गाजियाबाद : नोएडा स्थित यूनियन बैंक की शाखा में हुए लोन घोटाले के सभी आरोपित मंगलवार को सीबीआई अदालत में पेश हुए। घोटाले में प्राइवेट व्यक्ति सुशील व अजय ने अपने बयान दर्ज कराए। अदालत ने सुनवाई के लिए अगली तारीख लगा दी। सीबीआई के वरिष्ठ लोक अभियोजक ने अदालत को बताया कि नोएडा स्थित यूनियन बैंक की शाखा से दिल्ली की पृथ्वीराज ज्वैलर्स कंपनी के प्रोपराइटर राज कुमार सामंता ने बैंक प्रबंधक मनोज श्रीवास्तव से मिलीभगत कर फर्जी कागजों के आधार पर वर्ष 2008 में 40 लाख रुपये का लोन स्वीकृत करा लिया था। घोटाले की जानकारी मिलने पर सीबीआई ने इस मामले की जांच की थी। जांच में घोटाला होना पाया गया था।

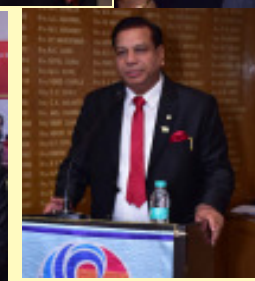

## EDITORIAL

## Priyanka will spur Congress cadre

**Priyanka** Gandhi, known primarily as the 47-year-old daughter of Rajiv and Sonia Gandhi and sister of Congress president Rahul Gandhi, entered politics formally, on Wednesday. She is now a general secretary of Congress, with oversight on the Lok Sabha elections in eastern Uttar Pradesh. The letter announcing her entry into active politics, among the most speculated upon topics in recent times in Indian national politics, was signed by her brother. The hashtag #PriyankaGandhi is by far the top trending topic on Twitter in India — and in many countries where Indians live. But votes, not tweets, win elections. And electoral success or failure is the only test of legitimacy.

Priyanka Gandhi's entry in politics means Congress is no longer content to be a pushover in UP, India's most politically-significant state, with 80 of 543 Lok Sabha seats. Over a quarter-century, the Grand Old Party (GOP) has ceded ground in this state, thanks to its own sins of omission and commission, to caste and religion-based outfits. Priyanka's entry, along with that of Jyotiraditya Scindia, another fresh face representing youthful energy, is a signal that the GOP wants the people of UP to know that Congress has fresh ideas for the state, different from poverty and conflict. Yes, Priyanka's entry does underline the Nehru-Gandhi family's grip on the Congress imagination. However, the media, and the focus on Priyanka, indicates that this tendency goes beyond the Congress. The willingness of Congress to give the battle in UP its all holds a message not only for BJP, but also for Samajwadi Party (SP) and Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP). Even if it was as far back as 2009, the Congress had won 21 seats, against BSP's 20 and SP's 23 in the Lok Sabha. Whatever be the case this time around, Priyanka Gandhi's coming out of the proverbial closet will, if nothing else, spur the Congress cadre onward.

## It's a pleasant surprise for once as waste collectors come to doorstep

**NOIDA:** The first day of door-to-door waste collection saw many residents being caught unaware though almost all of them welcomed the move as it began in five sectors—14, 50, 48, 49, 137 and in Aghapur village. There were some initial hiccups like delayed deployment of tipper vans due to logistical issues in arranging bins, drivers etc. by 9am. In Sector 50, when the tipper van reached there early morning, it was not allowed to enter by residents due to lack of intimation from the RWA. The van, however, returned with staff from Noida Authority. The RWA members then spent some time creating awareness about the new system. A similar

response came from Aghapur village where too the residents were caught off guard. While 13 tipper vans were deployed on Thursday, a total of 20 tonnes of waste were collected, of which 15 tonnes were from residential sectors and the rest five from Aghapur village. An additional five tonnes were brought by nearly 40 rickshaws in Sector 49 dhalao ghar where a 25-tonne compactor was placed for compressing municipal waste. "We got to know of the new mechanism of waste collection through media reports. By the time these vans came to our sector on Thursday morning, most of our original sanitation staff had already collected the garbage.

