि पर पार्क विकसित करने पर मंथन शुरू हो गया है। यह प्रस्ताव 19 अगस्त को होने वाली कार्यकारिणी बैठक में रखा जाएगा। जीडीए ने यहां पार्क बनाने का डिजाइन कई साल पहले तैयार कर लिया था। लेकिन नगर निगम तैयार नहीं हो रहा था। जीडीए इस भूमि पर राजनगर एक्सटेंशन के सिटी फॉरेस्ट की तर्ज पर पिकनिक स्पॉट बनाना चाहता था। इसके लिए जीडीए के उद्यान विभाग ने तीन साल पहले मानचित्र भी तैयार किया था। योजना थी कि बीच में झील और चारों ओर पैदल पथ बनाया जाएगा। नौका विहार की योजना भी थी। झील के आसपास लोगों के बैठने की व्यवस्था योजना का हिस्सा थी। एक लाख से ज्यादा

पौधे लगाने पर विचार हुआ था। इस योजना पर नगर निगम ने पानी फेर दिया था। अब नगर निगम की कार्यकारिणी में जीडीए की मदद से यहां पार्क बनाने का प्रस्ताव रखा जाएगा। विजय नगर क्षेत्र में हाउस टैक्स चोरी का मुद्दा कार्यकारिणी बैठक में उठेगा। नगर निगम की भूमि पर अवैध कब्जे होने, नाले की सफाई ठीक से न होने, नाला ढक कर वाणिज्यिक गतिविधि के लिए दी गई अनुमति को निरस्त करने, शूटिंग खिलाड़ी शिवम त्यागी को दस लाख रुपये आर्थिक सहायता देने, बड़े कारखानों और प्रतिष्टानों के कर्मचारियों की गाडियों के लिए पार्किंग बनाने और उनसे शुल्क वसूलने, बायोरेमेडिएशन से गंदा पानी साफ कर पेड़ों में देने समेत 41 प्रस्ताव कार्यकारिणी बैठक में रखे जा रहे हैं।

EDITORIAL

Knee-jerk: On Pakistan expelling Indian envoy

Pakistan's decision to expel India's High Commissioner. snap trade relations and observe August 15 as a black day in supposed solidarity with the people of Jammu & Kashmir is a serious setback for diplomatic relations. Wednesday's announcements appear to be a knee-jerk reaction to the mounting pressures on the Pakistani establishment to respond to India's executive-legislative actions that whittle down Article 370. Pakistan has consistently described chief ministers of Jammu & Kashmir as "puppets" and never recognised the legitimacy of the government in Srinagar. Its sudden concerns about India's actions in its own territory are reflective of muddled confusion. Ironically, this is the first time Islamabad has articulated that Article 370 was aligned with the interests of the Kashmiri people. Every Pakistani government and the country's permanent establishment have continued to peddle the myth that they could unilaterally alter the status quo in J&K. Now, they feel compelled to respond to the expectations that they have themselves raised in Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. Sections of Indian civil society have legitimate concerns about the actions of the BJP Government in emptying out Article 370 and the continuing lockdown of the Valley, but this does not license Pakistan to interfere in what the MEA correctly described on Thursday as India's internal matter.

In the days to come, India can expect Pakistan to raise the Kashmir issue at the United Nations, mobilise the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation and send envoys to friendly capitals. India is well placed to deal with Pakistan on the diplomatic front given the changed international context. India's economic clout has grown enormously in the last couple of decades, and given doubts in the Western world about Pakistan's overt and covert support to Islamist terror, New Delhi has the space to deal with Islamabad's efforts to "internationalise" the Kashmir issue. Downgrading diplomatic relations between troubled neighbours is never a good idea. Neither is snapping trade and transport links. India withdrew its High Commissioner to Pakistan after the 2001 Parliament attack, but chose not to send back the Pakistani envoy at the time. However, the Pakistani High Commissioner was expelled by India after the Kaluchak terror strike in 2002. It's interesting to note that despite all the troubles the two countries have had, High Commissioners have been able to return to their jobs since full diplomatic relations were restored in 1976. In fact, even after the 2001 Parliament attack, India and Pakistan managed to have their High Commissioners back in place by March 2003. Diplomacy is a mechanism to ensure that channels of communication remain open. While India and Pakistan have used back channels in recent years, the presence of seasoned diplomats in Delhi and Islamabad has always benefited the two countries. Pakistan needs to comprehend this. -By Dr. Dheeraj Kumar Bhargava

