# मुख्य आयकर आयुक्त आयकर परिसर का शिलान्यास

गाजियाबाद : आयकर विभाग को सीसीआइटी रजनीकांत गुप्त ने कार्यालय के रूप में सात मंजिला ग्रीन बिल्डिंग मिलेगी, जिसमें लिए होंगी। हापुड़ चुंगी स्थित सीजीओ कांप्लेक्स–1 के पीछे रिथत 1.22 एकड़ जमीन पर बनने वाली इमारत पर बाउंड्री का काम पूरा कर लिया गया है। बुधवार को मुख्य आयकर आयुक्त रजनीकांत गुप्त ने यहां आयकर कार्यालय परिसर के भूमि पूजन के बाद शिलान्यास किया। इस दौरान प्रधान आयकर आयुक्त आनंद शरण और उप आयकर आयुक्त( मुख्यालय) प्रमोद कुमार, अतिरिक्त आयकर आयुक्त (मुख्यालय) निहार रंजन पांडेय समेत आयकर विभाग के समस्त अधिकारी व कर्मचारी मौजूद रहे।

बताया कि कब्जा मिलने के बाद एस्टीमेट तैयार किया जा रहा बेसमेंट की दो मंजिल पार्किंग के है। करीब 70 करोड़ रुपये की लागत से सात मंजिला इमारत तैयार होगी। इसमें आयकर के प्रशासन, अपील व जांच समेत सभी विभाग एक साथ अपना काम कर सकेंगे। पार्किंग के लिए बेसमेंट की दो मंजिल होंगी। उन्होंने बताया कि यह बिल्डिंग पूरी तरह ग्रीन होगी, जिसमें सभी मानकों को पूरा किया जाएगा। एस्टीमेट लगभग पूरा हो चुका है, जल्द ही इसे शासन को भेजा जाएगा।मुख्य आयकर आयुक्त रजनीकांत गुप्त का कहना है कि आयकर विभाग के पास अपना कार्यालय नहीं होने से दो अलग भवनों में अधिकारी बैठते हैं।

# Up to 40% rebate on circle rate for setting up edu institutions

**GHAZIABAD**: Circle rates for 2018-19 have come into effect in Ghaziabad there has been no change except for few corrections in certain areas. While the 5% rebate on rainwater harvesting has been abolished, up to 40% rebate on plots has been offered for setting up educational institutions in the city. "From this financial year (2018-19), we are offering rebate on plots for establishing educational institutions, which will be under two slots," said Ritu Maheshwari, district magistrate of Ghaziabad. The two slots are 30% rebate on plots having an area between 1,000 sq m and 20,000 sq m,

and 40% on plots with an area of over 20,000 sq m. Earlier the rebate was under four slots between 10% and 30% on plots for the same purpose measuring between 1000 sq m and 20,000 sqm. "By offering rebates under parameters, we have tried to standardize the circle rate for educational institutions, hoping that it would give impetus to making Ghaziabad an educational hub of the region," said Maheshwari. The DM also said that the district has "abolished 5% rebate on rainwater harvesting because it was offered to encourage people to voluntarily go for it."

सपोर्ट की जानकारी होना जरूरी है। ऐसी स्थिति में सबसे पहले बेहोश हुए छात्र को हवा मिलनी चाहिए। इसके बाद एंबुलेंस को फोन कर बुलानी चाहिए। कई बार सभी बच्चे बेहोश को घेरकर खड़े हो जाते है। जिससे छात्र को सांस लेने में और दिक्कत पैदा हो जाती है। मैक्स अस्पताल के निलेश ने सेमिनार को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि आज की भागदौड़ भरी जिंदगी में बेसिक लाइफ सपोर्ट के बारे में सभी को जानकारी होनी चाहिए। यदि आपको इसके बारे में जानकारी है तो आप हार्टअटैक या दुर्घटना होने पर किसी की भी जान बचा सकते हो। वहीं मैक्स अस्पताल के रोशन सिंह ने डम्मी के माध्यम से छात्रों को बे सिक लाइफ सपोर्ट की जानकारी दी और छात्रों ने भी इसे करके दिखाया। वहीं एजी सुनील गौतम ने कहा कि दुर्घटना होने पर मरीज के लिए एक—एक पल कीमती होता है। एक मिनट की देरी होने पर मरीज के बचने की संभावना दस प्रतिशत कम

