आयकर विभाग ने भेजे
सात हजार से ज्यादा
लोगों को नोटिस

गाजियाबाद : महंगी संपत्ति खरीदने और बेचने वालों पर आयकर विभाग नजर रखे हुए है। विभाग ने गाजियाबाद जोन के तीनों जिलों के सात हजार से ज्यादा ऐसे लोगों को नोटिस दिए हैं, जिन्होंने 30 लाख रुपये से अधिक की संपत्ति खरीदी है। जोन के गाजियाबाद, बुलंदशहर व हापुड़ तीनों जिलों में आयकर चोरी से महंगी चल-अचल संपत्ति खरीदने वालों पर विभाग ने शिकंजा कसना शुरू कर दिया है। विभाग ने वित्तीय वर्ष 2018-19 में अब तक हुई सम्पत्तियों की रजिस्ट्री का ब्योरा तैयार किया है।

नैनीताल बैंक के वाइस प्रेसिडेंट के क्रेडिट कार्ड से चार लाख ठगे

गाजियाबाद : नैनीताल बैंक के एसोसिएट वाइस प्रेसिडेंट के क्रेडिट कार्ड से चार लाख रुपये की ठगी का मामला सामने आया है। आरोप एसबीआई के सेल्स मैनेजर है, जिसके माध्यम से उन्होंने कार्ड लिया था और फिर इसे बंद भी कराने को दिया था। आरोपित ने कार्ड के साथ अपना नंबर रजिस्टर्ड करा लिया और खरीदारी करता रहा। पेमेंट के लिए जब बैंक की ओर से उन्हें फोन किया गया तो जानकारी हुई। कोर्ट के आदेश पर ऊधम सिंह नगर के पंतनगर थाने में दर्ज मुकदमा शनिवार को नगर कोतवाली में ट्रांसफर किया गया है।

वर्ल्ड टीबी-डे के उपलक्ष्य में एनईए ऑडीटोरियम सेक्टर-6 नोएडा में कार्यक्रम आयोजित

नोएडा : ट्यूबरक्यूलोसिस यानी टीबी को वैसे तो बीते जमाने की बीमारी के तौर पर देखा जाता है, लेकिन तमाम कोशिशों के बाद भी टीबी के मरीजों की संख्या हर साल बढ़ रही है। यही वजह है कि विश्व स्वास्थ्य संगठन की ओर से पूरी दुनिया में हर साल 24 मार्च को टीबी डे मनाया जाता है। इसका मकसद इस रोग के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ाना है। वैसे तो टीबी लाइलाज नहीं है लेकिन अगर इसके इलाज में लापरवाही बरती जाती है तो यह जानलेवा भी साबित हो सकती है। स्वास्थ्य विभाग की ओर से टीबी की रोकथाम के लिए लगातार प्रयास किए जा रहे हैं। सरकारी अस्पतालों में तो टीबी का फ्री में इलाज भी



किया जाता है। ये बातें शनिवार को रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन (आरएचएएम) व नेशनल हेल्थ मिशन गौतमबुद्धनगर द्वारा सेक्टर-6 नोएडा स्थित एनईए ऑडीटोरियम में वर्ल्ड टीबी-डे के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित हेल्थ टॉक में गौतमबुद्धनगर के सीएमओ डा.

अनुराग भार्गव ने कही। इस दौरान लोगों को जागरूक करने के लिए टीबी पर प्रकाशित एक पुस्तक का भी निशुल्क वितरण किया गया। मुख्य अतिथि सीएमओ डा. अनुराग भार्गव ने कहा कि टीबी बैक्टीरिया से होने वाली बीमारी है, जो हवा के जरिए एक इंसान

से दूसरे में फैलती है। शरीर में यह आमतौर पर फेफड़ों से शुरू होती है। देश में सबसे ज्यादा फेफड़ों के ही टीबी मरीज हैं। हालांकि ब्रेन, यूटरस, मुंह, लीवर, किडनी, गला, हड्डी आदि शरीर के विभिन्न हिस्सों में भी टीबी के मरीज मिल रहे हैं। टीबी रोग के विशेषज्ञों के अनुसार टीबी का बैक्टीरिया हवा के जरिए फैलता है। खांसने और छींकने के दौरान मुंह-नाक से निकलने वाली बारीक बूंदों से यह इंफेक्शन होता है। फेफड़ों के अलावा जितनी भी तरह की टीबी होती है वह एक से दूसरे में फैलने वाली नहीं होती।

