अब जीडीए पार्की में लगाएगा सीसीटीवी



कविनगर थाने में महागुन बिल्डर खिलाफ दी तहरीर

गाजियाबाद : एनएच-24 महरौली स्थित महागुनपुरम ग्रुप हाउसिंग में तलपट मानचित्र के विपरीत निर्माण कार्य करने पर मैसर्स महागुन रियल एस्टेट के निदेशक अमित जैन के खिलाफ मुकदमा दर्ज करने के लिए कविनगर थाने में तहरीर दी गई है। गाजियाबाद विकास प्राधि ाकरण के प्रवर्तन जोन-चार के अवर अभियंता ज्ञान प्रकाश द्विवेदी और नरेंद्र कुमार ने तहरीर दी है। बिल्डर पर आरोप है कि उसने ग्रुप हाउसिंग के गोदावरी टॉवर में बायर्स को कब्जा नहीं दिया और पूर्णता प्रमाण पत्र को लेने में भी रुचि नहीं दिखाई। इस मामले से जुड़ी एक याचिका पर एनजीटी में बृहस्पतिवार को सुनवाई होनी है। तहरीर में बताया कि गोदावरी टॉवर में बायर्स को कब्जा न देने की

200 school buses give fitness test a miss on last day in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: More than 200 private buses engaged by schools to ferry students missed an inspection drive conducted by the transport department on its last day on Sunday. The department has now decided to conduct surprise checks on vehicles engaged by schools to see if they are fitted with equipment as listed in the guidelines laid down by the Supreme Court. On the first day of the drive on April 8, only 712 of the 1,400-odd buses across Ghaziabad district had turned up. Of them, 125 were found plying

without necessary safety gear in place. During the second and last phase of the drive on Sunday, another 308 buses turned up, of which 37 were found without safety features. "The buses were examined on an 11-point agenda as laid down by the apex court. We have issued notices to the managements of those private schools whose buses were found lacking the safety features. They have to install the features and report to the transport department in seven days," said ARTO Biswajeet Singh.

गाजियाबाद : महिला व नाबालिग संबंधी अपराधों की विवेचना में तेजी लाने व वादी को न्याय दिलाने के उद्देश्य से एसएसपी द्वारा तैयार की गई योजना परी दिवस की जिले में बुधवार से शुरूआत कर दी गई। परी दिवस हर महीने के प्रत्येक द्वितीय व चतुर्थ शनिवार को जिले में आयोजित किया जाएगा। द्वितीय शनिवार को अंबेडकर जयंती होने के कारण परी दिवस का आयोजन नहीं हो सकता था। इसके चलते ब्धवार को जिले के सभी थानों में इसका आयोजन किया गया। बुधवार को विभिन्न थानों पर आयोजित इस कार्यक्रम में 254 वादी उपस्थित हुए जिनके मामलों में प्रगति रिपोर्ट की समीक्षा कर उनके प्रकरणों को शीध



निस्तारित करने के निर्देश दिए गए। एसएसपी वैभव कृष्ण बुध वार को परी दिवस के अवसर पर नगर कोतवाली व सिहानी गेट में आयोजित कार्यक्रम में उपस्थित हुए और स्वयं मामलों की समीक्षा की। एसएसपी ने बताया कि थानों पर संबंधित सीओ व थाना प्रभारी के साथ विवेचक को बुलाया गया था। इसके अलावा एसपी सिटी व एसपी देहात को तीन—तीन थानों में जाकर समीक्षा के लिए कहा गया। उन्होंने बताया कि जिले में महिला व नाबालिगों से संबंधि त कुल 968 अभियोग पंजीकृत हैं। इनमें से बुधवार को परी दिवस के अवसर पर 537

प्रकरणों की समीक्षा की गई। परी दिवस में पूरे जिले के थानों में 254 वादी उपस्थित हुए। समीक्षा में पाया गया कि द्ष्कर्म व छेड़छाड़ के मामलों में 188 पीडितों का मेडिकल कराया जा चुका है जबकि 173 पीडितों के 164 के बयान दर्ज कराए जा चुके हैं। उन्होंने बताया कि सभी मामलों में 476 आरोपितों में से 162 की गिरफ्तारी कराई जा चुकी है। बाकी आरोपितों की शीघ्र गिरफ्तारी कराई जाएगी। एसएसपी ने बताया कि जिन मामलों में विवेचकों ने चार्जशीट लगा दी है उन मामलों में संबंधि ात सीओ को निर्देश दिए गए हैं कि वह चार्जशीट शीघ्र कोर्ट में दाखिल करें जिससे वादी को न्याय मिल सके।

