गाजियाबाद : आगामी त्योहारी सीजन को लेकर खा सुरक्षा एवं औषि विभाग ने कमर कस ली है। त्योहारी सीजन में आम लोगों की सेहत को देखते हुए विभाग द्वारा विशो अभियान चलाया जाएगा। अभियान के दौरान खा सामग्री के नमूने लेकर मिलावटखोरों के खिलाफ कार्रवाई की जाएगी। मिलावटखोरी से निपटने के लिए विभाग द्वारा ब्लू ड्क्षप्रट तैयार कर लिया गया है। अभियान नवरात्र से शुरू होकर दीपावली और छठ पूजा तक निरंतर चलाया जाएगा। इस दौरान जिले भर से खा सामग्रियों के नमने लिए जाएंगे। बता दें कि

त्योहारी सीजन के दौरान जिले में मिलावटखोर सक्रिय हो जाते हैं और खा सामग्रियों में जमकर मिलावट करते हैं। इससे न केवल खा सामग्री की गुणवत्ता प्रभावित होती है बल्कि लोगों के स्वास्थ्य पर विपरीत प्रभाव पड़ता है। खासकर दूध व दूध से निर्मित सामग्री पनीर, मावा मिठाईयों समेत घी तेल में सबसे अधिक मिलावट की जाती है। इसको लेकर विभाग पहले से ही सक्रिय हो गया है। विभाग द्वारा शीघ्र ही मिलावटखोरी के खिलाफ बड़े स्तर पर अभियान चलाकर मिलावटखोरी करने वालों के खिलाफ कार्रवाई की जाएगी।

GZB gets a plant to treat garbage collected from religious places daily

GHAZIABAD: Waste generated from religious places like temples are often dumped in rivers, causing pollution. To put an end to this menace, the Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation on Saturday inaugurated a plant in Sai Upvan area to convert waste into compost. The plant, built at a cost of Rs 30 lakh, will be operational from October 2, the officials said. “The city’s religious places generates about one to 1.5 tonnes of what we call religious waste every day in the form of flowers, leaves etc,” said CP Singh, municipal

commissioner. “Due to religious sentiments, people generally do not dispose waste in garbage bins or elsewhere. Rather, they prefer dumping the same in rivers like the Hindon or Yamuna, which adds to the pollution in these rivers. So, we thought of an idea to separately collect and treat these waste materials,” Singh added. Before giving the plan a shape, the municipal corporation first conducted a survey and identified 91 religious sites, including temples, gurdwaras, mosques and churches.

अब पराली जलाने वालों पर नजर रखेगा सचल दस्ता

गाजियाबाद : पराली जलाने पर नजर रखने व कार्रवाई के लिए प्रशासन ने सचल दस्ते का गठन किया है। ये सचल दस्ता क्षेत्र में निकल कर पराली जलाने वाले किसानों के ऊपर कानूनी कार्रवाई करेगा। जिलाधिकारी के आदेश पर सचल दस्ते का गठन किया गया है। बताते चलें कि एनजीटी के पराली जलाने पर बनाए गए सख्त नियमों के बाद प्रशासन इसे रोकने में लगा हुआ है। कृषि विभाग इसके लिए जागकता शिविर लगा रहा है। जिसमें किसानों को पराली जलाने से पर्यावरण को होने वाले नुकसान बताए जा रहे हैं। वहीं गठित हुआ सचल दस्ता पराली जलाने वाले के ऊपर कानूनी कार्रवाई करना सुनिश्चित करेगा।

ढाई लाख लोगों को साल के अंत तक मिल जाएगा पानी

गाजियाबाद : मेरठ रोड किनारे बसी कॉलोनियों में इस वर्ष के अंत तक पेयजल आपूर्ति शुरू हो जाएगी। अमृत योजना के तहत नलकूप, भूमिगत जलाशय, टंकी बनाने और पानी की पाइपलाइन बिछाने का कार्य लगभग पूरा होने वाला है। इसके बाद कनेक्शन देने का कार्य किया जाएगा। दीनदयालपुरी, हिंडन विहार, सिहानी और मरियम नगर वार्ड में 20 कॉलोनियां आती हैं। इनमें पानी की किल्लत बनी हुई थी। ढाई लाख लोग पानी न मिलने के कारण परेशान थे। इनकी समस्या का निस्तारण करने के लिए अमृत योजना के तहत 78 करोड़ रुपये का प्रस्ताव शासन से मंजूर हुआ।