GDA seeks feeder buses, DMRC says it's not our policy

GZB: The Ghaziabad Development Authority (GDA) has urged the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) to include a provision for feeder buses in its revised detailed project report (DPR) for Noida Electronic City to Mohan Nagar route under the phase 3 project. DMRC, however, has reminded the GDA that it does provide feeder bus services in areas other than Delhi. The GDA now has decided to take up the issue in a meeting with the UP government on March 18. "Even though DMRC does not provide feeder bus services in its projects outside Delhi as a matter of policy, we have still

asked them to include it in the revised DPR that they are preparing for the Electronic City to Mohan Nagar metro route under the phase 3 project," said Kanchan Verma, the GDA vice-chairperson. "Nevertheless, the issue will be taken up at the meeting with the principal secretary that is scheduled to take place on March 18," she added. The meeting has been primarily called to discuss the funding pattern for the phase 3 project. According to sources, the GDA will push for the same funding pattern that had been adopted for the Dilshad Garden-New Bus Stand metro corridor.

गौतमबुद्धनगर जिले के क्षय रोग अधिकारी डा.शिरीष जैन जैन ने कहा कि टीबी का बैक्टीरिया शरीर के जिस भी हिस्से में होता है, उसके टिश्यू को पूरी तरह नष्ट कर देता है और इससे उस अंग का काम प्रभावित होता है। जैसे फेफड़ों में टीबी है तो फेफड़े धीरे-धीरे बेकार हो जाते हैं, यूटरस में है तो इन्फर्टिलिटी (बांझपन) की वजह बनती है, हड्डी में है तो हड्डी को गला देती है, ब्रेन में है तो मरीज को दौरे पड़ सकते हैं, लीवर में टीबी होने पेट में पानी भरने लगता है।

रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन के चेयर डा.धीरज भार्गव ने कहा कि टीबी पहचाने के लिए शरीर के जिस हिस्से में टीबी है, उसके मुताबिक टेस्ट होता है। फेफड़ों की टीबी के लिए मरीज के बलगम की जांच होती है जो सरकारी अस्पतालों और डॉट्स सेंटर पर फ्री में होती है। अगर बलगम में टीबी नहीं मिलता है तो एएफबी कल्चर की जांच होती है। इसकी रिपोर्ट 6 हफ्ते में आती है। इस जांच में यह भी पता चल जाता है कि किस लेवल की टीबी है और दवा असर करेगी या नहीं। सरकार ने इस टेस्ट के लिए 2000 रुपये की लिमिट तय की हुई है। किडनी की टीबी के लिए यूरिन कल्चर टेस्ट होता है। यूटरस की टीबी के लिए सर्वाइकल स्वीब लेकर जांच होती है।

मैक्स अस्पताल वैशाली के डा. शरद जोशी ने लोगों को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि यदि बच्चों को टीबी हो जाए तो काफी घातक होती है। इसलिए पैदा होते ही बच्चे को बीसीजी का टीका लगाया जाता है। बच्चे को टीबी हो जाए तो उसके पूरे शरीर में टीबी फैल सकती है। बच्चे के दिमाग तक इसका असर हो जाए तो उस स्थिति को मैनेजइंटिस कहा जाता है। उन्होंने कहा कि सर्वे में यह जानकारी निकलकर सामने आई है कि इस समय दुनिया भर में एड्स के बाद सबसे ज्यादा मौतें टीबी से ही हो रही हैं। शहरों का प्रदूषण टीबी रोग के बढ़ने की सबसे प्रमुख वजह है। सड़क पर उड़ने वाली धूल-मिट्टी और कंस्ट्रक्शन वर्क से होने वाला प्रदूषण लोगों को तेजी से टीबी की तरफ धकेल रहा है।

टीबी से कैसे करें बचाव?