गाजियाबाद : 22 व 23 अप्रैल को कचरा महोत्सव का आयोजन किया जाएगा। इसका उद्देश्य कचरे की रिसाइक्लिंग करके उसे उपयोगी बनाने के लिए जन जागरूकता पैदा करना है। महोत्सव की तैयारी को लेकर जिलाधिकारी रितु माहेश्वरी ने कलेक्ट्रेट में बैठक आयोजित की। उन्होंने बताया कि कचरा महोत्सव में 05 दर्जन से अधिक स्कूल कालेजों, स्वंय सेवी संस्थाओं, आरडब्लूए तथा स्थानीय निकायों ने पंजीकरण कराया है। महोत्सव में प्रत्येक संस्था को एक-एक स्टाल निशुल्क उपलब्ध कराया जायेगा।

चंद्रशिला अपार्टमेंट का रुका काम अगले महीने हो जाएगा शुरू

गाजियाबाद : जीडीए का चंद्रशिला अपार्टमेंट योजना का निर्माण कार्य अगले महीने दोबारा से शुरू हो जाएगा। इसके लिए दूसरे ठेकेदार को निर्माण की जिम्मेदारी देने के लिए मई के पहले सप्ताह में टेंडर खोले जाएंगे। इस योजना में 120 फ्लैट बनवाए जा रहे हैं। जीडीए ने सिहानी गेट थाने के सटी जमीन पर चंद्रशिला अपार्टमेंट योजना के निर्माण की जिम्मेदारी एमजीआइ बिल्डवेल प्राइवेट लिमिटेड को दी थी। जनवरी 2015 में बिल्डर ने निर्माण शुरू किया था। इस प्रोजेक्ट को जनवरी 2017 तक पूरा करना था। शहर के बीचोबीच होने के

कारण योजना में तेजी से सारे फ्लैट बुक हो गए। बाद में निर्माण कार्य में देरी के चलते करीब 50 फीसद आवंटियों ने पैसा वापस ले लिया। प्राधिकरण ने निर्माण कार्य में देरी के लिए बीते साल जुलाई में बिल्डर पर 54.59 लाख का जुर्माना लगाते हुए प्रोजेक्ट को एक महीने में पूरा करने के निर्देश दिए। इसके बाद भी प्रोजेक्ट पूरा नहीं हुआ तो बिल्डर पर 74.39 लाख रुपये जुर्माना लगाते हुए उसे ब्लैक लिस्ट कर दिया था। अब इस योजना के फ्लैट का निर्माण पूरा कराने के लिए मई पहले सप्ताह में टेंडर खोला जाएगा। दूसरे बिल्डर को। ठेका दिया जाएगा।

उन्नाव–कठुआ कांड में इंसाफ के लिए कलक्ट्रेट पर प्रदर्शन

गाजियाबाद : सोने की खरीदारी के लिए साल का सबसे शुभ मुहुर्त माने जाने वाली अक्षय तृतीया पर जिले में इस बार कम कारोबार हुआ है। हालांकि सर्राफा कारोबारी सुबह से ही तैयारी में बैठे थे। कारोबारियों का कहना था कि आम दिनों के मुकाबले तो अधिक खरीदारी हुई, लेकिन बीते साल की तरह बिक्री नहीं हुई। बता दें कि नोटबंदी के बाद से ठंडे पड़े सर्राफा कारोबार को अक्षय तृतीया से उम्मीद थी। हालांकि कैश की कमी के कारण इस बार बडी संख्या में लोगों ने आनलाइन पेमेंट को अपनाया। अक्षय तृतीया या आखा तीज को स्वयंसिद्ध मुहुर्त माना जाता है। आमतौर पर इस दिन सोने की खरीदारी की जाती है। मान्यता है कि इस दिन खरीदा