## Education dept to monitor parent-teacher meetings to be held in 688 schools today

**NOIDA:** The district administration and the basic education department will supervise the fourth parent-teacher meeting to be held on a mass scale in Noida and Greater Noida on Monday. The single-day programme will be held in 688 government or government-aided schools in the district. Parents of nearly 84,000 children are expected to meet teachers during the day. The parent-teacher meetings on a mass scale were started on an experimental basis at the beginning of the current

academic session. These have now become a part of the school curriculum. The meetings are supposed to help parents gain feedback on the skills and achievements of their children from the teachers. According to sources, Gautam Budh Nagar is the front-runner in holding regular parent-teacher meetings in UP. "So far, we've hosted three such meetings. So, in an academic year, there will be four parent-teacher meetings. We're the first in the state to implement this. Though we wanted to improve the

frequency of such meetings, the difficulties involved in organising such gigantic meetings have prevented us," said Bal Mukund Prasad, basic siksha adhikari of Gautam Budh Nagar. "The involvement of parents in children's education is important and when parents visit teachers in the schools, it also becomes a feedback system for schools to correct themselves. Now, Gautam Budh Nagar has become a model for the rest of the state to adopt regular parent-teacher meetings in their annual curriculum.

## NBCC gets SC's green signal to complete Amrapali's 2 Noida projects

**NEW DELHI:** The Supreme Court on Friday permitted state-owned NBCC to start work to complete Amrapali's two unfinished housing projects in Noida and sought a comprehensive report from it on how the rest of the projects could be completed in a time-bound manner. A bench of Justices Arun Mishra and U U Lalit asked NBCC to complete two projects—Castle and Eden Park—which were chosen by the company. The two projects were selected as they were at an advanced stage of construction and only Rs 7 crore

was required to complete 618 flats in the projects. Other projects need more investments and the fund raised so far by the SC is not sufficient to meet the cost. As properties of Amrapali Group have been put on auction and some of them are likely to be sold by end of this month, the bench asked NBCC to prepare a blueprint for other unfinished projects also. After the SC entrusted the task to NBCC, the corporation conducted a thorough survey of all housing projects of Amrapali and agreed to take over the incomplete projects.

## 3 injured in garment factory blast in Noida

**NOIDA:** At least three workers were injured—one of them seriously—when a large boiler burst due a technical fault in a company engaged in dry cleaning of garments. The blast occurred around 6 pm in Fancy Industries in A-5 of Sector 16, when the workers were drying clothes in the boiler meant for drying clothes. It is a huge machine which can dry scores of clothes together. According to the police, the workers, Shahzad (20), Lal Babu (24) and Sagar (22), had been working when there was a sudden blast in the boiler.

## Gangster held for threatening toll staffers in Noida

**NOIDA:** The Noida unit of the special task force (STF) has arrested a henchman of the Sunder Bhati-Anil Bhati gang who allegedly threatened toll tax staffers at the DND and also fleeced money in the name of dreaded gangsters. Mohit Bhati, whose father's elder brother was well-known to Sunder Bahti's father, was arrested near Sector 21/25 intersection around 8.30am on Thursday after the STF officers got a tip-off about the movement of three members of the gang near the area. A Class 11 pass, Mohit (20) was allegedly involved in threatening toll tax staffers at the DND to ensure that trucks pass through the toll without paying the tax.

## Kalindi Kunj bridge opens, but no relief from jams

**NOIDA:** As expected, the opening of the new Kalindi Kunj bridge led to snarls before the traffic signal of the junction, with motorists stopping there and commercial vehicles being stopped for payment of toll. The six-lane bridge over the Yamuna and the connecting Shahdara drain bridge were inaugurated by chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday, with the pressing of a button at the Depot station of the Noida-Greater Noida metro corridor. With its opening, commuters coming from the Noida side towards Delhi had a smooth run. But only for a while. Soon, the snarls started building up. While officials of the company

handling the MCD toll tax were prepared and a booth was installed on the left side at the end of the two new bridges, some drivers attempted to dodge the toll. D Suryavanshi, toll manager for the company, said a separate lane for commercial vehicles was created on the extreme left of the new bridge. However, the situation on the ground reflected otherwise, with commuters stating that commercial vehicles needed to be funnelled at the start of the bridge. "There should be a separate lane for commercial vehicles so they do not merge with private cars that have nothing to do with toll," said Vipin Kumar, a Jasola resident.