- टीबी से बचने का सबसे आसान तरीका है कि इम्यूनिटी मजबूत करना।
- न्यूट्रिशन से भरपूर खासकर प्रोटीन डाइट (सोयाबीन, दालें, मछली, अंडा, पनीर आदि) का सेवन करना चाहिए।
- भीड़-भाड़ वाली जगहों पर जाने से बचना चाहिए।
- कम रोशनी वाली और गंदी जगहों पर नहीं रहना चाहिए।

- टीबी के मरीज से कम-से-कम एक मीटर की दूरी बनाकर रहना चाहिए।
- ऐसे मरीज को मास्क पहनाकर रखना चाहिए।
- टीबी के मरीज किसी एक प्लास्टिक बैग में थूकें और उसमें फिनाइल डालकर अच्छी तरह बंदकर डस्टबिन में डाल दें।

EDITORIAL

Decoding the Priyanka gamble

“It is my hope that you (Modi) become Prime Minister again.” This was the parting wish of Mulayam Singh Yadav on the last day of the 16th Lok Sabha. How will this wish of the patriarch of Samajwadi Party resonate in Uttar Pradesh as the country officially enters poll season? It would be instructive to look at some of the recent developments to see how the two main political parties are positioning themselves.

On the BJP front, three big developments in recent weeks have strengthened the position of both Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the party. First, the announcement of 10 per cent reservation for the economically weaker sections in the general category has been a unique and unqualified success. It is to the credit of Modi, and the trust he generates, that he could get this done without any social tension. Second, the decision to completely exempt from income tax those whose taxable income is up to Rs 5 lakh has been met with uniform cheer. That this move is likely to benefit more than 80 per cent of the taxpayers and immediately contribute to an increase in their disposable income indicates how well-thought out this decision was. Third, the PM Kisan income augmentation amount has been rolled out at an unprecedented speed and unlike the hassles associated with getting farm loan waivers, this is directly reaching the farmers’ accounts. These three recent announcements, along with the milestone of every home in India now being fully electrified, the remarkable success of Ayushman Bharat, the human story of more than 15 million families now having the security of their own homes through Awaas Yojana, the 70-million milestone of Ujjwala Yojana and the firm control on inflation make the development basket of Modi quite irresistible. Add to it, the bold and decisive action in Balakot and Modi has further strengthened his formidable image as a decisive leader.

On the Congress front, the Priyanka Gandhi Vadra card has finally been played. She comes with her strengths. Anecdotal evidence suggests that she is more natural than Rahul Gandhi when it comes to connecting with people, she has more flair than her brother and because she is fresh, she does not have the baggage of being labelled a failure like Rahul Gandhi. Arguably, Priyanka Gandhi Vadra is also less likely to make the gaffes that her brother has made a habit of. Of course, she has her own baggage of Robert Vadra to deal with.

If we consider India’s electoral verdicts since the first elections in 1952, we would find that no government at the Centre, other than the Congress, has been re-elected. The Janata Party experiment in 1977 failed after three years in office. As did the experiments in 1989, 1996, and 1998. Atal Bihari Vajpayee did technically return in 1999, after getting elected in 1998. But that term lasted just a year; so 1999 was, for all purposes, a first term. In 2004, after five years in office, Vajpayee too lost.

After complaints, school served notice for fee hike proposal

NOIDA: The district fee regulation committee (DFRC) of Gautam Budh Nagar has issued a notice to Billabong High School, asking the management to explain the rationale behind hiking fees for the upcoming academic session. Similar notices to three more schools in Noida are to be issued soon, the district inspector of schools (DIOS) said. Over 90 parents of Billabong High School had recently submitted a complaint to DFRC, under the banner of All Noida School Parents’ Association (ANSPA), claiming that they had been given an estimate by the school for the upcoming academic session, which was 21.5% more than the fee charged in