गूगल इमेजरी के जरिए जीडीए की अवैध निर्माण चिह्नित कराने की तैयारी

गाजियाबाद : आधुनिक तकनीक से अवैध निर्माण चिह्नित कराना जीडीए को काफी महंगा पड़ रहा है। आकाश नगर की सर्वे रिपोर्ट के बाद जीडीए अधिकारियों ने गूगल इमेजरी से अवैध निर्माण चिह्नित कराने का मन बनाया है। इस तकनीक से करोड़ों का काम हजारों रुपये में हो जाएगा। ग्रेटर नोएडा के शाहबेरी और गाजियाबाद के आकाश नगर इलाके में बहुमंजिला इमारत जमींदोज होने के बाद शासन ने जीआइएस से अवैध निर्माण चिह्नित करने के निर्देश दिए थे। लखनऊ के रिमोट सेंडक्लसग एप्लीकेशन सेंटर (आरएसएससी) को इस कार्य के लिए एजेंसी नामित किया था। शासन के निर्देश को मानते हुए

मौके पर होगा जुर्माना

पराली जलाने पर नियमों के तहत जुर्माने की व्यवस्था है। 2 एकड़ से कम की जमीन होने पर 2500 पये जुर्माना, 2 एकड़ से ज्यादा लेकिन 5 एकड़ तक की जमीन पर 5 हजार पये जुर्माना व 5 एकड़ से ज्यादा की जमीन होने पर 15 हजार पये जुर्माना का नियम है।

षि विभाग का सदस्य होगा। संबंधित तहसील के उप जिलाधिकारी को पर्यवेक्षण अधिकारी नियुक्त किया गया है। लोनी तहसील में पुलिस विभाग के क्षेत्राधिकारी प्रवेश कुमार सिंह, राजस्व विभाग से तहसीलदार प्रबान शर्मा व कृषि विभाग से जिला कृषि रक्षा अधिकारी डॉ. आरएस वर्मा को नियुक्त किया गया है।

प्रदूषण फैला रही आठ अवैध फैक्ट्रियां सील

लोनी : प्रशासनिक अधिकारियों ने सोमवार दोपहर बेहटा हाजीपुर और सेवाधाम इलाके में प्रदूषण फैलाने वाली अवैध रूप से संचालित आठ फैक्ट्रियों को सील कर दिया। सील फैक्ट्रियों के बिजली कनेक्शन काटने के साथ ही सबमर्सिबल भी उखाड़ लिए गए। उपजिलाधिकारी सतेंद्र कुमार सिंह के निर्देश पर सोमवार दोपहर न्यायिक तहसीलदार ऊषा ासह, प्रदूषण नियंत्रण बोर्ड, बिजली निगम, गाजियाबाद विकास प्राधिकरण, नगर पालिका और पुलिसकर्मियों की टीम ने सेवाधाम मंदिर के पास, सिंडीकेट गार्डन, बेहटा हाजीपुर गांव में प्रदूषण फैलाने वाली अवैध फैक्ट्रियों के खिलाफ कार्रवाई की। करीब तीन घंटे चली कार्रवाई के दौरान आठ फैक्ट्रियों को सील किया गया।

मेट्रो के लिए एक महीने में पूरा अंशदान देने के निर्देश

गाजियाबाद : दिलशाद गार्डन से नया बस अड्डा तक मेट्रो का संचालन नवंबर में शुरू होगा। उससे पहले डीएमआरसी को बकाया राशि का भुगतान करना होगा। कमिश्नर ने यूपीएसआइडीसी, आवास विकास परिषद और जीडीए को एक महीने में अंशदान का पूरा भुगतान करने के निर्देश दिए हैं। जीडीए को नगर निगम के हिस्से का 246.35 करोड़ रुपये अंशदान देना है। उसके अपने हिस्से के 49.62 करोड़ रुपये भी बकाया हैं। ऐसे में एक महीने में 295.97 करोड़ रुपये की व्यवस्था करनी पड़ेगी। इसे लेकर जीडीए अधिकारी

