EDITORIAL

Waiting for daybreak :  
on Chandrayaan-2

India’s second moon mission, Chandrayaan-2, was pulled back from launch just 56 minutes before its scheduled liftoff on July 15. This was owing to a technical glitch in the GSLV Mark-III rocket launcher. No rescheduled date has been announced for launch. This has no doubt served as a damper on those who eagerly looked forward to India being only the fourth country to launch a mission that would land on the moon, and the very first to land on and explore its south pole region. Yet, it was best that the glitch was discovered before the launch. Rocket launches always have a nail-biting finish. Even the GSLV-D1, the slighter predecessor to the GSLV Mark-III, suffered such a setback when it was about to be launched for its first developmental test flight in 2001. It was called off exactly one second before launch, as it was discovered that one of the four liquid propellant strap-on stages had not developed the required thrust. This test flight was conducted just 21 days later, paving the way for several successful launches of the GSLV rocket subsequently.

What seems to have touched the popular imagination is that the current launch window ends on July 16 and if this window is missed there could be an indefinite delay in rescheduling the launch. Coupled with news reports that checking and correcting the error could take up to 10 days, this has led to dire pronouncements of an indefinite postponement of the mission. The ‘launch window’ is determined by several factors. One of the most important considerations is that any spot on the moon receives sunlight for approximately 14 (earth) days before being plunged in night for another fourteen. The landing has to be timed so that it maximises the overlap with the sunlit days on that spot. This is because the lander and the rover need solar energy to power them and to keep the instruments warm. Therefore, given a landing spot that can be seen from the earth, the landing date has to coincide with the sixth phase of the moon (first quarter) as seen from the earth, on that spot. Secondly, once placed on the moon orbit, Chandrayaan-2 must have full visibility to the ground station, which will determine the time of operation of the landing. From the date of launch to the date of landing, the planned interval is about 54 days. Much of this time is needed for the Chandrayaan-2 mission to make various orbital manoeuvres and operations, but there is a leeway of a day or two to take some decisions. A window that takes all this into account, is available for about 10 minutes on each day now for about a week. Such a window can be found every month. Other tighter windows are available but are high-risk options. So even if Chandrayaan-2 misses its rendezvous with the moon this month, it will find a date, perhaps even next month, that will be suitable.

गाजियाबाद : इंडियन इंडस्ट्रीज एसोसिएशन (आइआइए) ने लखनऊ में आयोजित होने वाले नेशनल सोलर एक्सपो के साथ इस बार नवंबर माह में फूड एक्सपो का आयोजन कराने की योजना तैयार की है, जिसके पीछे मध्यम, लघु व सुक्ष्म इकाइयों में बनने वाली फूड प्रोसेसिंग मशीनरी व पार्ट्स को मंच मिल सके। आइआइए की बैठक में छोटे उद्योगों के समक्ष आने वाली समस्याओं के समाधान को लेकर विस्तार से चर्चा हुई। राजनगर में आयोजित आइआइए की बैठक में बोलते हुए नवनि्युक्त राष्ट्रीय अध्यक्ष पंकज गुप्ता ने कहा कि इस समय दिल्ली एनसीआर में सबसे बड़ी समस्या भूगर्भ जल को लेकर है। भयावह भूगर्भ जल की स्थिति को देखते हुए एनजीटी ने बोरवेल लगी इकाइयों को बंद करने की एक समय सीमा नि

र्धारित की है। उन्होंने कहा, औद्योगिक क्षेत्रों में काम करने वाले कर्मचारियों के लिए पेयजल की व्यवस्था कराना भी सरकार का काम है। बजट में सरकार की ओर से एमएसएमई उद्योगों के लिए सपना भर दिखाया गया है। छोटी इकाइयों के लिए बैंक लोन जहां 12 प्रतिशत ब्याज दर पर दिया जाता है, वहीं बड़े उद्योग घरानों को यही लोन 6 प्रतिशत में मुहैया कराया जाता है, जबकि कम ब्याज दर की ज्यादा जरूरत छोटे उद्यमियों को होती है। उन्होंने जीएसटी में सरलीकरण की भी मांग की। इस दौरान नीरज सिंघल को पुन राष्ट्रीय उपाध्यक्ष, महानगर चेयरमैन प्रदीप कुमार गुप्ता को मेरठ मंडल— का डिवीजनल चेयरमैन नियुक्त किया गया है। अध्यक्ष पद पर मनोज कुमार, राकेश अनेजा को नियुक्त किया गया।