An official of South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) confirmed there was a provision of charging 10 times the toll as fine. "Vimal called up his employer and asked him to come to the spot with the money. But the owner of the truck apparently told him to request the bouncers to let him go just by paying the original tax amount," Pandey said. The

Concrete dividers to replace iron grilles on Noida entry road

NOIDA: Nearly a month after the UP government launched the initiative to curb eveteasing, about 200 men found loitering around schools, colleges and public places in the district have been handed a 'red card' as a warning while eight others were sent to jail. For the implementation of the drive, 21 teams of 5 members each were formed in each of the police stations across the district. Each team is led by a sub-inspector and included two male and two female constables. TBC analysed the red card distribution data from several police stations. It also spoke to women constables who are part of the 'anti-Romeo' squads at Dadri and Sector 58 police stations that issued the most cards in the last one month. From inputs received from 500 feedback forms collected from schools and colleges, the squad in Dadri marked 17 points, including Ghanshyam Road, Vishal Mandir to Jarcha Road, outside Vaidik Kanya School, outside Suraj Band at Railway road. Similarly, the sector 58 police station identified 24 points from 400 feedback forms — Mamura bus stand, D park, Labour Chowk, Sector 62 metro station, outside Stellar IT Park, TOT mall road, outside Vanasthali School,

among others. Priti (24), a woman constable in Dadri, said that she has also been at the receiving end of teasing and objectification by men, and most of the time, she has ignored it fearing backlash and police inquiry. "I believe all women experience ugly behaviour by men but choose to ignore it. With the launch of red cards, we have been asked to not just patrol in these spots, but also stay there in plainclothes to observe the activities of men," said Priti. Priti, who has been working with UP police since 2016, in lives a rented accommodation near the police station. When asked how feedback from women had helped, she said, "It helped us in getting the exact timing of when these men were loitering in the area. Most women wrote about certain road stretches and paan joints where these men would stop and wait till school gets over." She added that one of the women also complained about her family members in the form. "We keep the names anonymous. Once a woman said that she was being stalked by her own brother-in-law who lived elsewhere, and that he passed comments when she would walk to the auto stand.

Ghaziabad gets land for waste plant, finally

GHAZIABAD: Efforts to build a waste-to-energy plant at Galand have received a major boost as the Ghaziabad Development Authority finally has the 14 acres of land it needed. Twelve farmers have agreed to part with their land at a mutually agreed upon rate, officials said. Last year, an NGT committee on solid waste management had barred the Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation from dumping waste at Pratap Vihar. Now, with the GDA having got the land, work on the plant is likely to start soon, officials said. "After a long hunt, we have managed to find the rest of the land that is

required for setting up the waste to energy plant in Galand," said Kanchan Verma, the GDA vicechairperson. "Of the 35 acres required, we were already in possession of 18 acres and now, we have managed to convince 12 farmers to part with 14 acres. The remaining three acres will be provided by builders from integrated townships," Verma added. Earlier, a rate committee had been set up to decide on the price at which the 14 acres would be acquired from farmers. "The panel had fixed a rate of Rs 2,550/sqm and the price had been agreed upon by the farmers.

Door-to-door collection of waste in 3 more villages

NOIDA: The Noida Authority extended the door-to-door waste collection to Badauli, Yakubpur and Gurjar dairy villages in Noida on Sunday. So far, AG Enviro Pvt Ltd, the private agency roped in by the Noida Authority has covered about 107 sectors, 55 villages and 82 group housing societies. Out of these, segregated waste collection, which was introduced in 20 sectors in July, continues. 'Villages falling under work circle 10 were covered today (Sunday) under door-to-door waste collection," said Rajesh Kumar Singh, officer on special duty (OSD) at the Noida

Authority. Even as residents complain lack of civic amenities in garbage disposal, Singh maintained that waste collection is expanding across the city along with adequate infrastructure support. "We have provided adequate infrastructure, including vehicles for waste collection, manpower and facility for waste disposal. The agency is deploying its manpower and machinery as and how work is expanding," he said. He further added that on August 17, another workshop on bulk waste generators will be held for high rise apartments, malls and restaurants.