गया सोना तरक्की के रास्ते खोल देता है। गाजियाबाद सर्राफा एसोसिएशन के संरक्षक राजिकशोर गुप्ता का कहना है कि इस बार उम्मीद से कम कारोबार रहा। इसके पीछे केश की किल्लत को बड़ी वजह माना जा रहा है। सर्राफा कारोबारी राकेश ने बताया कि बीते साल करीब 40 करोड़ रुपये का कारोबार हुआ था, जबकि इस साल कुछ कम कारोबार हुआ। अक्षाय तृतीया पर सर्राफा कारोबारियों को बड़े मुनाफे की उम्मीद रहती है।

गाजियाबाद : बिजली चोरी रोकने के लिए विद्युत निगम के अभियान के तहत बुधवार तड़के कैला भट्टा में छापेमारी की गई। इस दौरान एक दर्जन से ज्यादा लोगों को चोरी की बिजली प्रयोग करते रंगे हाथ दबो चा। छापामारी शुरू होते ही कुछ लोग अपने घर के ताला लगाकर फरार हो गए। निगम की ओर से 14 लोगों के खिलाफ बिजली चोरी की रिपोर्ट दर्ज करवाई गई है। विद्युत निगम के मुख्य अभियंता एके चौधरी ने बताया कि डीएम रितु माहेश्वरी के नेतृत्व में बिजली चोरी रोकने के लगातार जिले भर में अभियान चलाया जा रहा है। बुधवार को कैला भट्टा में चेकिंग अभियान चलाया गया।

अब संक्रामक बीमारियों की रिपोर्ट मिलेगी ऑनलाइन

गाजियाबाद : अब संक्रामक बीमारियों की जांच रिपोर्ट लेने के लिए जिला संक्रामक रोग नियंत्रण विभाग के चक्कर नहीं काटने पड़ेंगे, बल्कि जल जनित बीमारियों की जांच कराने के दौरान दी गई ई मेल आईडी पर जांच रिपोर्ट आ जाएगी। इसके लिए विभाग को अपग्रेड करने के साथ ही पूरा डॉटा आनलाइन किया जा रहा है। बरसात शुरू होने के बाद जिले में संक्रामक रोग के चपेट में आने वाले मरीजों की संख्या बढ जाती है। जिला संक्रामक रोग नियंत्रण विभाग में जांच कराने के बाद रिपोर्ट लेने के लिए भी चक्कर काटना पड़ता है। हर साल हजारों लोग डेंगू, मलेरिया की चपेट में आ जाते हैं। जिला संक्रामक रोग

विभाग में अब मलेरिया की जांच रैपिड किट से नहीं की जाएगी। केंद्र सरकार ने इस पर रोक लगा दी है। रैपिड किट की जगह यह जांच अब माइक्रोस्कोपिक विधि से की जाएगी। इस रिपोर्ट को ही अंतिम रिपोर्ट माना जाएगा। रैपिड किट की रिपोर्ट पर सवाल उठने के बाद यह निर्णय लिया गया है। वरिष्ठ मलेरिया निरीक्षक नरेंद्र क्मार ने बताया कि जिला एमएमजी अस्पताल में बनीं जिला संक्रामक रोग नियंत्रण प्रयोगशाला में अभी तक माइक्रोस्कोप और रैपिड किट दोनों से ही जांच की जाती थी, लेकिन माइक्रोस्कोपिक जांच जटिल होने के कारण ज्यादातर मलेरिया के मामलों की जांच रैपिड किट से ही की जाती थी।

EDITORIAL

Divided we fall: on the 15th Finance Commission

Prime Minister Narendra Modi thinks vested interests are behind the "baseless" allegation that the terms of reference of the 15th Finance Commission are biased against certain States or a region. He did not name the region, but he was clearly responding to growing clamour from the southern States for a rethink on the parameters for the Commission to determine revenue-sharing between the Centre and the States. The southern States are concerned that the Commission is switching from the 1971 Census to the 2011 Census. This means States that have done relatively better to control population growth could see their allocations, as a fraction of the total resources, reduced. However, speaking in Chennai Mr. Modi said a State like Tamil Nadu would actually benefit from the Commission's mandate as the Centre has mooted incentives for those who have done well on population control. That the Prime Minister has had to wade in to try and manage a controversy, days after Finance Minister Arun Jaitley had termed it as 'needless', signals the Centre's concerns about the narrative turning against the BJP ahead of the Karnataka election.