2018-19. “We examined the compliant by the parents and issued a show-cause notice to the school. We have also received complaints from parents of Cambridge School, Ryan International and Khaitan School and will be asking for explanation from them in the coming days,” DIOS PK Upadhyay said. The school had, however, explained to the parents that the fee was increased on the basis of calculations done as per the Uttar Pradesh Fee Regulation Act (2018). “Parents of

Cambridge School have shared the slip of proposed fee for the academic session of 2019-20. The fee asked for by the school for the next session includes a component for admission fee,” said K Arunachalam, general secretary of ANSPA. “How come schools are issuing such bills even when the Uttar Pradesh Self-Financed Independent Schools (Fee Regulation) Act is in place for the past one year? We are shocked to see school openly violating the act,” he added. ANSPA said it also wanted to draw the attention of the government to this issue that “simply introducing an act is of no use unless enforcement devices are put in place”.

Dance teacher, 2 others ‘beaten up’ by Sector 20 cops

NOIDA: A dance teacher has alleged that she, along with her colleague and a minor student, was harassed and beaten up by officials of Noida’s Sector 20 police station on International Women’s Day after they complained about three drunk youths who allegedly tried to hit her with their car. According to Swati Kumari, the 27-year-old owner of Swati School of Dance in Sector 27, she was waiting with her colleague Amar (21) for an auto in Sector 18 on Friday night. “Around 9.30 pm, three youths came in an Alto at the spot and tried to run over my foot. A PCR van was

parked nearby but the cops inside ignored the incident, despite having seen everything. I then complained about the youths to Atta chowki cops who said that it was an everyday affair,” Swati said. She said the policemen then asked the youths to leave the spot and allegedly started abusing her. As Swati and her colleagues tried to reason with them to lodge a complaint, her student Rohit was passing by the area and stopped to see what was happening. “I clicked a picture of the cops peacefully and tried to leave the area when they surrounded us and started manhandling us.

Same properties sold to many, 1 more held from Noida

NEW DELHI: A director of a real estate firm has been arrested from Noida for selling single properties to multiple people at a time. The company would offer office and residential apartments to buyers through advertisements in newspapers and on television. A case was registered in Delhi after the buyers found that the apartment they had booked for crores of rupees was also owned by several others. Additional CP (EOW) Suvashis Chaudhary said they had received a complaint from one of the homebuyers.

Tackle strays, tweet residents in selfies with cows

NOIDA: To counter the menace of stray cattle disrupting traffic across the city, a group of residents has started a campaign called “Selfie with cows”, wherein they click selfies with bovines, post them on Twitter and tag authorities. Residents have demanded that stray cattle crowding the main roads be shifted to the new cow shelter at Wazidpur in Sector 63. The campaign was started by three residents — Amit Gupta (Sector 77), Abhay Pandey (Sector 121) and Sachin Goyal (Sector 76). On Monday, the first day of the campaign, the



residents, including some traffic volunteers, clicked four pictures and uploaded them on WhatsApp groups. The residents have identified multiple spots across Noida where cattle continue to occupy space. These include the road between A and B blocks in Sector 62, the road opposite the fire office in Sector 5, DSC

road near the u-turn opposite Kesar Garden Apartments in Sector 48, the NTPC underpass, and the area opposite Skytech market. Gupta said that despite Noida getting another gaushala, stray cattle continue to take over the city’s streets. “There have been two accidents near the u-turn opposite Kesar Garden Apartments in January in which two people died. The Noida Authority has finally started another gaushala in Wazidpur. The Authority should start sending the cattle there now,” he said.

100 guests at party? Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation says you need its nod

GHAZIABAD: The Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation (GMC) has issued a notice asking residents to seek its permission before organising any party or gathering in which 100 or more people are likely to attend. The GMC cited the Solid Waste Management Rules of 2016 and said the order also required caterers and tent operators to make arrangements for segregation of dry and wet waste, failing which they would be penalised. “We have issued notices to residents, caterers and tent operators in the city that they

need to seek permission from us at least three days before organising a party or event where more than 100 people are invited,” said Dinesh Chandra, the municipal commissioner. “It is also mandatory for organisers to make arrangements for segregation of dry and wet waste, which would finally be sent to the GMC’s collection centres,” he added. The UP government had recently convened a meeting of several municipal corporations, including the GMC, on solid waste management.