Noida businessman, lodged in Meerut jail for Rs 57 crore tax evasion, flees from AIIMS

MEERUT: Manoj Kumar Arora, a businessman from Noida who has been in Meerut jail since 2017 following his arrest in a Rs 57 crore tax fraud case, escaped from police custody while he was undergoing treatment at AIIMS in Delhi. Arora, owner of Greater Noida-based Poorvai Pan Masala Pvt. Ltd. was arrested by Central Excise Commissionerate, Noida, for evading taxes to the tune of Rs 57 crore in April 2017. Meerut IG (Range) Alok Singh confirmed the development claiming that a manhunt has been launched. "A probe has been set up at the SSP level. Anyone found guilty of dereliction of duty will be severely dealt with as per the law," the IG said. Arora, along with three policemen from Meerut police lines, had left for AIIMS on Friday morning. Police were intimated about Arora's escape on Saturday morning. "All the three cops accompanying the jail inmate have been suspended," the IG said. According to sources in the police department, Arora, ever since his arrest, has been consistently under medical observation due to obesity and related cardiac problems. "He also used his treatment as cover for revelry while commuting to and fro from jail and hospital," a source said.

Currently an undertrial, Arora had hit the headlines five months after his arrest in 2017 when a video clip purportedly showing Arora partying with cops, who accompanied him to AIIMS from Meerut jail, went viral on social media. There have been several daring escapes by undertrials and convicted felons from police custody in Meerut zone this year. Dreaded gangster Badan Singh Baddo had escaped from a Meerut hotel with the help of his associates in March this year after the police team escorting him from Fatehgarh central jail to Ghaziabad court took a detour and landed in

Meerut. This was followed by another dreaded UP gangster Rohit Saandu escaping from police custody Muzaffarnagar after his associates attacked a police team which had brought Saandu to Muzaffarnagar for court hearing from Mirzapur jail on July 2. A police subinspector was fatally injured in the attack while Saandu managed to escape. He was later killed in an encounter with Muzaffarnagar police. In Sambhal, three jail inmates killed two cops and escaped from prison van in July. While one of the outlaws was killed in encounter, two are still at large.



2 posing as scribe, food inspector extort money in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: Police have arrested two men for allegedly posing as a journalist and a food inspector to extort money from a confectioner in Ghaziabad's Indirapuram area. The arrested persons have been identified as Sunil Kumar from Vijay Nagar and Sanjay Singh from Chipyana. Rakesh Mishra, circle officer, Sahibabad said the accused threatened the confectioner by conducting a fake raid at his shop. Deepak Sharma, SHO of Indirapuram told TBC that a confectioner who runs a shop in Shakti Khand area

filed a police complaint. The victim told police that on Saturday morning, nearly half a dozen people reached his shop and told him that one of them is a food inspector while others are from media. "After collecting food samples from his shop, the accused threatened him and demanded Rs 20,000. Suspecting the entire ordeal to be wrond, the victim gathered other shopkeepers and got hold of two of the accused, while four others managed to flee. They then handed the duo to police," Sharma added.

Toll bouncers beat trucker to death

NOIDA: A Noida truck driver who had entered Delhi without paying toll at the new Yamuna bridge in Kalindi Kunj was allegedly beaten to death by seven bouncers hired by the booth operator on Friday night. The body of the victim, Vimal Tiwari (40), a resident of Wazidpur area, was found the next morning on the Noida-Delhi carriageway of the road, around 500 metres from the toll booth. Police said Vimal was carrying a consignment of electrical equipment to Delhi. The toll plaza is managed by Maharashtra-based MEP.

Kavi Nagar: 67-year-old shoots self in his friend's office

GHAZIABAD: A 67-yearold man allegedly committed suicide by shooting himself in the head in his friend's office in Kavi Nagar's Loha Mandi area on Saturday evening. Police claimed to have recovered a suicide note from the pocket of his shirt. The body has been sent for an autopsy. A resident of Patel Nagar, Kailash Chand Baweja ran a microfinance business in Ghaziabad. He is survived by his wife Kamlesh, son Gagan daughter-in-law Geetanjali. Gagan, who owns a garment shop in Ghaziabad,

said his father used to work in the construction sector, but shifted to financing business two years ago after meeting with a road accident in which he had received head injuries. "My father left home around 2pm on his two-wheeler. He told my mother that he is going to my shop." Kailash Chand did go to his son's shop around 3pm, but left after an hour. "He told me that he is going to meet his friend," Gagan said. Shlok Kumar, SP (city), said police got the information about the incident around 6pm and soon a team rushed to the spot.

Ask Noida for parking lots: Official to cops

NOIDA: The additional chief secretary (home) has observed that cases of vehicle theft and cybercrime were on the rise in Noida and other areas and asked police to nudge the Noida Authority on providing proper parking space to residents. The senior official also directed the cops to ask the Authority to make available land for two proposed police stations in Sector 142 and Phase I areas. Awanish Awasthi made the observations during a late night inspection of Sector 20 police station. He instructed cops to find out why vehicle thefts and cases of cybercrime were on the rise in the area.

