इंस्टीट्यूट को हर माह 400 नेपकिन निशुल्क देगा रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन

गाजियाबाद : दौलतपुरा मॉडल टाउन जीटी रोड स्थित इंग्राहम इंस्टीट्यूट की छात्राओं को अब सेनेटरी नेपकिन की अचानक जरूरत पड़ने पर बाजार नहीं जाना पड़ेगा और न ही पैसे खर्च करने पड़ेंगे। आरएचएएम (रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन) द्वारा महिला स्वच्छता जागरूकता अभियान के तहत इंग्राहम इंस्टीट्यूट में शनिवार को एक सेनेटरी नेपकिन वेडिंग मशीन लगाई गई। जिसका उद्घाटन असिस्टेंट गवर्नर जोन-16 रो.सुनील गौतम व असिस्टेंट गवर्नर जोन-11 रो. प्रशांत राज शर्मा ने फीता काटकर किया। इस मशीन की मदद से छात्राएं जरूरत पड़ने पर निशुल्क नेपकिन प्राप्त कर



सकती है। इतना ही नहीं वे नेपकिन को अपनी मां, बहन या अन्य परिजन के लिए घर भी ले जा सकती है। इसके लिए उन्हें कोई पैसे नहीं देने होंगे। इस दौरान इंस्टीट्यूट को 400

नेपकिन भी निशुल्क दी गई। इसके अलावा हर माह 400 नेपकिन रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन द्वारा दी जाएगी। यदि ज्यादा की जरूरत होगी तो ज्यादा नेपकिन इंस्टीट्यूट को

दी जाएगी। रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन के चेयर डा. धीरज भार्गव ने बताया कि इससे महिला सशक्तिकरण को बढ़ावा दिया जा रहा है। वेडिंग मशीन में एक साथ 25 नेपकिन डाली जा सकती है। इंस्टीट्यूट को 400 नेपकिन एक्सट्रा दी गई है। उन्होंने कहा कि अधिकांश छात्राओं को मुश्किल दिनों के समय काफी परेशानियों का सामना करना पड़ता है। इसी को ध्यान में रखते हुए सेनेटरी नेपकिन मशीन लगाई गई है। इंग्राहम इंस्टीट्यूट को जरूरत के हिसाब से हर माह निशुल्क नेपकिन दी जाएगी।

दिलशाद गार्डन-न्यू बस अड्डा कॉरिडोर को मिली हरी झंडी

गाजियाबाद : दिलशाद गार्डन से न्यू बस अड्डा मेट्रो कॉरिडोर पर मंगलवार सुबह सेपटी ट्रायल होने के बाद इसे हरी झंडी मिल गई है। जल्द ही इसका उद्घाटन किया जाएगा। कमिश्नर मेट्रो रेल सेपटी (सीएमआरएस) एसके पाठक ने 9.41 किलोमीटर लंबे कॉरिडोर की मंगलवार को सेपटी परखी। सप्ताह भर में इसकी रिपोर्ट आने के बाद मेट्रो के संचालन का रास्ता साफ होगा। मंगलवार न्यू बस अड्डा मेट्रो कॉरिडोर पर सेपटी ट्रायल होने को लेकर साफ सफाई की चाक-चौबंद व्यवस्था रही। इस दौरान यहां सुरक्षा व्यवस्था को लेकर सुरक्षाकर्मी तैनात रहे। हालांकि अभी सेपटी स्कैनर स्टेशन पर नहीं लगाए गए हैं, लेकिन सुबह से ही न्यू बस अड्डा



मेट्रो स्टेशन पर चहल-पहल के साथ ही साज-सज्जा की गई थी। मेट्रो कमिश्नर मेट्रो रेल सेपटी (सीएमआरएस) एसके पाठक ने सुबह करीब 11 बजे हरी झंडी दिखाते हुए मेट्रो का सेपटी ट्रायल कराया। यह कॉरिडोर दिल्ली मेट्रो की रेड लाइन का विस्तार है। बता दें कि इस पर शहीद नगर, राजबाग, राजेंद्र नगर, श्याम पार्क, मोहननगर, अर्थला, हिंडन रिवर और न्यू बस अड्डा स्टेशन बनाया गया है। इसके निर्माण में विभिन्न मंदों से 1781.21 करोड़ रुपये लागत आई है।

Ghaziabad to get its first electric crematorium in February

GHAZIABAD: The city will get its first electric crematorium February. To be set up along the banks of Hindon, the crematorium is expected to be one more step towards curbing the high pollution levels, especially in winter. According to an official of Ghaziabad Development Authority, nearly 90% work is complete and the machines will be installed within a fortnight. "We have spent Rs 70 lakh on the infrastructure and Rs 49 lakh will be spent on the machines, which will be installed in 15 days," said Ajay Singh, executive engineer, GDA. Owing to immense air pollution that traditional cremation causes, the district magistrate in December had



written to GDA to expedite the work for electric crematorium. "Even the NGT in 2016 had asked various municipalities to switch over to electric crematorium," said Singh. Acharya Prince, who oversees cremations at Hindon ghat says that on an average, nearly 15 cremations are done in traditional way every day in the city. "Sometimes we have 30 cremations in a day. Cremations in traditional method consumes at least 500 kg of woods to light one pyre.