One will have to wait till October 2019, when the Finance Commission's final recommendations come in, to assess the actual impact on States' cash flows, but framing the issue as a southern vs northern States debate is not constructive. The 14th Finance Commission had also given a 10% weightage for the 2011 Census in its calculations and there was no discernible impact on allocations to the more populous States such as Uttar Pradesh and Bihar. Also, there are other States whose share of India's total population has declined between 1971 and 2011, including West Bengal, Goa, Himachal Pradesh and Punjab. Finally, it is misleading for State governments to assume that all positive changes in demographics are a result of their own actions or policies — there are a variety of factors at play when individuals make decisions about procreation. For the Commission, it is more critical to ensure that resources reach those who need them the most and that the genuinely needy are not deprived, wherever they may be. States may spend their energies better by seeking more clarity on the Commission's other terms of reference, especially the incentives proposed for shunning populism and the move to give the Centre a larger share of the resources to build the New India it envisions by 2022. Whether mid-day meals for children or employment schemes for the rural poor amount to populist pandering is an extremely subjective call. And the Centre's attempt to increase its share from the divisible pool of resources from the present 58% is something that should concern all States, whether populous or not. -By Dr. Dheeraj Kumar Bhargava

Class XII student abducted, murdered for ransom by tenant and accomplice

GREATER NOIDA: A 19-year old class XII student was allegedly kidnapped and murdered for ransom by his tenant and an accomplice in Gulistanpurvillage in Greater Noida. The victim Tarun Sharma had left his home on Thursday evening for Sai Temple in Sector Delta I. His body was found under the ashes of garbage in a deserted location near Shani Temple, around one kilometer away from his home on Friday. Police have arrested the tenant of three years, Arun Kumar (25), and his accomplice Sajid (30), in connection with the murder, after the victim's call records revealed the accused had made frequent calls on Tarun's mobile phone and called him for a meeting that evening.

Rs 2,000 crore more needed to finish Jaypee Noida project

NEW DELHI: Suraksha and Dosti groups, which have emerged as the top contender to take over ailing Jaypee Infratech have estimated that nearly Rs 6,000 crore is required to complete work in 250 towers in Jaypee Wishtown with a funding requirement of Rs 2,000 crore after budgeting for nearly Rs 3,750 crore due from home buyers. The payment by home buyers will be linked to construction milestones.

'Land grabber' shot dead at construction site in Noida

NOIDA: A 60-year old man accused of land grabbing at massive scale was shot dead by two bike-borne criminals in Hindon Vihar in Sector 49 on Monday evening. Motilal Goyal was shot at several times from point-blank range and collapsed at the 10-acre plot where he was supervising the foundation works of a commercial plaza near Salarpur road. Around 10construction workers at the spot fled away after hearing the gunshots. Goyal was rushed to a hospital where doctors declared him brought dead. Police suspect the man was killed over old property and land dispute. Shwetabh Pandey, Circle Officer, Noida III, said that the incident took place at around 5 pm. "Goyal supervising the construction work while some workers were at the spot.

While Sudhir Valia's Suraksha group that has partnered Mumbai-based builder Dosti group has offered to commit around Rs 3,500 crore for completing the project that started nearly a decade ago, it is planning to put in place a panel of home buyers to monitor construction as part of a confidence building exercise once it receives regulatory and legal clearances to take over the company that is facing bankruptcy proceedings,

sources told TBC. "If needed the companies will offer more money to complete construction with focus being on building flats and villas that have already been sold," one of the sources privy to the discussions told TBC. Of the 31,000-odd units, nearly 29,000 been have with around 25,000 yet to be delivered. Around Rs 9,000 crore have already been invested into Jaypee Infratech,

24-yr-old Greater Noida woman alleges gangrape by two youths on Yamuna Expressway