First-year biotech student ends his life in apartment

NOIDA: A first-year biotechnology student of Amity University was found hanging from the ceiling fan of his flat in a housing society on Monday night. Utkarsh Shukla, who was originally from Rewa in Madhya Pradesh, probably ended his life due to the pressure of studies, police said. According to police, 23-year-old Utkarsh, a student of IIInd semester of biotechnology, was staying in the flat in Amrapali Sapphire society along with two flatmates. His friends were not at home when Utkarsh allegedly committed suicide.

Parents want school to reduce fee, file complaint

NOIDA: Around 90 parents of Billabong High School in the city have filed a complaint with the district fee regulation committee and demanded that the school revise its fee structure for the upcoming academic session. The parents said they had been given an estimate by the school for the upcoming session, which was 21.5% more than the fee charged in 2018-19. The parents met under the banner of All Noida School Parents Association (ANSPA) and write to the district fee regulation committee (DFRC). The parents have filed the complaint after seeking a response from the school. “We have submitted the complaint with the DFRC



and officials have assured us that a notice is being sent to the school. Any fee hike by schools after implementation of the Uttar Pradesh Self-Financed Independent Schools (Fee Regulation) Act will have to be guided by the Act. If any excess hike is noticed, financial penalties along with refund of excessive charges may be imposed,” said K Arunachalam, general secretary of ANSPA. “While there has been a stiff rise

GST fraud of Rs 90 crore unearthed, GZB resident held

MEERUT: Sleuths of the office of Director General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) have arrested one Rajesh Goyal, 42, a resident of New Panchwati Colony in Ghaziabad, for issuing fake invoices of more than Rs 400 crore through 50 shell companies to illegally avail of or utilize input tax credit to the tune of Rs 90 crore. This comes weeks after a 27-year-old Chartered Accountant (CA) was arrested for running a similar racket encashing input tax credit of Rs 50 crores illegally. Arpit Saxena Senior

Intelligence Officer said, Goyal was operating since 2017 and over time created 50 shell firms. Investigations are on and more names will crop up soon.” Explaining the modus operandi, Manish Goel, additional director general (ADG) of DGGI, Meerut zone unit, said, “The accused through these bogus companies which were actually registered with GST -- issued tax invoices despite the fact none of these companies dealt with or supplied any goods and services. These fake invoices were sold to clients.

6 members of extortion gang held in Greater Noida

NOIDA: A man wanted in 18 criminal cases and five of his associates have been arrested in Greater Noida after a gunfight with the Special Task Force (STF) of the Uttar Pradesh police, officials said Wednesday. The gang, which extorted money from several companies and acquired work contracts by pressurising them, was held on Tuesday night, officials said. The group's leader, Pawan Nagar, was carrying a reward of Rs 25,000 and had 18 criminal cases registered against him at a police station in Greater Noida, a senior official of Noida STF said.

27 lakh to vote from Ghaziabad, focus on low turnout areas

GREATER NOIDA: A cash van was seized from Behlolpur Phase 3 area on Thursday afternoon and Noida Police has claimed that the vehicle was ferrying Rs 1.37 crore without proper documents. Police suspect that the cash was being ferried in violation to the RBI guidelines and it was meant for political parties ahead of the elections. Police said the driver and the helper have been detained. The van belonged to a company called Cash Management Solutions (CMS) and its representatives said the money was meant for ATMs in Noida. They alleged



that five men from the company have been detained illegally. The incident took place near Behlolpur Phase 3, Noida, around 2pm on Thursday. The police stopped the blue and white van, with registration number DL 1L T 1910, at a checkpost. “We seized a cash van with over Rs 1 crore for which there was no solid document produced by the driver.