# **Vote-banks and foreigners**

**Opposition** parties have sensed a chance after the release of the final draft of the NRC. Every attempt is being made to create a crisis where none exists. However, it is grossly premature to speculate on the future of those identified as illegal immigrants. Religion, region and caste have always affected politics but governance should be above such considerations. A perfectly legitimate exercise by the Assam government, under the Assam Accord, has precipitated condemnable reaction from the Opposition parties. The Congress and its president, Rahul Gandhi must make its stand clear on the issue of illegal migrants from neighbouring countries. Both Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi had committed that immigrants to Assam after March 25, 1971, would be detected, identified and deported. The Congress had agreed to the NRC. But the party did nothing in this respect when it held office at the Centre or in Assam because the immigrants are mostly Muslims and the party has cultivated this community as its vote bank.

The Congress also tried to subvert the Foreigners Act 1946 through the Illegal Migrant Determination by Tribunal (IMDT) Act, 1983. The IMDT Act was stuck down by the Supreme Court in 2005. The Court's verdict came in response to a petition filed by Assam's current Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal. The court noted that the IMDT "is the main impediment or barrier in the identification and deportation of illegal migrants". The Congress's conduct in the affair requires close scrutiny. In an affidavit filed before the Supreme Court on August 28, 2000, the then Asom Gana Parishad (AGP)-led government pointed out that it had been asking the Centre to repeal the IMDT Act because the law was against national interest. In May 2001, the AGP was defeated in elections to the Assam Assembly and a Congressled government assumed office. On August 8, 2001, the new government moved an application in the apex court praying that the state be permitted to withdraw the earlier affidavit and be allowed to file a new affidavit. The application stated that "the IMDT Act is constitutional and there is no question of either repeal or striking down of the Act".

The Atal Bihari Vajpayee-led NDA government at the Centre had filed an affidavit in the matter on July 18, 2000, stating that a proposal to repeal the IMDT Act was under its consideration. However, the Congress-led UPA government which assumed office at the Centre in 2004 file another affidavit in November that year. It said that the Centre had decided to retain the IMDT Act in its present form. But the Court stuck down the Act in 2005. It observed, "The dangerous consequences of large-scale illegal migration from Bangladesh, both for the people of Assam and more for the nation as a whole, need to be emphatically stressed. No misconceived and mistaken notions of secularism should be allowed to come in the way of doing so". It would not be an exaggeration to say that at the root of all socio-political problems in the country lie the Congress's myopic politics. The party's position on several issues, including the triple talaq issue, the Supreme Court judgment on maintenance to Shah Bano, illegal immigrants from Bangladesh, Ram Temple at Ayodhya and the plight of Kashmiri Pundits, testify to its myopic vision. The party is responsible for communalising Indian politics. All political parties should express their stand on the issue of illegal immigrants in no uncertain terms. Fearmongering and hyperventilation would not serve the interests of the nation as would keeping quiet on the issue.

# Vertical gardens to dot metro, flyover pillars

Noida: The Noida Authority has started setting up vertical gardens in order to improve the city's aesthetic beauty and also curb pollution. The horticulture department has set up one such garden under Sector 15 flyover on the way to Udyog Marg. More vertical gardens will come up on the Shahadra bridge which will cover the drains on both the sides and also minimise the bad odour. In addition to this, by month end, all pillars of metro stations in sectors 15, 16 and 18 will dot vertical gardens. Rajeev Tyagi, general manager, Noida Authority, said the agency has started the work to set up vertical gardens. "In the first move, we have placed one such garden under the Sector 15 flyover. We are getting good response from the residents and commuters. We have decided to develop these gardens on the metro pillars of stations in Sector 15, 16 and 18. These will come up by the end of this month. The vertical gardens on Shahadra drain will also come up in a few days," Tyagi said. The saplings of Ficus Panda, Espragus Marry and Riban Grace are part of the vertical garden. A similar garden has also come up in the Noida Authority office in Sector 6. When open spaces are not readily available in urban areas, vertical gardens become an ideal option to enjoy the greenery, officials said. They can be used on any indoor or

outdoor wall or free standing. The metro pillars on the Dwarka-Noida corridor went green in January this year with a similar vertical garden. Kochi, Ahmedabad and Bengaluru have already set up such vertical gardens. Environmentalists feel that these potted plants in vertical garden would help in battling air pollution if planted in large numbers. Chitra Mukherjee, head of programme, Chintan (an environment research and action group), said that vertical garden is a good idea. "But I feel that this should be managed well, as lack of upkeep would make them redundant. If a large number of vertical gardens are set up, they can control pollution.