चितित हैं। उन्होंने इतनी धनराशि जुटाने के लिए प्रयास शुरू कर दिए हैं। आवास विकास परिषद के अधिकारी भी चितित नजर आने लगे हैं। उन्हें एक महीने में 159.54 करोड़ रुपये की व्यवस्था करनी है। यूपीएसआइडीसी को 11.85 करोड़ रुपये अंशदान देना है। इस कॉरिडोर पर ट्रायल शुरू हुए 25 दिन हो गए हैं। डीएमआरसी सूत्रों के अनुसार अब तक ट्रायल ठीक चल रहा है। किसी तरह की खामी सामने नहीं आई। अब तक रेल गीमी गति से दौड़ाई जा रही है। अक्टूबर से इसकी स्पीड बाकर ट्रायल किया जाएगा।

इनको मिला कार्ड

दो बच्चों में मिले गलघोंटू के लक्षण

गाजियाबाद : गलघोंटू से दिल्ली में बच्चों की मौत के मामले सामने आने के बाद जिला स्वास्थ्य विभाग पूरी तरह से एक्टिव दिख रहा है। रविवार को उन क्षेत्रों में स्वास्थ्य अधिकारियों ने जांच की, जहां टीकाकरण का प्रतिशत कम रहा है। बताया जा रहा है कि भोजपुर के मुकीमपुर चट्टा में दो बच्चों में गलघोंटू के लक्षण मिले हैं। दोनों बच्चों के रक्त के सैंपल लेकर जांच के लिए स्वास्थ्य विभाग ने भेजे हैं। रविवार को स्वास्थ्य विभाग ने टीकाकरण न कराने वाले परिवारों को चिन्हित करने का कार्य शुरू किया। कल्लूगढी गांव और भोजपुर के मुकीमपुर चट्टा में कुछ परिवार ऐसे हैं, जिन्होंने बच्चों का टीकाकरण नहीं

कराया है। एसीएमओ डा. विश्राम सिंह ने बताया कि मुकीमपुर चट्टा गांव में दो बच्चों में गलघोंटू के लक्षण मिले हैं। जांच रिपोर्ट में यदि बच्चों को गलघोंटू की पुष्टि होती है तो फिर उन्हें दिल्ली के लिए रेफर किया जाएगा। पुष्टि न होने पर सामुदायिक स्वास्थ्य केंद्र पर ही बच्चों का इलाज किया जाएगा। इसके अलावा कल्लूगढी में सात साल से नीचे के तीन बच्चे मिले हैं, जिनका टीकाकरण नहीं हो सका है। स्वास्थ्य विभाग की टीमों ने तीनों को डीपीटी के टीके लगाए हैं। एसीएमओ ने बताया कि अभियान चलाकर टीकाकरण कराया जाएगा। इसके लिए पीएचसी और सीएचसी पर भी निर्देश जारी किए गए हैं।

Implications of data mirroring

Data is the new oil and a driver of growth and change. Indeed, India is supposed to become data rich before becoming economically rich. This digital growth is being pushed by large foreign digital companies. They are largely fuelled by the data of their users. And they are being welcomed by the establishment as is evident by the visits of the prime minister and Union information technology minister to Silicon Valley over the past few years as part of the Digital India campaign. Important sectors such as e-commerce, social media, digital entertainment, online communication, and information and communication technology (ICT) hardware in India are predominantly served by foreign companies, or domestic companies funded by foreign capital. Indian users today are accessing digital technology-driven services not only within India's national boundaries, but also outside its jurisdiction. Consequently, these foreign service providers are free to process the personal data of millions of Indians within their own shores. The advancement of digital tools and technology in areas such as artificial intelligence (AI), has enabled them to monitor and profile user behaviour, preferences and even daily routines, granting them the potential power to influence their decisions through targeted communications.

Many experts have been ringing the alarm bells for the past few years, warning the government of digital colonialism by such companies. Data is now considered a strategic asset by many, and data driven network effects coupled with user feedback loops have given first mover advantage to the more developed western world. The data processed by these companies is not only used offshore to track and profile users, but is also fed as fuel into modern technologies like AI and the Internet of Things (IoT), which are touted to be the drivers of modern manufacturing, service delivery and governance. Perhaps that's why it is Silicon Valley that is expected to lead the way in researching, implementing and controlling digital technologies, earning it the reputation of being the new Rome. Recognising the gravity of the issue, the Srikrishna committee in its draft data protection bill has rightly observed that the freedom to share personal data in the digital economy works selectively in the interests of certain countries that have been early movers. These countries can support a completely open digital economy without any detriment to their national interests by virtue of their technological advancement. It goes on to state that popular websites owned by foreign entities refuse to provide data to Indian law enforcement agencies in many instances. It has also flagged other related critical issues in the realm of personal data protection and data sovereignty, such as preventing foreign surveillance and fostering AI in India, all of which need to be addressed. However, it remains to be seen whether the bill will backfire with respect to the potential threat of data colonialism. The path recommended by the committee to accomplish the feat is mandating local storage of a copy of user's data, or data mirroring, something which has not gone down well with its critics. Contemporary public discourse interprets digital colonialism as a large global economy wherein small local players are left out. It has also been argued by industry players, academia and consumer groups that mandating data mirroring will raise entry barriers in the Indian market and adversely impact a variety of smaller domestic stakeholders, such as start-ups and micro, small and medium enterprises.