AGRA: A 24-year-old woman, who works at a private firm in Greater Noida, was allegedly raped by two youth on the Yamuna Expressway while she was on her way home on Saturday evening. In her complaint, which was filed on Sunday, the survivor has alleged that she was offered lift in a car by one of the suspects, Salman Malik (28), who was known to her, around 5 pm. On the way, Malik picked up the other accused, Sajid (26), and they drove towards the expressway where they raped her. The medical examination of the woman has been conducted but the reports are yet to arrive. The two accused, in the meanwhile, have dubbed the charges to be false. SP Singh, station house officer (SHO) of Kotwali police station, said, "The woman hails

from Meerut and works with a chartered accountant in Greater Noida. She stays at a rented accommodation in the city. She told police that Malik had dropped her home in the past as well and hence she did not hesitate to take lift in his car on Saturday." The woman said that the duo had gagged her and raised the volume of the car's stereo before taking turns to rape her. According to police, Malik is a scrap dealer and a resident of Dadri in Greater Noida. During interrogation, he told officers that the woman had accompanied them to Agra for a wedding. Superintendent of police (SP), city, Mathura, Shrawan Kumar Singh, said, "We have registered a case under section 376 (D) (gangrape) of the IPC against the two men. Our investigations are on."

NPCL to buy 100 MW more for Greater Noida

GREATER NOIDA: The Noida Power Company Ltd (NPCL), which supplies power to Greater Noida, has signed an agreement with Power Trading Corporation of India Ltd to purchase 100 MW electricity per year to provide round-the-clock electricity to Greater Noidafrom December this year. "The agreement is signed with an aim to fulfil the mission of the state government to provide power to all. With this agreement, NPCL is confident to get transmission access as



per its requirement, both from Power Grid Corporation India Ltd's (PGCIL) central transmission utility (CTU) and Uttar Pradesh Power Transmission Ltd's (UPPTCL) state transmission utility (STU)," said R C Agarwal, managing director and CEO,

medium term power purchase agreement signed in the country, following competitive bidding through DEEP (Discovery of Efficient Electricity Price) portal of ministry of power," said Sarnath Ganguly, general manager, NPCL. NPCL is expecting nearly 400 MW demand this year which would further rise in the next few years due to accelerated industrial investments"The current supply in Greater Noida is 300 MW.

Ghaziabad schoolboy held for killing friend for not returning Rs 2,200

GHAZIABAD: An 18-yearold schoolboy was arrested on Sunday along with two other accomplices for allegedly killing a friend after being exasperated over the latter's inordinate delay in repaying a debt of Rs 2,200. The accused, who has been identified as Jogi, is a student of Class X in Shambhu Dayal Inter College in Naya Ganj area of Ghaziabad. Jogi and his two accomplices, Mohit and Deepak, who are also aged around 18 years, live in Ganeshpuri area under Sahibabad police station area. On the morning of April 13, the police had found a body lying in a park near a water tank in



Sahibabad. It was identified the same day as that of Rohit (19), who also lived in Sahibabad. "Investigations have revealed that Jogi had murdered Rohit for not returning a sum of Rs 2,200. The latter had taken this money from Jogi during the Kanwar festival last year but had been delaying its return under one pretext or the other," said circle officer, Sahibabad, DSP Rakesh Mishra. Police said Mohit and

Deepak had dropped out of studies. While Mohit used to ply a battery-operated rickshaw, Deepak had a street-food stall in Sahibabad. Rohit used to work with his brother in a switch-manufacturing firm in Site 4 Industrial Area of Sahibabad. Jogi told media persons on Sunday that he first hit Rohit on his head with a brick. He had then taken off his own T-shirt and strangled Rohit's neck. The four men had met at the park at around 9pm on April 12. "Mohit, Deepak and Rohit had got a few bottles of alcohol from Delhi. They asked me to join them for drinks. We went around for some time looking for

a desolate place for drinks. Then we decided to go to the water tank," said Jogi. The three accused men, however, said Jogi had attacked Rohit in selfdefence when he became aggressive. The three men said they had consumed a beer each on the fateful evening and topped it up with a quarter bottle of hard liquor. "We were all very inebriated. Rohit became aggressive and began to abuse me in foul language when I pestered with him to return my money which I needed urgently. When I retorted to his abuses, he went down the tank and returned with a brick to attack me. Sensing danger, I snatched the brick from him and hit it on his head. Then I took off my Tshirt and strangulated him with it till he died," said Jogi. "The next day I went to my school and attended classes as usual feigning as if nothing of this sort ever occurred," he added. Police said that the three accused were nabbed on the basis of forensic evidence and after questioning locals who claimed to have seen the four boys together for the last time on the evening of April 12. An FIR under Section 302 (murder) of the IPC was lodged on April 13 on the basis of a complaint filed by the deceased's father Rakesh