### Noida to build 100 public Toilets soon

Noida: Nearly 100 public Toilets will be constructed in Noida before October 2 under BOT (build-operate-transfer) model as part of the Swachh Bharat Mission. The Toilets, which will have two units for men, two for women and one for the differently abled, will be built as per the area's footfall requirements across commercial, industrial and residential sectors. This includes localities like GIP Mall, Botanical Garden metro station, Sector 18, Sector 72 crossing, Sector 51 metro station, City Centre Mall, residential-industrial sectors etc. While 84 such Toilets are currently ready, the remaining will be completed before October 2. These Toilets will be built by private agencies at a cost ranging from Rs 10 to



Rs 12 lakh. "We have provided the tender to 4-5 agencies to build these public Toilets across Noida on the BOT (build, own, operate and transfer) model for a period of 10 years. Under the model, the private agency will build these Toilets, operate it, own it for a period of 10 years during which, it will have the right to earn through advertisements on it with a clause that Rs 10,000 per month would be given to Noida Authority from their ad earnings for the period of 10 years," OSD Rajesh Kumar Singh told TBC.

#### Youth Noida creates fake profile of Patanjali MD

Noida: A 29-year-old man who allegedly indulged in 'obscene' online chats with Facebook users posing as Acharya Balkrishna, managing director of Patanjali Ayurved and a close aide of Ramdev, was held on Saturday. The accused, Mohammed Zeeshan, a resident of Saharanpur, was arrested for making a fake profile of Balkrishna and using indecent phrases in chats with Facebook users who followed the profile. A complaint was filed on July 4 by Pramod Joshi, CEO of Vedik Broadcasting Limited. An FIR was then lodged under sections 419, 420 500 of IPC and Section 66 D of the IT Act against an unknown accused.

Friday. "After returning home, my wife noticed that our eldest daughter looked sad and was unable to walk properly. Initially, the girl did not respond to her mother's queries, but later told her everything," he added. "Around 8 pm on Wednesday, Ravi, who was passing by, saw the girl playing on her mobile phone outside her home.

# 2 sub-inspectors from Haryana killed in accident in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: Two Haryana police sub-inspectors posted in Palwal district died in a road accident on Eastern Peripheral Expressway near Duhai on Monday afternoon. The accident took place around 2 pm when the two policemen, travelling in a Swift car, rammed their vehicle into a stationary truck parked on the side of the carriageway. Both of them died on the spot. The two have been identified as Virendra Kumar (49) and Rajendra Singh Dagar (51). According to their colleagues, the duo had recently been promoted to the rank of sub-inspector and were undergoing training at Haryana Police Academy in

Karnal for the past two-anda-half months. On Monday, they were returning to Palwal on a holiday. Prior to their promotion, Kumar was the incharge of Asaoti police post while Dagar was posted at Palwal police chowki. Subinspector, Muradnagar, Bhupendra Singh said, "The bodies have been kept at a government hospital in Sanjay Nagar and will be handed over to their families after postmortem. A provision to impose fines on such vehicles could be looked into. "Commuters tend to speed on the road finding it wide open. We are looking into ways to control this menace," he added.

### GZB edges past Delhi as liveable city

NOIDA/GHAZIABAD: Ghaziabad is a better place to

live than Delhi as per the nationwide livability study conducted by the Union ministry of housing and urban development. However, Noida and Greater oida, though being important NCR cities, missed the bus of this ranking as the twin cities are not governed by municipalities. The framework of study has been divided into four categories – institutional, social, economic and physical with 25% weightage given to each category. Ghaziabad, a city with 16.49 lakh, has come at 46 rank. Gurgaon has got 88th rank. Delhi with a city population of 112.92 lakh is ranked at 65.