## Son of a pradhan shot dead in Loni

**GHAZIABAD:** A son of village pradhan was shot dead by three bike-borne unidentified assailants in Loni on Sunday evening. The victim has been identified as Vikram, son of Jagwati, who is pradhan of Mahmoodpur village in Loni. The incident took place around 7.45 pm when Vikram was sitting outside his house. The assailants came on a motorcycle and shot at him multiple times. Vikram tried to run from the spot but fell to bullets in an alley near his house. SSP Sudhir Kumar Singh said the victim had a long criminal history and animosity with several people. We are

trying to gather more information about. The family has given us some names we are working on the information. SP (rural) Neeraj Kumar Jadaun said Vikram was involved in several cases of murder loot and dacoity and had been to jail several times in the past. He had a history-sheeter since 2009. It seems that today’s incident was an outcome of a gang war. His house is in the open area. They gheraoed him and fired multiple shots, Jadaun added. The body was subsequently sent for post-mortem. The family had not given a complaint till the filing of the report.

## Taunted for not having baby, couple abduct kid

**NOIDA:** A couple, taunted by family members for remaining childless even after eight years of marriage, abducted a six-year-old boy from outside his home on July 9. Sandeep and Pinky, who provide services like physiotherapy in private hospitals, had taken the boy, Utkarsh, to Lucknow and kept him as their own child. They were identified from CCTV footage, where Sandeep can be seen picking up Utkarsh in his arms and disappearing into the darkness along with Pinky. Utkarsh is the son of Naren Rathore, a vegetable-seller, and Sunita, who stay in a rented house in Gajhera village in Sector 53.

## Boy in ICU after fall from school terrace in Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD:** A ninth standard student at Everest Public school in Sahibabad was injured after allegedly falling from the terrace of the school’s second floor on Friday. The student’s family has claimed he was being thrashed by a teacher and fell as he tried to run away. But a teacher at the school said the boy had “misbehaved” with another student, a girl, and both students had been summoned for counselling. “Some students informed me someone had fallen from the terrace. I rushed to the spot and found the boy in front of

the junior wing’s toilet. I took him to a nearby hospital, which referred him to another hospital,” the school’s sports teacher said. “CCTV footage clearly shows the boy running towards the terrace. He jumped from there, fearing his parents would be called to school,” he added. The boy’s father, who works with a private company in Ghaziabad, said one of the teachers had tortured and beaten his son. “He received fractures in his hands and leg and also sustained head injuries.

## Man impersonating as cop arrested

**GHAZIABAD:** A man was arrested for allegedly impersonating as a police officer and extorting money from several people, police said on Saturday. The accused, identified as Ashish Chaudhary, a resident of Harsh Vihar Colony in north-east Delhi, was arrested from Sikandarpur village. He had extorted money from several passersby, posing as a police officer, SP (City) Shlok Kumar said. The SP said they recovered a countrymade pistol, live cartridges, Rs 25,000 in cash, a uniform and motorcycle from him.

## Law student commits suicide, 4 booked for abetment

**GHAZIABAD:** A 20-year-old law student allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself from the ceiling fan of his house on Kavi Nagar on Thursday. Four students, including a girl, have been booked for allegedly harassing Vipin Kumar and abetting the suicide. Police said Vipin had shot a video before committing the suicide, in which he mentioned the names of his classmate and alleged that they harassed him mentally. Vipin’s father, a police constable, had lodged a complaint against the four students. On Thursday evening, Vipin Kumar, who

was in the third-year at a private law college in Ghaziabad, was found hanging from the ceiling fan “Around 6pm on Thursday, Vipin had gone to the second floor of the house, but when he didn’t come down even after several calls, we went to look for him and found him hanging from the ceiling fan. In his phone, he shot a video accusing four students of mentally harassing him and passing lewd comments,” said Virendra Singh, Vipin’s father. Singh said Vipin had earlier complained to his parents about being mentally harassed.