Road squatters to be removed from Raj Nagar Extension

GHAZIABAD: Officials of the Ghaziabad Development Authority (GDA) have been pulled up its vice-chairman over rampant encroachments on both sides of Meerut bypass in Raj Nagar Extension. Junior engineers have been directed to take immediate action and also ensure that the encroachers, especially food and vegetable vendors, do not return, sources said. "During a plantation drive in Raj Nagar Extension area on August 3, GDA VC Kanchan Verma expressed her displeasure over the encroachments and directed officials concerned to initiate action against the squatters. This is because

roads in Raj Nagar Extension will be developed as 'model roads' and the squatters are responsible for traffic jams in the area," a source said. Officials have been directed to make public announcements asking violators to remove encroachments on their own. Moreover, they are required to prepare a list of people who have made permanent encroachments and initiate legal action against them under the provisions of the Urban Planning and Development Act. "GDA officials have also been directed to coordinate with the traffic police and ensure their presence between 3 pm and 6 pm on the road every day. Two cranes have been given at their disposal to tow away vehicles parked illegally on roadsides," sources said. Residents said in absence of proper monitoring, encroachers do not pay much heed and start setting up shops on roadsides within a few days of their removal. Meanwhile, Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation has issued notices to recover parking charges from 14 establishments, mainly automobile showrooms, furniture showrooms, and a cinema hall in Sahibabad Site 4 and Link Road. Recently, **GMC** commissioner Dinesh Chandra had got a survey done in the area.

Woman jumps to death from GIP food court

NOIDA: A 50-year-old woman allegedly committed suicide by jumping from the third floor of The Great India Place (TGIP) mall in Sector 38A in Noida on Saturday night. Police said Kiran Kundu, who lived with her family in Sector 93, had to come to the mall alone and jumped over the railing of the food court on the third floor around 8.45 pm. She was rushed to a nearby private hospital where doctors declared her brought dead. "We reached the spot as soon as we got a call from an eyewitness and rushed her to Kailash Hospital. Her family was informed and the body has been sent for an autopsy," said Rajesh Sharma, SHO of Sector 39 police station.

Ghaziabad teen alleges sexual assault bid by biker

GHAZIABAD: A 19-yearold man has filed a police complaint against a person who allegedly tried to sexually assault him on Thursday evening. An FIR has been filed in the case. Police said the teenager works with a private company in Ghaziabad. According to his complaint, on Thursday evening, he had been waiting for a bus at Modi Nagar junction to go to office when the incident took place. "Suddenly, a man, aged around 25 years, came on a bike and offered me a lift. As I was getting late, I accepted the

offer. After about five minutes, he stopped his motorcycle at a shop for water. There is gave me a drink laced with some sedatives. I had it and then started our journey. But after sometime, lost consciousness. He took me to a secluded place at Raj Nagar Extension area and tried to force himself on me," said the man. "When I came to, I found myself in that area and somehow managed to escape. I returned to my house after taking an auto-rickshaw and narrated the incident to my family members," he added.

Two business graduates from Allahabad cheat 200 of Rs 5 crore, held

LUCKNOW: Two youths from Allahabad, holding BBA degrees, amassed Rs 5 crore by convincing at least 200 people from UP and Delhi into investing in various fake schemes and projects over a period of seven months. A special task force of UP Police arrested Shubham Mishra and Pankaj Kumar, both in their late twenties, from Noida on Saturday. The two had opened a call centre in Sector-6, Noida, in January this year to trap victims from Delhi, Lucknow, Hardoi, Sitapur, Unnao, Kanpur and Allahabad.

Two criminals arrested after separate encounters with police in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: Two criminals carrying rewards on their arrest have been nabbed after separate encounters with police here, in which both of them and a constable sustained bullet wounds, police said on Saturday. A gunfight broke out in the Kavi Nagar police station area on Saturday when two bike-borne suspects opened fire at police on being signalled to stop near the Double Overhead Water Tanks, senior superintendent of police Sudhir Kumar Singh said. Head constable Pankaj sustained a bullet shot injury, following which the police party returned fire, officials said. One of the identified suspects,

Dharmendra, alias Tindi, was injured in the police fire and arrested, while the other managed to flee, they said. Dharmendra, a native of Bharatpur in Rajasthan, was wanted in a dacoity and a dozen other criminal cases. He was carrying a reward of Rs 50,000 on his arrest, police said. Another encounter took place around 9 pm on Friday in Loni police station area, they said. Two people on a scooty opened fire on a police party on being asked to stop for checking and fled the spot, the officials said. Police gave the duo a chase and fired in retaliation, injuring one of the miscreants who was arrested.