## Man shot at for refusing to withdraw case in Ghaziabad

**GZB:** A dairy owner was allegedly shot at by three unidentified men in Kavi Nagar area on Saturday. The victim has been identified as Paramveer Singh, who is in his early 50s. He lives in Kavi Nagar’s Chiranjeev Vihar. Police said that around 6am on Saturday, when Singh was going to his dairy, the three accused intercepted him near the railway tracks just 100 metres away from his home and fired two shots at him. The first bullet missed him narrowly from the shoulder, while the second hit him in the thigh. Singh was

rushed to nearby Sarvodaya hospital and police were informed about the shootout in the evening. According to Singh’s son Mohit Chaudhary, one of the accused, Sunil, owed them Rs 11 lakh and a case in this regard has also been going on in a local court. Sunil was allegedly mounting pressure on Singh to withdraw the case but when he refused to do so, he along with his two accomplices attacked him. Chaudhary has filed a complaint against the three persons at Kavi Nagar police station and they have been booked under IPC Section 307.

## Flats of coal ministry official, bank executive burgled in Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD:** Two flats, belonging to an undersecretary in the Union coal ministry and a senior bank official, were burgled in a highrise apartment in Raj Nagar Extension on Thursday afternoon. The burglars escaped with cash and jewellery worth Rs 11 lakh. The flats, located opposite each other, are on the 11th floor of Raj Empire Society. According to the complainants, the burglary took place between 1pm and 2pm when the owners had gone out for work. Of the 400 flats, only 70-80 are currently occupied.

## Kin free youth from jail, NSA slapped against his brother

**GHAZIABAD:** The brother of a youth, accused of molesting a woman, has been booked under the National Security Act after he and his family members created a ruckus at Tronica City police station and tried to release him forcibly on the night of December 3 last year. At that time, an FIR had been registered against 12 persons, including the accused Rahul, his brother Suraj and father Ranveer for attacking cops and damaging property of the police station. Police said Suraj had been trying to get a bail in

the case and there was apprehension that his release might lead to law and order problems. The police recommended that NSA be slapped against Rahul. The district magistrate, to whom the request had been made, gave permission. After Rahul’s arrest, his relatives had barged into the police station late on December 3 night and freed him after the cops on duty did not allow them to offer the accused fish and liquor. Police said Rahul had come to Ghaziabad to meet a friend near Signature City.

## Farmers want village names in metro stations

**NOIDA:** A group of residents from Hoshiarpur village on Wednesday protested outside Sector 34 metro station of the Blue Line extension demanding that the Aqua Line metro stations be named after the villages where they are located. In 2017 too, many farmers had submitted letters to the managing director of Noida Metro Rail Corporation Santosh Yadav demanding that every metro station coming up on the Blue and Aqua lines be named after the nearest village. However, with most metro stations of the Aqua Line up for sale of co-branding rights, the demand seems unlikely to be approved.

## Girl resists molestation, kin attacked

**GHAZIABAD:** The family members of an 18-year-old girl were attacked by a group of 15-20 people with bricks after the girl resisted a molestation attempt by some youths in Kavi Nagar area on Saturday evening. The accused had been harassing her for the past six months, the girl’s father said. The accused has been identified as Sachin, his father Sanjay, their relative Bhola and some unidentified persons, all residents of the same locality in Kavi Nagar. The girl’s father, who works as an electrician, said on Sunday: “Sachin and his friends had been harassing my daughter, who is pursuing BSc, over the phone and whenever she passed

through their colony.” He added, “My daughter informed her mother about it and she asked her to ignore their comments. However, when the harassment increased, she informed me about their unruly behaviour. I tried to reason with Sachin’s father and asked him to stop his son from harassing my daughter.” He further alleged that Sachin had once again harassed his daughter on Saturday evening while she was returning home. When she resisted, Sachin slapped her. After some time Sachin, his father and their accomplices attacked the girl’s family with sticks, bricks and stones. In the attack, some of the neighbours,

who came to their rescue, were also injured. One of them received 15 stitches on his head after a brick hit him. The girl’s father said the accused fled the spot after issuing threats to burn down their house. “All members of my family, comprising my wife, two daughters and a son were injured in the attack,” he said. Following the attack, the police were informed about the incident on Dial 100. An FIR has been registered under sections 147 (rioting), 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), 336 (act endangering life or personal safety of others) and 354 D of the IPC at Kavi Nagar police station.