# Ghaziabad call centre cheated policyholders, 7 held

**GHAZIABAD:** A fake call centre that was being run from a rented office at Cloud-9 in Vaishali area was busted on Saturday with the arrest of seven persons. The accused were allegedly involved in duping over 500 insurance policy holders. “They ran the call centre in the name of one M/S Italic Service at office no. 436, at Cloud-9 society’s commercial area in Sector 1, Vaishali area of Ghaziabad,” said a police officer. Police said the accused have been identified as Bharat Kumar and Gaurav Chandr, both from Vijay Nagar area of Ghaziabad, Sanjeev Singh, from Mandawali in Delhi, and four women, Jyoti Dinanath, Mamta Kumari, Puja and Bhavna, all of whom are from Delhi. The mastermind, Asif, who is from Haryana, is on the run, the police said. Shlok Kumar, the superintendent of police (city), told TBC that the accused claimed that the firm was under the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDA) and targeted those whose life insurance policies were soon to get expired. “They would call up people and ask them to renew their insurance policies. When the respondents agreed, the accused would ask them to mail them their Aadhaar and PAN details. The accused would share with them account numbers where the renewal amount had to be deposited. Once the money was transferred, the accused would call up the respondents and confirm the transaction. Later, when the victims would try to get details of their policies, they would come to know about the fraud. When they tried to call on the numbers, they would find those switched off,” he added. “The accused used to purchase data from one Ajeet, another accused in the case. He is on the run. Ajeet would sell the data of one person for Rs 10. It included name, address, contact details and details of insurance policy of a person. At a time, Ajeet would sell data of more than hundreds of people,” Kumar added. The call centre was being run for the past six months but the fraud came to light when an FIR was lodged by a victim at Indirapuram police station, alleging that a few people had duped him of over Rs 70 lakh. Apart from a fixed monthly salary of Rs 20,000, each call centre employee was given an incentive after a successful transaction.

# Ghaziabad man strangles wife, sits with body before surrendering

**GHAZIABAD:** Suspecting his wife of having an extramarital affair, a 29-year-old man allegedly strangled her after a heated argument in Loni and sat with the body for over two hours before surrendering to police on Thursday. The accused, Azad, is an autorickshaw driver. He lived in Loni with his wife Farzana (26) and two children. “The couple had been married for five years. Farzana used to work as a tailor from home. They lived in Sahibabad’s Shaheed Nagar earlier and had shifted to Loni 25 days ago,” a police officer said. Azad suspected



his wife of having an affair, and late on Wednesday, the couple had a heated argument after their children fell asleep. “In a fit of rage, Azad thrashed Farzana. He then grabbed her by the throat and strangled her with his bare hands. He later told police that he was drunk and didn’t intend to kill her, but went too far,” SP (rural) Neeraj Kumar Jadaun said.

# Arthala lake: NGT asks for affidavit on compliance

**GHAZIABAD:** The National Green Tribunal (NGT), while hearing the case on encroachment around Arthala lake on Wednesday, has directed the Ghaziabad district magistrate to file an affidavit within 10 days detailing compliance as per the 2016 NGT order. The green panel has also asked the administration to submit an action plan on how it will go about removing encroachment around the lake. In its May 31 order, NGT had specifically asked DM Ritu Maheshwari to be present for the hearing. “We’ve been asked by NGT to revisit the 2016 judgment in which detail of plots that were encroached upon had been mentioned and we’ve been asked to file an affidavit within 10 days. We’ll comply with the order,” Maheshwari said. The NGT order stated: “... we direct the district magistrate, Ghaziabad, to study the judgment dated 20th September, 2016, and come out specifically, by way of an affidavit, as to what all compliances are to be made, as per the directions given by the Tribunal and also the encroachments which are yet to be removed.

# Want to make Noida a model district, says officer behind Ghaziabad Swachh show

**GHAZIABAD:** Ritu Maheshwari isn’t leaving Ghaziabad without regrets. Sitting in her camp office on Friday, clearing her last files as district magistrate, Maheshwari said she knew her transfer was “only a matter of time” and she was prepared for it. In an action-packed packed 22-month stint — during which she also held dual charge of Ghaziabad Development Authority for several months — Maheshwari earned a reputation as a proactive officer who got things done. One of the reasons was Ghaziabad’s impressive performance in the Swachh Bharat rankings (all-India 13th currently). The other was stopping registries in illegal colonies in the face of political pressure. “Satisfying”, is how the 2003-batch IAS officer summed up her experience in Ghaziabad during a chat with TBC but, at the same time, pointed to unfinished business like the pollution problem and the state of the Hindon river. “It’s not that work has not been done on the issue of pollution but I hoped more could have been done. It’s the same with the rejuvenation of the Hindon river,” she said. Noida, whose infrastructure and traffic Maheshwari identifies as priority areas, will hope she brings the same dynamism to the city as she did to Ghaziabad where, under her watch, major infrastructure projects like the Hindon Elevated Road, Delhi Metro’s Red Line extension and the Hindon air base’s new civilian terminal were completed. “The decaying and missing infrastructure in Noida will be high on my priority list and I hope to bring positive changes to turn Noida into a model district. It is with this mindset that I hope to take up my new responsibility,” said Maheshwari. “I will also lay emphasis on making Noida a green city.” Maheshwari said she was aware of the complicated real estate problems of Noida. “My understanding as of now is that projects by Jaypee and Amarpali are being overseen by courts. I will step in if my intervention is required,” she said. The biggest challenge, according to her, has been to change the mindset of officials in different departments. “There were times when I got the feeling that officials were either reluctant or too lethargic to react in removing impediments plaguing projects,” Maheshwari said.