# Undertrial gives cop a slip in Ghaziabad court

**GHAZIABAD:** An undertrial prisoner fled from a court in Ghaziabad on Monday, where he was brought for a hearing, by hoodwinking a police constable who was accompanying him. The prisoner, Ishrar, is an accused in a theft case that took place in Kavi Nagar in 2014. Ishrar was in judicial custody in Dasna jail after he was arrested. On Monday, he was brought from the jail for hearing in court No. 79. He was being accompanied by a constable, Krishan Murari, who had recently been attached to the police lines from Khoda police station where he was

posted. "The undertrial prisoner had not been handcuffed as he was brought for hearing. The constable left him alone for a moment at the ground floor of the court building when he left to make formal entries for the day in a register. The accused immediately fled from the premises taking advan-tage of the situation," said a police officer. The police have registered an FIR at Kavi Nagar police station under sections 223 (escape from confinement negligently suffered by public servant) and 224 (resistance to lawful apprehension) of IPC following the escape.

# Satellite to keep tabs on saplings

NOIDA: The UP forest department will geo-tag tree plantation for the first time. A massive plantation drive, planned for August 15 under the mandate of chief minister Yogi Adityanath, will be continuously monitored for sapling growth for the next one year from an aerial satellite to register the success or failure of the drive. The forest department said that with sapling plantation and its success always questioned on the survival rates of the plant, this time a scientific approach had been adapted to map the growth of the saplings once they are planted.

# 14 illegal buildings razed in second phase of drive in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: The GDA on Monday started the second phase of the demolition drive during which 14 Illegal buildings were razed. The team faced some resistance in Balaji enclave in Masuri, where two buildings were razed, but the police prevented the residents from stopping the drive. "We had set a target of demolishing 21 buildings in the city, but we could manage to demolish only 14," said V K Singh, OSD, GDA. "Under Muradnagar police station, two colonies on Duhai road spread across an area of 6,000 sqm and 10,000 sqm were



demolished," said Singh. In Meerpur Hindu Colony under Tronica City police station, an illegal colony, Dream City, spread over 11 hectares of land was demolished. "We demolished the boundary wall of about 70 plots," said Singh. In Kavinagar and Indirapuram, four buildings were razed, followed by three each in Sahibabad and Vijay Nagar

areas. ADM (City), Himanshu Gautam, said in the Masuri area, when the team went to demolish structures, about 50odd people tried to stall the drive. "We had an inkling of the protest brewing in the area so a PAC battalion and personnel from at least three police stations, apart from civil police, were deputed at the site who ensured that the drive was not affected," Gautam said. "The protesters were insisting that that their houses were not illegal, but when we asked them to produce the map they were unable to do so.

### Techie claims sexual harassment in office

NOIDA: A 30-year-old woman filed a police complaint against her company management and colleagues on Saturday for allegedly sexually harassing her. The woman, a resident of Firozabad, has been working in an IT firm since October 2016. She told police that some colleagues had harassed her and made sexual advances in the office since November 2017. She alleged that the colleagues had also posted derogatory remarks against her in a WhatsApp group. She informed about their behaviour to the management of the company but no action was allegedly taken.

# 3 minors booked for killing 12yr-old over watch in Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD**: Three minor family had rented. The boy's on Sunday after they allegedly thrashed to death a Class VI student following a quarrel over a plastic wrist watch. The victim, identified as 12-year-old Sunny, studied in a private school in Khoda. GHAZIABAD: Within hours of what seemed like a perfect robbery plot, police claimed to have cracked the case with the arrest of five people, including three employees of a private firm who had reported they were robbed of Rs 19 lakh by four armed assailants on Tuesday afternoon. Police said the three employees of the private company had made a call to the police control room around 4 pm on Tuesday to report the robbery at gunpoint by four bike-borne assailants in Vasundhara Sector 19. The employees had also claimed that one of their colleagues had also suffered injuries after an assailant slashed him with a blade. After senior officials, including SSP Vaibhav Krishna, CO (Indirapuram) Ravi Kumar, and SHO (Indirapuram) Sachin Malik, reached the spot, the trio told them that four



assailants overtook their car near an electricity sub-station in Vasundhara Sector 19 under the Hindon Elevated Road and took away at gunpoint a bag containing the money and a laptop. They said the robbery took place when they were on their way back to the office in Shakti Khand 3 after withdrawing Rs 19 lakh from two banks Punjab National Bank and Axis Bank in Vasundhara Sector 13. SSP Vaibhav Krishna said, "The three employees Vishal Agnihotri, Amit Katiyar and Wasim Siddiqui worked in the company of Hitesh Kumar, who takes contracts from the power department and civic bodies.