## Two drug peddlers from Haryana held in Noida

**NOIDA:** Two suspected drug peddlers were arrested after over two kg of cannabis was allegedly recovered from them here, police said Tuesday. The men were held around 11 pm Monday from a road near Nithari village on a tip-off, they said. Those arrested have been identified as Vipin Prasad and Raju Singh, both residents of Faridabad in Haryana, said an official from Sector 20 police station. "The duo was arrested with 2.5 kg of cannabis Monday night. They were involved in illegal trading of cannabis which they procured from Faridabad and were selling in Noida," said Inspector Manoj Kumar Pant.

## 4 carjackers arrested from Ghaziabad's Muradnagar

**GHAZIABAD:** The police, on the intervening night of Friday and Saturday, arrested four robbers who had allegedly robbed an Ola cab driver in Noida. The accused after dumping the driver at an isolated spot in Ghaziabad drove to Meerut and on the pretext of giving lift they targeted two gullible commuters. They were intercepted by police near Muradnagar and after brief resistance from them were arrested. "On the intervening night of Friday and Saturday four accused identified as Vikas, his namesake Vikas,

Sandeep and Lokesh were driving towards Ghaziabad from Meeurt in a stolen Hyundai Ascent bearing Delhi registration number have been arrested" said Umesh Bahadur Singh, SHO, Muradnagar police station. "Actually we were on lookout for stolen car after message was flashed that four accused had robbed an Ola cab driver in Noida and when they were spotted near Jhilmil cut we chased them after they tried to flee and arrested them”, added Singh. "They asked me to drive even though I objected saying he has no booking in their names" said Sahid.

## Three-year-old raped by neighbour

**NOIDA:** A three-and-a-half-year-old girl was allegedly raped by a 56-year-old man in Sadarpur of Sector 45 after the latter apparently lured her to his room. The incident happened around noon when the girl was playing outside the room her family lives in. According to the family of the girl, the accused had come to Noida to stay at his daughter’s place from Kolkata about 10 days back and was living close to their house. “He took her inside his room. When I heard her cries, I rushed outside to see where she was but I couldn’t find her.

## Flipkart founder, CEO booked for ‘cheating’ buyer

**GHAZIABAD:** An FIR was registered on Saturday against Flipkart founder Sachin Bansal and CEO Kalyan Krishnamurthy following a complaint of cheating lodged by a Ghaziabad-based lawyer. The complainant, Naushad Chaudhary, alleged the company had sold him a laptop having features different from what was mentioned at the time of sale on the Flipkart app installed on his phone. He claimed that Flipkart’s customer care had initially agreed to replace the product, but later stopped all communication with him.

Chaudhary said he even sent a legal notice to company, but there was no response. “It is then that I lodged the complaint,” he said. The charges mentioned by police include cheating, criminal breach of trust and forgery. Flipkart said on Sunday it would look into the matter. According to the lawyer, he had bought the laptop (HP 15 APU Dual Core A6) for Rs 17,990 on October 12 last year under the “special offers” category for Diwali. He raised a complaint with the customer care, which, in turn, promised to resolve the issue and refund the money.



## Meerut allows Ghaziabad to dump 200 tonnes of waste daily

**GHAZIABAD:** The acute problem of solid waste management in Ghaziabad has got a temporary solution with the Meerut Municipal Corporation obliging to a request from GMC to allow dumping of civic waste in its jurisdiction. Though the Ghaziabad Municipal Corporation got permission to dump 200 metric tonnes of waste per day, officials said that only one-third of it is required to be sent to Meerut. The GMC had also placed a similar request with Noida, the permission for which is still awaited. The solid waste management in Ghaziabad plunged into a crisis

as the GMC was forced to stop dumping at Pratap Vihar landfill on the orders of an NGT committee on waste management. “Even though we have the permission from the Meerut corporation to dump 200 metric tonnes of civic waste in their area, as of now only one-third of it is being sent there because much of it is managed here itself,” said C P Singh, municipal commissioner, GMC. “We have requested Noida also to allow us dump waste in their area but so far we have not received any reply from them. In any case, I don’t think we will need it,” added Singh.