Two steal cab, held after shootout

GNOIDA: Two criminals fleeing with a stolen cab were arrested after a shootout in Dadri on Friday morning. The accused have been identified as Mohit (25) and Jitendra alias Jeetu (26), both residents of Aligarh. Two of their accomplices managed to escape in the darkness. Ram Sen Singh, SHO, Dadri police station, said four criminals had booked a taxi from Ghaziabad to Greater Noida on Thursday night. "The accused boarded the cab and reached Bisrakh. Suddenly, one of them took out a pistol and held the driver, Anil Kumar, hostage. The criminals then stole the car from the driver at gunpoint and fled," he

said. The driver immediately dialed 100 from his mobile phone and informed police. The personnel from Bisrakh police station launched a search and alerted their counterparts to beef-up checking. The criminals roamed around the city for 2-3 hours. Singh said his police team received information about the movement of criminals in the area. "We deployed a team near Luharli Road at 4.15 am. The four suspects came in a cab at the spot. The police signalled them to stop for checking but they began firing at the police and tried to speed away," Singh said.

After 94 students miss board exams, CBSE notice to Ghaziabad school

DEHRADUN: CBSE's regional office in Dehradun has sent a show-cause notice to a school in Ghaziabad which had allegedly promised schools not affiliated to CBSE to register their students for their CBSE board exams, resulting in 94 students missing the exams. The notice asked why Holy Angel's Public School's 'provisional affiliation for its secondary and senior secondary certificate level" to the CBSE should not be cancelled for violation of affiliation bye-laws of the board. Owner of the school, Siddharth Jain, told TBC that

they were yet to receive the notice. Last month, 94 class 10 students had claimed that as the schools where they are actually enrolled do not have CBSE affiliation, their registration for the board examination has been done through Holy Angel's Public School. The students alleged that they were not given admit cards when they reached Holy Angel's. The school, however, denied knowledge of having any agreement with the students' schools. An inquiry was subsequently done by the CBSE in the matter. Providing details, Ranveer Singh, regional

officer, Dehradun, CBSE said, "The school misguided the parents by saying that their students' names had been deleted by CBSE during school inspection. On further probe, it appeared that the school (in Ghaziabad) in association with some of the local non-affiliated schools, was involved in the grave practice of sponsoring unauthorised students." He added that the RO has strongly recommended de-affiliation of the school. "We will do everything we can to ensure that schools are not able to get away with such practices.

8,000 people living in 10 slums vulnerable to fire outbreaks

GHAZIABAD: Nearly 8,000 people live in 10 big slums in Indirapuram, Vasundhara, Vaishali and Kaushambi which are most vulnerable to fire, according to a survey conducted by police. The survey was conducted on the direction of the GDA, after a fire recently destroyed a slum in Indirapuram. "On April 3, over 100 hutments were gutted that displaced close to 250 families in Kanawani in Indirapuram. This was a wakeup call for us. So, on the direction of GDA vicechairperson Ritu Maheshwari, a survey was undertaken by police to identify the areas where

people live in slums," said V K Singh, officer on special duty (OSD), GDA. "Ten spots have been identified in Indirapuram, Vasundhara, Vaishali and Kaushambi where people live in slums and are most vulnerable to fire," added Singh. Such slums identified in Indirapuram are in Abhay Khand 2 with a population of 1,200 people; in Makanpur, which is inhabited by around 600 people and in Shakti Khand 4 and 2 near Kanawani gate with a population of around 4,000 people. Close to 600 people live in two slums located in Vasundhara's Sector 2A and on

the stretch between sectors 6 and 4B. A third slum located between sectors 7 and 8 is home to 250 people. In Kaushambi, close to 850 people live in two slums that have come up on a vacant plot near Radisson Blu and a police outpost. A slum in Vaishali is home to around 300 people. "The hutments which are mostly inhabited by migrant construction labourers from other states are constructed of tin shades and even polythene which is highly inflammable and in case of a fire, it has the potential to cause maximum damage to life and property.