# Come next year, Noida may bid goodbye to open vats

NOIDA: While Noida is set to be open defecation-free before October 2 following the construction of over 100 public Toilets across the city, in its next phase, the Noida Authority is all set to do away with open vats or 'dhalao ghars' in sectors and replace them with with compactors. The compactors are containers which will store garbage in the compact form to be carried away on trucks to temporary dump sites. The compactors will be placed in areas where open vats existed earlier. At present, tenders are being issued for segregated waste collection across the city. Sources said the process of closing down open vats will begin by December 2018. "We are currently finalising the tendering process for door-todoor segregated waste collection. The successful bidder will be allotted the contract soon. Once the process is implemented, we will begin work on removing the dhalao open vats to convert the area into a landscaped green stretches," said Rajesh Kumar Singh, OSD in the Noida Authority. S K Gupta, deputy general manager, health, Noida Authority, said there are nearly 400 designated open vats in the city. The work to remove them will commence by the end of December 2018. "Nearly 3/ 4ths of the 400 designated dhalao open vats in the city will be taken down from December 2018. Before that, we will set in motion the process of doorto-door segregated waste collection and disposal through compactors," said Gupta.

# Rera to set up bench in Noida, hear 4,000 pending complaints

GREATER NOIDA: The Real Estate Regulatory Authority (Rera) is set to open its western UP bench in Greater Noida in a few days, at a time 4,000 complaints related to issues over flats from Noida and Ghaziabad are waiting to be heard. The bench will operate from the old building of the Greater Noida Authority's office in Gamma 2. The building had been lying vacant since the Authority's office was shifted to Knowledge Park IV. Two of the bench members will hear cases in the Greater Noida office, while the remaining two

will be in Lucknow. Although Rera has been operational in the state since April 2017, it was only last week that the state appointed former chief secretary Rajive Kumar as its full-time chairman. Kumar replaced Nitin Ramesh Gokarn, principal secretary (housing), who was the interim chairman. A bench of the Rera committee had been a longstanding demand homebuyers and residents of Noida and Ghaziabad. Sources said the decision to set up a bench in Greater Noida had been driven by the fact that around 80% of the complaints related to housing had come from Noida and Ghaziabad, which has seen a real estate boom over the last decade. Sources said around 6,000 applications related to real estate were waiting to be heard across the state, of which 4,000 were from Noida, Greater Noida and Ghaziabad region. UP Rera has four team members in total, who will sit on rotation in the offices in Greater Noida and Lucknow. The Greater Noida bench will hear cases every day so that the backlog can be cleared. "We are setting up mobile courts so that Rera officers can get closer to complainants. By setting up a bench to Greater Noida, the hearing process has been decentralised. Now with the mobile courts, the process will get streamlined further," a committee member said. Apart from Rajive Kumar, the state has appointed Kalpana Mishra, Bhanu Pratap Singh and Balvinder Kumar as members of the Rera commitee. While Mishra is from the judiciary, Singh is a former IPS officer. Balvinder Kumar had served as vice-chairman of the Lucknow Development Authority.

# Four held for extortion using honeytrap in Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD:** Four persons, including two women, were arrested on Friday in Ghaziabad on charges of luring rich boys using honeytrap and extorting money from them by threatening to slap rape charges on them, police said. The accused were arrested after a case was registered against them under sections 386 (extortion) and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the IPC in Indirapuram Police Station of the city on August 3. The police said during the ongoing vehicle checking drive ahead of the Independence Day, they arrested these four criminals

wanted by the Indirapuram police from near Kala Patthar crossing in Indirapuram area. During interrogation, they confessed to their crime. They gave their names as Harkesh and Nivesh Sirohi of Bulandshahr, who would along with the two women commit crime. Harkesh admitted that he was the gang leader. They had extorted money using honeytrap in the past, too. The police recovered a car from them. All the four were produced later in the court, which sent them to judicial custody, said SHO-Indirapuram Sachin Malik.