Aqua Line braces for second test after Oct 15

NOIDA: The commissioner of metro rail safety (CMRS) will conduct the second phase of inspection of the Aqua Line after October 15. The first phase of the inspection completed on Thursday and officials said the report on coaches was "good". Deputy CMRS Uttam Prakash visited the NMRC depot in Greater Noida's Sector Delta I on the second day of the inspection on Thursday and examined the rolling stock of the Aqua Line. The second day of the inspection included measurement of trains, rescue

system, depot facilities and so on. On Thursday, the documentation process was completed. The two-day inspection included a full trial of the metro and test of the rolling stock of the entire corridor. The rolling stock test includes testing of the public announcement system, public information system, emergency evacuation measures, fire sensors, volume adjustment, manual line selection etc. Sources said the deputy CMRS will share his observations with the CMRS, who is the highest authority that

takes a call on a metro corridor's readiness for commissioning after checking all the technical aspects and security mechanism. The CMRS, after going through the report on the first phase of the inspection, will submit it to the railway ministry. An official said the second round of inspection for the entire corridor was expected any time after October 15. At present, Aqua Line is undergoing full-fledged trials. The CMRS, SK Pathak, is also likely to visit the depot in a few days, sources said.

TV executive fights off snatchers but can't reach police on 100

NOIDA: A television channel executive walking home after withdrawing money from an ATM was allegedly attacked by two men, who came in a car and tried to snatch his gold chain after pointing a gun to his forehead. Pushpal Singh, however, fought off the attacker who had whipped out the gun and pressed the button which allowed the magazine to fall off. Though the assailants fled in the car, Singh's ordeal did not end there. Repeated calls to the police response team on 100 failed to connect. He then called up a friend, who, in turn, informed the SSP. The alleged attack took place near Hyde Park society in Sector 78. Singh said he had reached

near the society around 8.30pm on Wednesday when he realised that a grey Hyundai i10 had been following him for some time. "When I had walked about 20 metres ahead of Hyde Park, the car intercepted me. A man walked towards me and sought to know the direction towards Sector 56. As I told him the directions, he did not seem interested at all. He was instead looking here and there, as if to check for any passerby. He and the other man inside the car seemed to be in their 30s," Singh said. He said the man then whipped out a country-made pistol from his pocket and caught hold his collar in a bid to snatch the chain.

Noida sector 18 traders seek end to snarls by Diwali

NOIDA: Traders in the Sector 18 market have sought a change before Diwali in the routes used by vehicles to enter and exit the shopping zone. While the market association has submitted a four-year plan to regulate traffic, the traffic police is of the opinion that a new plan needs to be drawn keeping in mind the multi-level parking. At the moment, there are 11 entry/exit points to the sector. The committee on traffic, comprising officials from the Noida Authority, traffic police and members of two of the market associations, discussed the plans for traffic movement, a U-turn on the Sector 18 road and illegal encroachment on inner roads.

Noida: College in sector 91 set for facelift

NOIDA: Following a request from the Principal of the Panchsheel Balak Inter College Sector 91, Noida Authority has undertaken the maintenance work of the 25-acre campus on Tuesday. Under this, work related to completion of a 750 seating capacity auditorium along with a senior scholar's mess building will be undertaken. Estimated to cost Rs 10 crores, the work will be completed in one year's time. Other pending issues to be looked into include condition and upkeep of classrooms, hostel, residential buildings and sports facility on the campus. "We have taken up the maintenance work of the

college including completing the 750 seating capacity auditorium as well as the mess building for senior students. The cost of the work is estimated at Rs 10 crore and it will be completed in one year's time," said Samakant Srivastava general manager (Civil) Noida Authority who was part of the 1.5-hour inspection of the 25-acre campus on Tuesday. Accompanied by a team of Noida authority work circle 8 including Srivastava, the inspection held under CEO Alok Tandon undertook an assessment and review of all buildings in the college academic, hostels, residential flat towers and sports facilities.