Plaster falls off ceiling in class, 2 students hurt

GHAZIABAD: Two students attending class at a government secondary school Ghaziabad's Pasonda had a narrow escape on Thursday after a mound of plaster peeled off the ceiling and fell on them. Class VI students Inshad (13) and Rehan (14) escaped with minor injuries and their health conditions were said to be stable. Police said Inshad had suffered an injury to the leg and was admitted to GTB Hospital in Delhi. "The incident took place around 10am when a teacher was taking class. Two minor boys suffered injuries and one of them is in GTB



Hospital. The other boy didn't need to be taken to the hospital as portions of the plaster fell on his back. We have sent a report in this regard to the education department," Sahibabad circle officer DSP Rakesh Mishra said. Administrative officials, who visited the school after the accident, said some of the rooms were in dire need of repairs.



Headless bodies' case solved with arrest of victim's partner

Ghaziabad: On Sunday, Sambhal police got a major breakthrough, arresting four accused, including two women, in the matter of murder of a woman and her son whose headless bodies were found in Chimyavali village on March 18. The bodies were identified as those of Mamta alias Shahin, 35, and her 10-year-old son Karan alias Sameer. Their heads were found later on April 1 and April 8, respectively from two different locations in the area. Police said that the accused Mohammad Wahid, with whom Shahin had been living with her two children for the past year, wanted to get rid of her after he had married another woman, Armana around six months ago. Shahin was six months pregnant when she was murdered, said police. According to police officers, Armana had told her husband that she would not live with him until Mamta and her kids were killed. Briefing the media, additional director general (ADG) of Bareilly zone, Prem Prakash said, "On March 18, chowkidar Ram Ratan of Chimyavali village informed police about the headless bodies, following that we constituted 12 teams, initiating search operations to nab the accused. On Sunday morning, we got a tip-off, following

which we arrested the four accused from Chandausi bus One of stand. their accomplices is still at large." Prakash said that one Kallu, a resident of Chimyavali village who had been a history sheeter, had got his daughter Armana married to Wasim around six months ago. "Before this, Wasim had come in contact with Shahin in Ghaziabad where he was an auto-rickshaw driver. He lived there next to Shahin's house. He had brought her and her two kids around one year ago to Sambhal and started living with him. We have rescued Shahin's daughter Manju alias Zainab from their house. She has been handed over to child welfare society," Prakash added. Police said that they have also recovered two sharp-edged weapons used in beheading the victim. Besides, they also recovered the Adhaar card and identity card of boy for his school in Ghaziabad. Superintendent of police (SP) of Sambhal, Ravi Shankar Chhabi said, "The other two arrested accused are Kallu and his wife Shufia, who were Armana's parents." Chhabi said, "After search operations from Moradabad to Ghaziabad did not turn up anything, we changed our line of inquiry and focused on the village where the bodies were found

Ghaziabad: Six people were arrested for fleecing insurance holders policy in Krishnanagaron Sunday. The police recovered Rs 1.1 lakh cash, 6 laptops, 67 mobile phones, 23 ATM cards of different banks, 15 bank passbooks, 50 SIM cards, 5 voter ID cards, 5 Aadhaar cards, a motorcycle and other documents from them. SHO Krishnanagar Anjani Pandey said the gang was being led by Aman Kumar. The gang members, introducing themselves as officers from insurance companies, would call policy holders and tell them about bonus amounts from the

customers of various companies. They would ask customers to deposit an amount to withdraw the bonus. The gang had been operational in south Delhi where they had an office in the guise of a cyber café. They had been arrested by the special cell of Delhi Police but had been out on bail because of lack of evidence. The gang then set up a base in Ghaziabad but after police raids, fled to Kanpur. There they opened a 'centre' and took Rs 5,000 each from villagers in the name of opening their bank accounts.

Road agency identifies 14 jam spots in Ghaziabad, suggests widening of streets

GHAZIABAD: The Central Road Research Institute (CRRI) on Wednesday submitted a report after it was entrusted with the responsibility of preparing a comprehensive mobility plan for the city by the GDA. The CRRI has identified 14 'problematic' intersections in Ghaziabadand suggested some measures to ensure seamless flow of traffic on these stretches. In Wednesday's meeting, the GDA also asked CRRI to submit a short-term mobility plan Indirapuramtownship and Modinagar in one week. CRRI director Prof Satish Chandra said, "We have sought the base plan for vehicular traffic from GDA.