According to CP Singh, Ghaziabad generates nearly 1,000 metric tonnes of waste daily. While 300 metric tonnes are ferried to Pilkhuwa, nearly 200 metric tonnes are used in various GMC-owned parks in the city to prepare compost. “There are more than 1,240 parks under GMC and we have dug up compost pits in all these parks which consume nearly 200 metric tonnes of civic waste,” said Singh. “Apart from this, we have two compost plants, especially for religious waste and fruit vegetable waste which consumes nearly 100 metric tonnes while a small portion

is being dumped at Indirapuram landfill site and only the rest will be send to Meerut,” added Singh. The GMC has five zones in its jurisdiction. While the city zone generates 300 metric tonnes of waste, Kavinagar, Mohan Nagar and Vasundhara zones generate nearly 200 metric tonnes each and Pratap Vihar zone generates nearly 100 metric tonnes. The GMC is also eyeing 19 acres of private land which it intends to take on lease from farmers to create a temporary landfill. “There are many defunct brick kiln owners on the outskirts of Kavinagar and Rajnagar Extension areas.

## Woman ends life in Shipra flat, note speaks of loneliness

**GHAZIABAD:** A 50-year-old woman hanged herself from a ceiling fan in her third-floor flat in Shipra Sun City in Indirapuram on Thursday when her daughter was away at her friend’s place for some college-related work. The woman, Kanchan Rana, was a widow and was working as a teacher in a government school in Makanpur village. She was living in the flat with her 21-year-old college-going daughter Anukriti while her son, Rishav Rana (26), who works with a private firm, lives with his wife in Pune. Her husband, Dharendra Singh Rana died 15 years ago. In a

suicide note recovered from the house, she mentioned “loneliness” as the reason for taking the extreme step. According to a relative, in the letter addressed to Chandani, Kanchan apologised to her daughter and wrote that she wanted to do a lot of things for her. She further wrote that she had not been able to cope with the loss of her husband anymore and therefore taking the extreme step. Kuldeep Singh, Shipra Sun City police post in-charge, said the body was sent for post-mortem and added that her son was on his way to Ghaziabad.

## Rape survivor seeks protection from cops after series of threats

**GHAZIABAD:** A 26-year-old rape survivor has sought police protection against two men who sexually assaulted her and an accomplice of theirs. She claimed they came to her house three days ago and threatened her with consequences if she did not withdraw her complaint. The woman, in her complaint to the SSP, said Taslim and Shakil had raped her at knifepoint in her house on February 4, 2015. Her husband and relatives had gone out of the city that day. An FIR was registered against the duo at Masuri police station the next morning under sections 376 (rape) and 506 (criminal

intimidation) of the IPC. he woman added that Taslim, who has several cases registered against him in Hapur and Ghaziabad, had also trespassed into her house and assaulted her a year back. An FIR was registered at Masuri police station after this complaint as well. “The two have been after my life and are intimidating my husband to back out from the cases. They have a long list of criminal cases against them and even our relatives and neighbours are afraid of supporting us. This Monday, the duo and their accomplice Gulfam once again threatened to kill me,” the woman claimed.