#### 8 robbers held, four of them after shootout

**GREATER NOIDA**: Eight persons involved in several cases of robbery were arrested from two different places of Greater Noida in two days. Among them, four were working as a gang and conducting robberies in Aligarh and Surajpur areas. On Sunday, around 5am, Rahul (25), Vikas (24), Keshav (19) and Rakesh (24) were arrested after a shootout near Surajpur square. Police said Rahul had robbed a government official along with an accomplice Govinda and a few others in December 2017 after which they were sent to jail. Nine motorcycles, two master keys and two country-made guns were seized from them.

### Minister, MLAs urge CM Yogi Adityanath to stop demolition drive in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: A minister and two MLAs from the BJP on Thursday urged chief minister Yogi Adityanath to direct the district administration to stop the demolition drive being carried out in the district claming that it would cause immense financial loss to the builders. Instead, they said, the government should constitute a high-level committee and evaluate whether such constructions can be legalized in any manner. They also demanded that the officials of the civic body be punished in the first place for allowing such constructions in the city. In a

letter to the CM, minister Atul Garg, MLAs Sunil Sharma and Ajit Pal Tyagi said that through media reports and after talking to district magistrate Ritu Maheshwari, they had come to know that there were more than 500 buildings, each with four-five floors, built in an unplanned manner and without an approval from the district authorities. So far, 20-25 such buildings have been demolished. "The total cost of these buildings are somewhere between Rs 1,000-Rs 1,500 crore, and demolishing them is an impractical approach. This will completely destroy the builders.

### Noida to change old transformers, wires

Noida: The city, which was earlier in the "no power cut" zone, will now be one of the 17 cities that will be part of the "no-tripping zone", the power department announced. The department, which is still grappling with infrastructure and financial constraints, shared details of the plan that it will implement over the next few months. The plan includes replacing old and damaged equipment, installing new transformers in different areas and digital relays for sensing fault. Further, the Noida Authority has decided to help the Pashchimanchal Vidyut Vitaran Nigam Limited (PVVNL) with three major projects hanging in the balance for the past few years.

# Hindon IAF base may see pvt jet ops too

**NEW DELHI**: The new civil terminal being built at Hindon Air Force base in Ghaziabad could accommodate both cheap flights and private jets Subsidised regional connectivity scheme (RCS) flights who flights are capped at Rs 2,500 per hour would operate from Hindon next January. Airports Authority of India (AAI), which is building the terminal, plans to shift non-RCS flights on planes with less than 80 seats also to Hindon. If that happens, business jets, and private chartered planes almost all of which are small planes except for a rare big bird like Airbus Corporate Jet that Vijay Mallya once had and now only Reliance has in India may be flying in and out of Hindon. While RCS flights have been



cleared, the civil aviation authorities would need IAF nod for charter or private plane operators. "Hindon is presently not available for any nonschedule operations," said a senior official. Chartered and private jet operations regularly happen at several defence airports like Goa and Chandigarh. AAI would try to get a not for Hindon too to free up some slots at IGI Airport to accommodate more scheduled flights, both domestic and international. Under a hugely delayed but ongoing expansion

### plan, IGIA is supposed to get a fourth runway and an expanded Terminal 1 by September 2022. That means for almost four years some drastic steps would be needed to cope with the growing air traffic demand of Delhi. AAI chairman Guruprasad Mohapatra told TBC that the proposed shifting of chartered planes and business jets from IGIA to Hindon wouldn't be a permanent affair. "It will coincide with the period till Hindon continues with RCS operations. The civil enclave in Hindon will be ready in maximum six months," he said. Once IGIA is expanded, it would take care of RCS and business jet operations once

### Romanian national arrested for trying to steal data from ATM in Noida

**NOIDA**: A Romanian man was arrested on Saturday for allegedly trying to steal data from an automatic ATM machine in Sector 18 here, police said. Onciu Anexandru (27), a resident of Valcea Romana in Romania, was fiddling with the ATM of a private bank in Savitri Market, they said. "The accused had got his ATM card stuck in the machine and was fiddling with it. The security guard at the ATM grew suspicious of his activities and alerted the police," according to a police statement. Personnel from the Sector 20 police station immediately reached the spot and held Anexandru.

## Rape survivor accuses Ghaziabad cop of forcing her to change statement

GHAZIABAD: A 30-year- two occasions and sought his old gangrape survivor has accused a sub-inspector of Masuri police station of trying to force her to change her statement against the accused.