On the occasion, the principal Dr Neeraj Tandon also requested that class 6 to 12 be opened for day scholars so as to help increase the number of students in the college. CEO Tandon asked the principal to submit a proposal to that effect. Panchsheel Balak Inter College is an English medium educational institution affiliated to CBSE New Delhi and situated in Sector-91 Noida Expressway, Gautam Budh Nagar. Established and administrated by the Noida and Greater Noida Education Society, the college run classes from 1st to 12th standard across three wings - senior, middle and primary.

24 cameras to watch over vehicles on NH-24

GHAZIABAD: As many as two dozen closed circuit cameras will keep tabs on movement of vehicles on the 19.2km stretch of NH-24 that falls within Ghaziabad after it is opened to traffic. Footage from these cameras will be monitored from a control room to be set up near the Lal Kuan flyover. The cameras and control room are part of an advanced traffic management system being implemented by the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) as part of the NH-24 widening project. At present, the NHAI is undertaking construction work on the second section of



the project that stretches from UP Gate on the Delhi border to Dasna. According to NHAI, the traffic management system includes variable message signboards and automatic traffic classifiers and counters. “Detection cameras will be set up at accident prone spots. The cameras will detect any abrupt incident on the highway,

such as collisions, speeding or irregular lane movements. These will be monitored round-the-clock at the control room, which will have an in-charge and support staff,” NHAI project director RP Singh said. In the first section of the highwaywidening project from Nizamuddin Bridge to UP Gate a total number of 12 incident detection cameras has been installed. These cameras are monitored 24x7 from a control room set up near the Akshardham flyover. In the Ghaziabad section, at least eight variable message electronic signboards will be installed at different locations.

Thieves break SUV window, steal Rs 2.5 lakh

GZB : A property dealer was allegedly robbed of Rs 2.5 lakh cash in Rajnagar District Centre (RDC) on Wednesday afternoon. The realtor Sanjay Sirohi (45), a resident of Chiranjeev Vihar, was on his way to his office located in Noida’s Sector 18 when he stopped by at a private bank in RDC to complete some documentation work. He parked his Toyota Innova in front of the bank and left a bag containing the cash inside the SUV. “I left my bag and few other belongings inside the vehicle.

U-turns to decongest Modinagar, I’pura

Ghaziabad: GDA has started implementing the suggestions made by the Central Road Research Institute (CRRI) to decongest Modinagar and Indirapuram. On the 12.7km Modinagar-Muradnagar stretch, CRRI had under its comprehensive mobility plan suggested five U-turns and closing down of 15 cuts. “Of the five U-turns, we have started work on Jhilmil cut and we hope to complete the work within a month,” Santosh Rai, secretary, GDA, told TBC on Tuesday. “The U-turn will be made on both sides of the road which will enable traffic coming from Modinagar to Murdnagar to move over to

opposite lanes without disturbing the traffic and vice versa as it will be 300 metres wide,” he added. Work on the other U-turns will be taken up upon completion of Jhilmil cut. These are ARM roundabout, Sikri Road roundabout, Raj Cahupla cut and Modi Mandir cut. “In addition to these, there are 15 cuts which CRRI has proposed to close down and it will be taken up one by one,” said Rai. As per CRRI’s report which was submitted in June this year, the Modinagar-Muradnagar road is a vital link to Meerut and Dehradun and it witnesses traffic movement of 1.3 lakh vehicles per day, but due to jam this stretch is a

Domestic help burgles businessman’s home, held

GHAZIABAD: A 19-year-old youth was arrested on Sunday for allegedly robbing the house of a factory owner where he was employed as a help for the past eight months. Cash and jewellery worth Rs 53,000 and valuables worth Rs 15 lakh were recovered from the arrested servant, identified as Avinash. Avinash robbed the house of Surendra Arora in Kavi Nagar, who runs a factory of machine parts. Arora had left with his family for Delhi to attend a wedding on Friday when the robbery took place. When the family



returned around 2am, they found entire house was ransacked and valuables missing. Police suspected the domestic help behind the crime because the robber had entered through the back door of the house, even though a security guard was stationed at the main gate. “The burglary had been committed by the Domestic help alone.