## In Ghaziabad, youth fires at sister-in-law, kills self

**GHAZIABAD:** A 26-year-old man allegedly shot himself after shooting at his sister-in-law on Friday morning. While the accused, Ramesh, died on the spot, the woman, Savita Devi (36), is said to be critical. She was shot at thrice in her abdomen. Police said Ramesh was a vegetable vendor in Sahibabad. On Thursday around 10pm, he went to his brother’s house in Haibatpur village in Greater Noida’s Bisrakh and shot at Savita. He then returned to his house in

Jhandapura in Ghaziabad’s Link road and killed himself. The woman is survived by her husband and three minor children. Laxmi Chauhan, the SHO of Link Road police station said, police received the information about the death from Ramesh’s neighbour. “Police have found an illegal pistol and some bullets near the body,” she said. Jai Kumar, Ramesh’s elder brother and Savita’s husband said, “I never thought that Ramesh will try to kill my wife. He has defamed the image of the family by doing this.”

## Robber involved in several burglaries arrested

**GHAZIABAD:** A robber was arrested from Ghaziabad’s Kavi Nagar area on Wednesday for his alleged involvement in several burglaries in high-rise apartments and factories. Police said, so far, the accused, Neeraj Singh, has confessed to committing five such robberies recently. Two of them were reported at Panchsheel Primrose. Singh is a resident of industrial area in Kavi Nagar. He was caught from near Diamond flyover around 6pm on Wednesday when he was on his way to commit another robbery.

## woman bitten by dog: UP: 60-year-old bitten by dog in Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD:** A 60-year-old woman was bitten by a stray dog on Wednesday around 10.30pm while she was walking inside her residential society, GH-7, in Crossings Republik. The residents alleged that the particular dog had bitten several kids in the past as well. The woman has been identified as Shobha Devi who lives with her son and his family in tower five of the society. “The dog started following her soon after she came downstairs for a walk and then suddenly bit her on the leg. I heard some commotion outside and when I went there. I found my mother lying in a pool of blood. I immediately

rushed her to a private hospital for treatment. She has suffered a very deep cut,” said Shobha Devi’s son, Mukesh Sharma. Following the matter, many residents gathered at the spot and demanded removal of the dog from the society. Rohit Chaudhary, the president of GH-7, said, “The same dog has bitten three-four people in the past as well. One such case had taken place on March 26 this year when the dog had bitten a girl while she was going to her tuition class. The dog was picked up on our complaint by the People for Animal (PFA), but after a few days, it was dropped back here.

They were sure it wouldn’t miss. “That evening, when I returned from work, I wasn’t feeling well so I told my wife to go to the party and give the boy a birthday gift. My wife handed over the gift and returned after some time,” says Kumar, an RBS employee. But after some time,

## Man commits suicide after shooting at sister-in-law

**GHAZIABAD:** A man hailing from Bihar has committed suicide at Jhanda Pur village in Site-4 Industrial area of Sahibabad after shooting at his sister-in-law, with whom he was allegedly having an affair, police said on Friday. As per police investigation, Ramesh, who hailed from Khagaria district in Bihar, killed himself using a country-made pistol, which was found abandoned near his body, city superintendent of police Shlok Kumar said. Ramesh's brother runs a pan shop in Haibatpur area Noida. Ramesh was recently asked to leave his

brother's home. Since then he was living Ghaziabad and selling vegetables, police said. Ramesh was allegedly having an affair with his sister-in-law, which his older brother Janaradan objected to, officials said. Around 8 pm on Thursday, Ramesh went to his brother's house and shot thrice at his sister-in-law. Later Ramesh returned here and committed suicide. His body was sent for autopsy. His sister-in-law is undergoing treatment at Ram Manohar Lohia hospital in Delhi where she is stated to be in critical condition, the SP added.

Megha was not the property dealer Yadav had contacted recently.