Director of Earth ‘shell’ company held

NOIDA: Aditya Goel, son of one of the directors of Earth Infrastructure Pvt Ltd who is lodged in Tihar jail along with three other directors of the company, has been arrested, claimed officers of the crime branch. Police said Aditya was picked up from his house in Delhi’s Inderpuri and produced in a Surajpur court on Tuesday. Aditya, officers said, is the director of at least two of the multiple shell companies of the group. He owns an 1,800 sqm plot in Goa and he and his mother are directors in Julian Infracon Private Limited in Delhi. This is the third such arrest by police in the case.

DU student molested, robbed in Ghaziabad autorickshaw

GHAZIABAD: An 18-year-old Delhi University student was allegedly molested and robbed inside a moving autorickshaw that she had boarded to reach her Indrapuram home from Electronic City metro station on Tuesday night. The incident came days after a 30-year-old dentist was gagged and robbed inside a moving autorickshaw by four men who drove her around Ghaziabad and Noida for over an hour. The girl, a BCom first-year student, was returning from her college and had boarded the auto from near CISF cut around

10.10pm on Tuesday after getting down at the metro station. She alleged that four persons who were inside the auto molested and robbed her of Rs 200 and then dumped her on Vishwakarma Road in a semi-conscious state. She was slapped repeatedly, and suffered severe swelling on the face, head and other parts of her body. Based on her complaint, an FIR against unidentified persons was registered under sections 394 (voluntarily causing hurt in committing robbery) and 354 of the IPC at Vijay Nagar police station on Wednesday.

BJP names VK Singh as candidate for Ghaziabad seat

GHAZIABAD: Gen Vijay Kumar Singh's (retd) name figured in BJP's first list of 184 candidates for upcoming Lok Sabha polls. The party has reposed trust in Singh and have been yet again given him ticket to contest Ghaziabad parliamentary seat which he had won in 2014 general elections with a record margin. "We are thankful to the party and people that they have reposed trust in VK Singh by giving him ticket for Ghaziabad seat" said Mrinalini Singh, Gen VK Singh's (retd) daughter after the announcement. "During his tenure he has done lot of

work for Ghaziabad -- opening of Dilshad Garden-Shaheed Sthal New Bus Adda metro line, civil terminal from Hindon IAF base and if he wins this time which I am sure he and his priority will be to ensure 'jam-mukt Ghaziabad' and to carry forward pending projects like Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Expressway, RRTS corridor among others" said Mrinalini. Considered a political novice when he joined BJP in March 2014, Singh had already started making right moves soon after he retired as Army chief in 2012. His fallout with the then UPA government over age issue led

him to participate in two anti-UPA government protests led by Yoga Guru Baba Ramdev and anti-corruption crusader Anna Hazare that was sweeping across nation at that time. On one occasion, he had famously compared the then UPA government rule with situation that existed in 1975 and had said from Jantar Mantar, where he had gone to participate in Anna's agitation that 'When I evaluate the country's present condition, it is similar to that of 1975' so when he decided to take a plunge into active politics BJP was his natural choice of party. The BJP which at that

time was riding on Modi was soon to repose trust in Singh who was given high profile Ghaziabad Lok Sabha seat to contest which was considered a safe seat for BJP. The opposition in response to this too fielded its high profile candidates which included Raj Babbar from Congress and Shazia Ilmi who fought on AAP ticket. A high pitched political battle ensued in the 2014 Lok Sabha election campaign in Ghaziabad parliamentary constituency and any doubts that opposition was giving a tough fight to was laid to rest when results were announced.

Surendra Kumar Munni out, Suresh Bansal is SP-BSP candidate from Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: Former BSP MLA Suresh Bansal's name was announced as the SP-BSP alliance candidate from Ghaziabad by the Samajwadi Party (SP) on Friday. He replaced Surendra Kumar Munni, who had been named the candidate from here a week ago. A three-time MLA, Munni currently holds the post of the SP president in Ghaziabad. The announcement was made soon after Bansal (76) took active membership of the SP in front of party workers at his home in Kavi Nagar. This is the second time that Munni's candidature has been shot down after he was nominated to contest the election. In

2017, the SP had given him the ticket to contest the Assembly polls from Muradnagar, but he was soon replaced by a Congress member after an alliance was forged between the two parties. Munni said he respected the party high command's decision and refrained from giving any statement on why his name was dropped once again. Bansal thanked senior leaders of both the SP and BSP for considering his name and said he had got permission from BSP supremo Mayawati for taking membership of its alliance partner. "I respect both Mayawati ji and Akhilesh Yadav ji.