Improve night patrol or face action: SSP

GZB : In view of the poor patrolling mechanism in place during night hours in the district, Ghaziabad SSP Vaibhav Krishna has threatened to take departmental action against erring SHOs. In a recently-held crime review meeting, the SSP directed them to look into the matter and plug all loopholes at the earliest. “The system of conducting patrol checks by police stations is in a very bad shape. Strict action will be taken against the SHO concerned if any incident takes place in his area. The police officer will not be spared under any circumstances,” stated the SSP’s communique to police officials.

Vaishali park turns vending zone, NGT stalls work

GHAZIABAD: A local resident has approached the National Green Tribunal (NGT) after GMC allegedly started work to convert a “park” in Vaishali’s Sector 4 into a vending zone. In a hearing on Tuesday, the green panel ordered that a committee of officials from GDA, GMC, district administration and Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) be formed to look into the matter and decide on the matter within a month. All work in the park area has been suspended for now. The NGT order said, ““We direct



that a joint committee...be constituted and may hold a meeting within one month to take stock of the situation and to decide further course of action in accordance with the law.” It further said, “GDA will be the nodal agency and will be accountable for compliance of the order of this tribunal.”

Prohibitory orders to remain in Ghaziabad during festive season

GZB : The district magistrate of Ghaziabad has imposed Section 144 in the entire city in view of the festive season ahead. Section 144 will remain in place from September 14 to October 20. “We have Muharram, Gandhi Jayanti, Durga Puja and Vijayadashami in the coming days and in order to maintain law and order, Section 144 has been imposed from September 14 till October 20,” said Ritu Maheshwari, district magistrate. Only traditional processions will be allowed in the district,” added Maheshwari.

Labourer kills father, drunk brother after tiff in shanty

GHAZIABAD: A 60-year-old man and his 35-year-old son were found murdered on Tuesday near a shanty in which they lived in Ghaziabad. The deceased have been identified as Murli and his son Nanhe, who worked as daily wage labourers. Murli’s younger son Dinesh, who was found injured a little distance away, has admitted to having killed his father and brother during a quarrel late on Monday night, police said. Police had rushed to the spot after receiving a call about the bodies lying unattended. Dinesh was found sitting

dazed and injured on a wooden cot outside the shanty. “Nanhe arrived home in an inebriated state on Monday night. There was a quarrel between him and our father, which soon escalated into a fight. They attacked each other with staffs and wooden planks as I tried to intervene. Our father suffered blows on the head after which he fell unconscious and died. Nanhe attacked me, too. He was injured seriously when I attacked in retaliation and died after some time,” Dinesh has apparently told the police. He has been arrested.

DMRC told to complete trials on Ghaziabad metro line by November-end

GHAZIABAD: GDA vice-chairperson Kanchan Verma held a meeting with Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) officials on Wednesday to take stock of the progress on the Dilshad Garden-New Bus Stand metro corridor. It has been learnt that DMRC has given a November deadline for commissioning of the project, on which trial runs are currently underway. Apart from this, traffic management along the route was also discussed in the meeting. “DMRC has assured us that it will complete the trial runs by the end of by November. After that, it will be in a position to start full-fledged operations on



the Dilshad Garden-New Bus stand metro corridor,” Verma told TBC. “We have also asked DMRC to submit the final cost estimate to GDA in one week, so that we can push for Centre’s share of Rs 402 crore for the project, which is awaiting the Union cabinet’s approval,” Verma added. GDA officials said DMRC may not provide feeder bus connectivity to stations, and in view of this, GDA is planning to talk to other departments to

fill in the gap. “Once the corridor opens, traffic management will be a challenge. Since DMRC is reluctant to providing feeder bus service, we will have to talk to other agencies,” the vice-chairperson said. Talks also centered around two proposed metro extensions Noida Sector 62 to Sahibabad and Vaishali to Mohan Nagar corridors. “Since work on both extension lines can’t be undertaken simultaneously, we will have to decide which section should be prioritised. We hope that a decision is made by next week. Funding of Phase 3 still remains a contentious issue. Except the Centre, which has

pledged to bear 20% of the total cost of the project, all stakeholder agencies have shown reluctance to contribute, and that needs to be ironed out with the state government,” Verma added. The Dilshad Garden-New Bus Stand metro corridor would be the second metro line in Ghaziabad after Vaishali and the first metro link connecting the interiors of Ghaziabad. This corridor will pass through the Sahibabad Industrial Area and will significantly impact the residential areas lying in proximity. The MoU for the project was signed between GDA and DMRC in 2014.