## Noida STF arrests henchman of Sunder Bhati gang,was involved in firing at DND over passage of trucks

**NOIDA:** The Noida unit of the STF has arrested a henchman of the Sunder Bhati-Anil Bhati gang who was on police radar for notoriously wielding the gang’s influence on the Noida-Delhi border and resorting to extortion under the name of the dreaded gang leaders. Mohit Bhati, whose father’s elder brother was well known to Sunder Bhati’s father, was arrested from near the Sector 21/25 intersection around 8:30am on Thursday after the STF officers got a tip-off about the movement of three members of the gang

near the area. A class 11 pass Mohit (20) was allegedly involved in threatening toll tax staffers at the DND toll to ensure that trucks pass through the toll without paying tax. According to STF officers, a trap was laid and a Volkswagen without any number plate was intercepted in which three accused including Mohit, his cousins Satpal and Sachin were travelling. While the STF team managed to catch hold of Mohit, the others managed to flee the spot. Deputy SP, STF Noida, Rajkumar Mishra told

TBC that the three accused have been involved in an incident of firing at the DND toll on May 29 last year. “The accused had resorted to firing upon the toll staff when they faced resistance from the latter upon their insistence that some of the trucks be allowed to pass without payment of toll tax. Mohit and some other accused were also involved in firing upon a Greater Noida resident Jitendra over a contract for scrap maintenance on September 9 last year. While Jitendra survived the attack, their motive was to ensure that

he withdraws from the contract,” he said. An FIR was lodged against Mohit under the Arms Act and sections 307 (attempt to murder) in Sector 20 police station. STF officers say that the accused and the gang members have been actively involved in spreading fear among toll tax collection staffers at the borders including at the DND and the Kalindi Kunj. On condition of anonymity, toll staffers too admit that gangsters regularly try to wield their influence for allowing their trucks to move without any tax payment.

## Ghaziabad DM fined over illegal colonies issue

**GHAZIABAD:** The Allahabad high court on Thursday imposed a fine of Rs 5000 on Ghaziabad DM for imposing a ban on registries in 321 illegal colonies. The order has come on a PIL filed by Tehsil Bar Association in which it has been said that Maheshwari was within her rights to stop registries as per registration manual and Act governing registries in the state. “The two judge bench of Allahabad HC comprising of Justice Sudhir Agarwal and Justice Rajender Kumar has imposed a fine of Rs 5000 on Ghaziabad district magistrate Ritu

Maheshwari for banning registries in illegal colonies in December last year” said Vivek Prakash Mishra, counsel for Tehsil Bar Association. “The court dismissing argument made on her behalf that ban was imposed in larger public interest saying that it was not in accordance with the existing laws governing registration of properties in the state” added Mishra. This is the second ruling by Allahabad HC in this case the first being on 8 January when a different bench had quashed DM’s ban order on a petition filed by a city based builder Virendra.

## NTPC engineer killed in car crash

**GREATER NOIDA:** A 26-year-old man died on the spot after the car he was travelling in collided with a stationary truck near the campus of National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) in Jarcha early on Saturday. The victim has been identified as Rahul Goyal, an original resident of Agra. He had been working at the NTPC plant in Dadri for the past three years as a junior engineer. Around 1.30am on Saturday, when Goyal was heading home to Agra after work, his Swift Dzire car hit a stationary truck parked outside gate number two of NTPC campus.

## 18-year-old private tutor held for girl’s rape, murder in GZB

**GHAZIABAD:** An 18-year-old private tutor was arrested on Wednesday for the alleged rape and murder of his six-year-old student in Loni. The girl’s body was found on a vacant plot near her home on Tuesday morning, a day after she went missing. Police said Faizul Islam lured the girl out of her residence on the pretext of buying her an eraser on Monday night, took her to his house in the same locality and then raped and strangulated her. He had initially hid the girl’s body on the terrace of his uncle’s house where he was living, before dumping it on a vacant plot the next morning. According to cops, the girl, a

**GNOIDA:** A 44-year-old woman has alleged that her 24-year-old daughter, who has been missing since Dec 14, was kidnapped by her partner and his four family members with whom she was living in Chotpur colony in Noida’s Phase 3 area for the past few years. ## Red Line Extension to link Dilshad Garden, Ghaziabad

**GHAZIABAD:** The second phase of Delhi Metro in Ghaziabad could begin passenger services next month as funds that couldn’t be released till the Centre gave a formal approval will now be available. The nod to the Red Line Extension (New Bus Stand to Dilshad Garden), and the central government’s contribution of Rs 324.87 crore for the project, came at a Cabinet meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday. This now paves the way for the commissioner of metro railway safety

(CMRS) to inspect the corridor, work on which is complete. The CMRS inspection, according to officials, will require around 10 days. The inspection dates will, however, be set by the CMRS. The Ghaziabad Development Authority (GDA) is hopeful that by mid-February, the project will be ready for commissioning. “We are told that after CMRS inspection, the operation of this corridor will start by mid-February. The state government can decide on its inauguration,” said Kanchan Verma, vice-chairperson, GDA.