Parties capitalise on Holi Milan for people-connect

GHAZIABAD/NOIDA: Political parties and their candidates may not have officially launched campaigns for the general elections, but most of them are capitalising on 'Holi Milan' programme to connect to people. But, they are refraining from calling such meetings as 'Holi Milan' to avoid model code of conduct violation. In Ghaziabad, BJP's prospective candidate and incumbent MP, Gen VK Singh (retd), held as many as 20 programmes across the city on Wednesday, during which he met residents. Singh also visited houses of his

party workers and discussed with them BJP's agenda. "He first visited Raj Nagar and then participated in 'Holi Milan' programme organised by the traders' associations in Raj Nagar, Ashok Nagar, Navug Market, Tigri cut and Nandgram areas," said a BJP functionary. "In the evening, he attended a Holi Dahan event in Shastri Nagar and met residents of Vaishali at 'chai pe charcha'," he added. Congress candidate for Ghaziabad seat, Dolly Sharma, said she would spend her day strategising with senior leaders on Holi.

Collapsed building: As toll reaches 7, at least 20 still trapped under the rubble

DHARWAD: The toll in the building crash in Dharwad rose to seven with the rescue team recovering five more bodies on Wednesday. Regional commissioner Tushar Girinath, who is also the administrator of Hubballi-Dharwad Municipal Corporation (HDMC), has ordered a magisterial inquiry into the incident. As many as 55 people, including three women, were rescued and shifted to various hospitals in the twin cities. It is suspected that 20-30 people, including 12 girl students, are trapped under the debris. Their

relatives were waiting near the spot. The tragic under-construction building collapse in Dharwad has lessons for every city. The greed to reap quick dividends can make owners of commercial structures lax in following norms. With this kind of approach, building owners tend to flout structural norms, at times building extra floors like the one in Dharwad. These go unnoticed in the absence of frequent audits by the authorities. Tuesday's building collapse could have been avoided had the authorities cracked down on

defaulters after the 2016 railway parcel office building crash in Hubballi. The Natural Disaster Response Force (NDRF) team, which took over the rescue operation, struggled to reach the girls as they were surrounded by collapsed concrete pillars. The girls responded to calls in the beginning, but their voices weakened later. "After hearing their voices in the morning, we supplied them glucose and water and stepped up the operation to remove the blocks. However, as the clock ticked, there was no response from them,"

deputy commissioner Deepa Cholan said. Prakash Kudatarkar, owner of a cyber café in the building said the girls were at the facility to apply online for jobs in the Regional Rural Bank. Some of them were playing online games at the café when the building came crashing down. The deceased are Salim Makandar, 35, Ashit Hiremath, 28, and his father Mahesh Hiremath, 62, Mehboob Raichur, 48, Mehboob Desai, 55, and Aslam Sheikh. Authorities could not identify the seventh deceased.

Illicit liquor worth Rs 28 lakh seized, 2 held in Ghaziabad

GHAZIABAD: Over 750 cartons of illicit liquor worth Rs 28.2 lakh were seized in Loni on Monday and two persons were arrested. The huge cache of liquor was to be smuggled to Loni from Haryana ahead of the Lok Sabha elections, police said. After receiving information about a truck carrying illegal liquor, the police setup a check post on Ram Vihar road on Sunday night. “Around 3.30 pm on Monday, we spotted the truck and chased it. Soon after, we seized the vehicle and



arrested two men,” police said. Sanjay Verma, SHO of Loni police station told TBC that the arrested persons were identified as Bal Kishan (38) from Haryana and Amarchand (29) from Ghaziabad. “During questioning, they told us that some people had handed over the truck to them at the Haryana-Delhi border,” he added.