Owners away, burglars target Kavi Nagar homes

GHAZIABAD: In separate cases, burglars decamped with cash and jewellery worth Rs 13 lakh and Rs 5 lakh, respectively, from two homes in Kavi Nagar. In the first case, the bungalow of the chairman of UP Udyog Mandal was targeted on Friday night when he and his younger brother, along with their family members, had gone to Delhi to attend a marriage function. Notably, the businessmen brothers’ house is located near Rajya Sabha MP Anil Agarwal’s house. Ashok Arora, chairman of UP Udyog Mandal, said the family had left home around 9 pm on



Friday and returned around 2am on Saturday. On opening the door, they found the doors of the kitchen and balcony open and a cupboard in one of the bedrooms broken. “A close scrutiny revealed that Rs 60,000 in cash and jewellery worth Rs 12.5 lakh were missing. It looks like the job of an insider who knew where money and other valuable items were kept, as the robbers targeted only one room in the entire house,” he said.

64-year-old thrashed during daughter’s wedding talks, dies

GHAZIABAD: A 64-year-old man died in a hospital in Ghaziabad on Friday after being allegedly assaulted by the prospective parents-in-law of his daughter. An FIR has been filed against the accused and cops are investigating the case. Rajendra Munde, a resident of Radhey Shyam Colony in Muradnagar, was in talks with a family from Modinagar for the marriage of his 23-year-old daughter Preeti, police said. The prospective bridegroom’s family visited Munde’s house on Friday afternoon for talks about the marriage. Sources said the discussion took an ugly turn when both families failed to agree on

a few conditions for the marriage. Munde was allegedly thrashed during the quarrel. He was admitted to a private hospital for treatment around 4pm. His family approached cops and on the basis of a police complaint by Preeti, an FIR was registered three members of the prospective bridegroom’s family under sections 323 (assault) and 452 (house trespass after preparation for assault) of the IPC at Muradnagar police station the same day. Munde died later in the evening. “From preliminary inquiries, it seems the complainant’s father collapsed during the fight.

Accused in Dadri lynching to contest LS polls from Noida

Agra: Etah, Kasganj and Firozabad police on Saturday apprehended eight men and seized liquor and hooch over Rs 55 lakh from the districts. In Etah, two operations were conducted by Dehat and Pilua police forces. Dehat police, along with a SWAT team, raided Purangiri cold storage on GT road and recovered 885 cartons of Indian made foreign liquor (IMFL) smuggled from Arunachal Pradesh. According to the superintendent of police, Etah, Ashish Tiwari, “A gang of seven men were running an illegal business of smuggling liquor and repacking it with a different brand to sell it in the

local market. Our team has seized the re-packing machine and Rs 35 lakh worth of liquor. Three men have been arrested, while four managed to flee.” The three apprehended men were identified as Arvind of Mainpuri district, Rajesh Yadav and Son Singh of Etah district. The absconding were identified as Sunil Singh, Ashish Jadon, Lucca Singh and Bantu Singh. In Pilua police jurisdiction, the team apprehended three men, along with 200 cartons of IMFL smuggled from Haryana in a pick-up truck and two cars. SP Ashish Tiwari said, “During a routine check at Bhadwas border, Pilua police

detained three vehicles and found liquor which was being smuggled into the district. The liquor was worth Rs 8 lakh.” The three arrested men were identified as Vikas Sharma of Farrukhabad, Pramod of Mainpuri district and Tejpal Rajput of Firozabad. Police have come across two other men, identified as Rambresh and Rinku of Etah who were local contacts of three smugglers. In Kasganj, Dholna police raided Birhara and Nagla Tayabpur villages and recovered 55 litres of hooch and 500 litres of material used to make it. According to Surendar

Singh, SHO of Dholna, “Two men, Bhudev Singh and Surendar, who were running an illegal factory to make hooch, were arrested.” Apart from this, Nasirpur police of Firozabad district seized 220 cartons of IMFL smuggled from Arunachal Pradesh from a pick-up truck. According to Achal Singh, SHO of Nasirpur, “On an anonymous input, our team trailed a pick-up truck near Lakhanpur temple. The driver of the truck managed to flee but our team managed to seize the liquor, whose worth is around Rs 10 lakh.”