## Techie robbed at gunpoint near metro station

**NOIDA:** A 25-year-old engineer was robbed of Rs 28,000 cash at gunpoint near City Centre metro station on Friday night. The engineer, Rishabh Mandal, is a resident of Delhi’s Pandav Nagar area. In a complaint filed with the Sector 24 police, Mandal said that he had visited Ghaziabad on Friday evening. While returning, when he reached Noida City Centre metro station around 9pm, a person came running towards Mandal and informed him that his sister had met with an accident and he needed help. Believing the person, Mandal decided to accompany him to help the victim.

## Gang helps candidates crack police exam, 3 held

**NOIDA:** The Special Task Force (STF) of city police arrested three persons on Sunday for allegedly impersonating candidates during an exam for recruiting constables for UP police in Mathura. Police have also found some electronic communication devices, spy camera, admit cards, etc. from their possession. The arrested persons have been identified as Pawan, Rajkumar and Jivan Singh, all three residents of Aligarh. Raj Kumar Mishra, DSP at Noida STF, said that on Sunday the STF received information about some people

impersonating in the police recruitment exams. “A team immediately conducted a search at an examination centre and found one candidate dubious. On inspection, it was found that the accused, Jivan Singh, was impersonating in the exam. Police also found a student’s examination identity card from his possession,” he added. During questioning, Singh revealed that one Pawan was the gang leader of the racket and the former only appeared in the examination when directed by him. Police laid a trap and arrested Pawan from the neighbourhood.

## Kids’ lessons for cops on traffic snarls

**GREATER NOIDA:** The Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority on Sunday organised a hackathon and carnival parade in the four-day-long winter carnival that started from January 25. The Authority also held a mobile app contest in which students presented models and gave suggestions on improving cleanliness, traffic management, women’s safety, patrolling, maintenance of parks, etc. The programme was organised in Sharda University. Ajit Kumar, joint registrar of Sharda University, said students also suggested models for waste management.

## 4 resident welfare associations to clean their own roads, drains

**NOIDA:** The Noida Authority has allowed the resident welfare associations (RWAs) of four sectors to execute sanitation work in their areas from next month. The RWAs of sectors 47, 49, 52 and 66 will sweep internal roads, clean garbage, dispose of waste at designated places and execute all such work that were carried out by contractors hired the Authority till now. The decision follows repeated complaints by residents about poor sanitation work by the private contractors. The residents’ association had proposed that they could execute this

exercise at 75% of the amount that is paid by the Authority to the contractors. Rajesh Kumar Singh, OSD at the Authority, said the proposal of the four RWAs had been approved recently by CEO Alok Tandon. “They will start the work from February 1 and it will be executed in keeping with the labour laws. While the Authority will continue door-to-door garbage collection, the RWAs will execute work like sweeping of internal roads, cleaning drains, etc. They will also dump the waste at designated places,” Singh said.

जो तीन दिन में डीपीआर तैयार कर जीडीए को सौंपेगा। मार्च से इसका निर्माण कार्य आरंभ होने के साथ ही इसे एक वर्ष में पूरा करने का लक्ष्य रखा गया है। बता दें कि मधुबन बापूधाम में 45 मीटर चौड़े आरओबी के निर्माण में 15 करोड़ रुपये का खर्च आएगा, जिसका प्रस्ताव जीडीए बोर्ड बैठक में पास हो चुका है। आरओबी निर्माण के बाद एनएच 58 से हापुड़ रोड, एनएच—24, शास्त्रीनगर, गोविंदपुरम, हरसांव, हापुड़ एवं नोएडा की ओर जाने वाले वाहनों को समय की बचत के साथ ही राजनगर एक्सटेंशन चौराहे और हापुड़ चुंगी पर लगने वाले जाम से निजात मिलेगी।