Gupta is currently

in judicial custody since his arrest from Madhya Pradesh last year for allegedly acquiring 57.1 hectares of land at an inflated rate from relatives and acquaintances though the land actually had no utility. Several others involved in the previous scam are also behind bars. The latest scam orchestrated by the ‘P C Gupta gang’ in a modus operandi similar to the previous land fraud case was unearthed after current YEIDA chairman Prabhat Kumar initiated an inquiry into the purchase deals of 14.5 hectares in Midhawali village of Hathras district in 2014.

NOIDA: Former Paytm vice-president Sonia Dhawan was granted bail by the Allahabad high court and released from jail about four days ago. The development comes almost five months after Sonia was arrested, along with two others, for allegedly trying to blackmail Paytm founder Vijay Sharma. Village gains from ‘adoption’ by MP but airport plan sparks worry

NOIDA: Neemka Shahjahanpur, a small village 60 km from Noida off the expressway in Jewar, was adopted by Gautam Budh Nagar MP Mahesh Sharma in November 2014 under Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana. During his first visit there in January 2015, Sharma announced he would ensure employment for village youth, free Wifi coverage and better infrastructure, among other things. Neemka, which has a population of 5,600, is located nearly 40km from Pari Chowk in Greater Noida. In the last five years, the village has

made some small, but significant, progress. The pond is cleaner than before, the village has got an interlocked footpath, a 200-kilolitre tank and 360 household toilets. An NGO has been roped in for a digital literacy programme in its primary school. However, the village lacks cleanliness and solid waste management. There aren’t adequate hospital facilities, and a proper drainage system is much needed. Another major worry for the locals is the fact that the UP government recently notified the village as “urban”.

This gang of 8 robbed commuters after offering lifts, busted

GREATER NOIDA: A gang of eight men was arrested from near the Sector 40 U-turn for allegedly robbing commuters on the pretext of giving them lifts. The accused were identified as Pushpendra, Ravi Kumar and Shiv Kumar, residents of Aligarh. The others are Kamal, Javed, and Manish, who are from Dankaur, along with Bhole Ram and Manoj, who are residents of Ecotech 1 and 3 areas, respectively. Police said two cabs, which are mostly likely stolen and were used to rob the commuters at gunpoint, were recovered from the gang.

Student hangs herself, ex-boyfriend booked

NOIDA: A third-year LLB student of Galgotias University allegedly committed suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling fan at her paying guest accommodation in Sector Alpha 2 on Friday afternoon. Police said the 22-year-old woman was allegedly being harassed by her ex-boyfriend who threatened to show some of her objectionable pictures to her father. Both the man and the woman were from Jhansi in Uttar Pradesh. They had been in a relationship for the past few years, but broke up in January. On Friday, the woman’s ex-boyfriend had reached her father’s office in

Jhansi from where he allegedly called her once again and threatened to show her pictures. “I saw him outside my office on Friday but did not know the reason,” said the woman’s father to police. The woman’s younger sister, who lived with her at the paying guest accommodation, said her sister took her life around 1.30pm, minutes after she ended a conference call with her ex-boyfriend and her college friend. The victim’s sister is a first-year student in the same university. “During the conference call, her ex-boyfriend asked me how long I knew her.

तेजाब हमला निर्मम अपराध, किसी भी तरह क्षमा योग्य नहीं : सुप्रीम कोर्ट

नई दिल्ली : सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने तेजाब हमले को 'असभ्य व निर्मम' करार देते हुए कहा कि यह अपराध क्षमा करने योग्य नहीं है। शीर्ष अदालत ने दो दोषियों को पीड़ित लड़की को डेढ़-डेढ़ लाख रुपये अतिरिक्त मुआवजा देने का आदेश देते हुए यह टिप्पणी की। दोनों दोषी 2004 में 19 वर्षीय लड़की पर तेजाब फेंकने के मामले में पांच साल की सजा काट चुके हैं। कोर्ट ने हिमाचल प्रदेश सरकार को भी पीड़ित मुआवजा योजना के तहत पीड़ित लड़की को मुआवजा देने का निर्देश दिया। जस्टिस एएम खानविलकर और अजय रस्तोगी की पीठ ने कहा कि वास्तव में इस बात से इनकार नहीं किया जा