23-year-old rapes minor after his birthday party

GHAZIABAD: A 23-year-old man has been booked for allegedly raping a 14-year-old girl and trying to force her repeatedly into a physical relationship by blackmailing her with a mobile phone video that he apparently shot of the first crime. The minor girl, a Class IX student of a government school in Ghaziabad, had been raped around four months ago in a flat in Crossings Republik, where she had visited the birthday party of the accused. Police said the girl told her mother on Thursday about her

ordeal and the attempts to blackmail her with the video. The accused, Imran, has been booked under Section 376 (rape) of the IPC and provisions of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, on a complaint by the girl. Police said Imran was absconding and they had questioned one of his close friends, Danish, in Dundaheda about his whereabouts. The girl’s parents are estranged and she lives with her mother and younger brothers, aged 8 and 10 years, in Ghaziabad.

Soon, cops will have details of violators on Noida-Greater Noida expressway

NOIDA: After the successful integration of the e-challan system on the Yamuna Expressway with National Informatics Centre’s Vahan software, the authorities are in the process of linking the Highway Traffic Management System on the Noida-Greater Noida Expressway with Vahan too. According to officials, the traffic police and NIC have now initiated the process of integration of database with the other systems at the Expressway and intersections, including sectors 57 which are manned by CCTV cameras.

Ghaziabad Development Authority plans to lease out Nehru stadium to private agency, cricketers protest

GHAZIABAD: The Ghaziabad Development Authority’s decision to lease out the Nehru cricket stadium to a private agency for 10 years has met with a stiff opposition from residents and players. The protesters have threatened to intensify their agitation if the decision is not rolled back. Referring to GDA bylaws, the protesters claimed the stadium cannot be leased out as it is a public property used by morning-walkers and players. They said it is the responsibility of the development agency to maintain the stadium. “About 20 years ago, the GDA had

250 carton of smuggled liquor seized in Ghaziabad

GZB : Police have seized 250 cartons of liquor from a truck in Ghaziabad and arrested one person. On a tip-off, the police intercepted a truck on Eastern Peripheral way on the intervening night of Thursday and Friday and made the seizure, deputy superintendent of police Prabhat Kumar said. The driver and owner of the truck managed to flee the spot, the police said, adding the conductor was nabbed. During interrogation he told the police that 250 cartons country made foreign liquor was being taken to Bihar.

So far, the only mechanism to check for an e-challan is to log into the website of MORTH’s e-challan system, where only the number of pending challans is visible with the time and date of the issuance. Commuters say though e-challaning may be happening, there is no mechanism to get an instant alert for the same which can discourage commuters from making another violation.

Two security men found murdered at PNB guard room in Noida

NOIDA: Two security guards of Punjab National Bank circle office in Sector 1 were killed by unidentified criminals during an attempt to loot on Friday morning. The deceased were identified as Mudrika and Mukesh. Their bodies were found with severe injuries in the guard room. The loot attempt was thwarted, said police. Police said that in the morning a gardener reached the campus but he did not get any response from guards. The gardener informed bank manager who rushed to the spot and informed police. Both the main doors were locked. The police broke opened the



door and found the two guards with head injuries. It is suspected the two persons were killed with rods or some other objects. Senior police officials are scanning the campus with dog squads and finger print experts. SP city Arun Kumar Singh said police have registered a case and investigating the matter from all angles.

Residents raise civic issues across four sectors with Noida Authority

Cops said the boy changed two buses to reach Greater Noida where he lost his way. He was spotted in school uniform by passersby, who dialled 100. Muneesh Chauhan, the SHO of Surajpur police station, said the boy told them that he fled from his school in east Delhi on Wednesday afternoon and reached the city. “He could

not give us his house address. After almost three hours, we managed to get through his father’s mobile after contacting his class teacher in school. The family reached the police station around 11.30 pm and took his custody,” he added. The boy’s father said that they stay in a rented accommodation in Gandhi Nagar area of east Delhi and he works as a salesman at a hosiery shop in Gandhinagar. “My son was upset since Tuesday because I had beaten him up for stealing Rs 1,000 from my wallet on Monday night.