गाजियाबाद : आरएचएएम (रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन) द्वारा सोमवार को वर्ल्ड कैंसर डे पर हापुड़ चुंगी स्थित इंग्राहम इंस्टीट्यूट गर्ल्स डिग्री कॉलेज में कैंसर पर हेल्थ टॉक का आयोजन किया गया। रोटरी हेल्थ अवेयरनेस मिशन व बीएलके हॉस्पिटल दिल्ली द्वारा आयोजित जागरूक कार्यक्रम में लोगों ने कैंसर पर सवाल-जवाब भी किए। मुख्य अतिथि डीजीएनडी रो.अशोक अग्रवाल ने भी लोगों को कैंसर के प्रति जागरूक किया। इस दौरान आरएचएएम ने कॉलेज को 350 नेपकिन भी दी। आरएचएएम के चेयर डा.धीरज भार्गव ने बताया कि पांच माह पूर्व कॉलेज में सेनेटरी नेपकिन वेंडिंग मशीन लगाई गई थी। अब कॉलेज को प्रतिमाह जरूरत के हिसाब से निशुल्क नेपकिन आरएचएएम द्वारा दी जाएगी। जिससे छात्राएं संक्रमण से बची रही। डा.भार्गव ने बताया कि कॉलेज में 9 से 14 साल तक की छात्राओं को सर्वाइकल कैंसर के टीके लगाए जाएंगे। इस वैकसीन की बाजार में कीमत करीब 3500 रुपये है जिसे आरएचएएम के माध्यम से निशुल्क लगाया जाएगा। इंग्राहम इंस्टीट्यूट गर्ल्स डिग्री कॉलेज के ऑटोडोरियम में ब्रेस्ट व



सर्वाइकल कैंसर पर आयोजित जागरूकता कार्यक्रम को संबोधित करते हुए बीएलके हॉस्पिटल की डा.निधि नैय्यर ने कहा कि कैंसर जानलेवा बीमारी है, जो किसी को भी हो सकती है, लेकिन कैंसर के लक्षणों को यदि समय पर पहचान लिया जाये तो इसके इलाज में आसानी होती है। कैंसर के शुरुआती स्टेज में पता चलने पर इसके इलाज में ज्यादा दिक्कत नहीं होती है और मरीज को बचाया जा सकता है। वहीं रो.डा.कुसुम चोपड़ा ने कहा कि जिन लोगों को कैंसर होता है उनका वजन असामान्य रूप से कम होने लगता है। यदि बिना किसी प्रयास के शरीर का वजन 10 पौंड से ज्यादा कम हो जाये तो इसे कैंसर का प्राथमिक लक्षण के रूप में देखा जा सकता है। बुखार भी कैंसर का एक सामान्य लक्षण होता है। वहीं डा.धीरज भार्गव ने कहा कि त्वचा में असामान्य परिवर्तन कैंसर के



संकेत हो सकते हैं। अगर किसी व्यक्ति की त्वचा बेवजह सांवली या काली पड़ने लगे हो तो यह कैंसर का संकेत हो सकता है। त्वचा का पीला पड़ना भी कैंसर होने का संकेत देता है। अगर किसी को लम्बे समय से कब्ज की शिकायत रहती हो अथवा कोई लम्बे समय से डायरिया से परेशान हो तो ये कोलोन कैंसर या उदर के कैंसर के संकेत हो सकते हैं। स्तनों में गांठ होना ब्रेस्ट कैंसर के लक्षण हैं। ब्रेस्ट कैंसर केवल महिलाओं को ही नहीं होता, पुरुष भी इसकी गिरफ्त में आते हैं। लिम्फ नोड्स में परिवर्तन होना भी कैंसर का

संकेत है। लिम्फ नोड्स में या गले में एक गांठ या सूजन हो तो चिंता का विषय है। मुख्य अतिथि डीजीएनडी रो.अशोक अग्रवाल ने कहा कि यदि स्मोकिंग और तंबाकू चबाने के दौरान मुंह या जीभ में सफेद दाग व धब्बे दिखे तो यह कैंसर के लक्षण हो सकते हैं। यह ओरल कैंसर के लक्षण हैं। कैंसर होने पर पाचन क्रिया भी प्रभावित होता है। यदि खाना अच्छे से पच नहीं रहा है, तो यह पेट के कैंसर का लक्षण हो सकता है। असिस्टेंट गवर्नर रो.सुनील गौतम व प्रशांत राज शर्मा ने बताया कि देश भर में कैंसर जैसी बीमारी से मरने वालों

की संख्या दिनोदिन बढ़ती जा रही है। कहीं ना कहीं ऐसी बीमारियों के लिए हमारी आरामतलब जीवनशैली और खानपान की गलत आदतें जिम्मेदार है। इस दौरान एजी सुनील गौतम, प्रशांत राज शर्मा, सुरेंद्र शर्मा, डा.अजय, रोटरी क्लब ऑफ दिल्ली लिगेसी के अध्यक्ष मनीष गुप्ता, दिल्ली सेंट्रल की अध्यक्ष रीना अग्रवाल, राजेश मिश्रा, संदीप मिगलानी, अखिलेंद्र गर्ग, सीवेंद्र सिंह, पंकज गुप्ता, अजय सिन्हा, एमसी गौड के अलावा प्रिंसिपल सरिता आदि मौजूद थे।



EDITORIAL

A budget for Bharat and India

For the first time, an accounting professional (a merit ranked chartered accountant) presented a budget which balanced the needs of an election-bound government and an economy wanting to grow at a faster pace for better inclusion. It is a budget which boosts consumption through support to farmers and the rural economy, by providing direct income transfer, to middle-class taxpayers through tax rebates and to entrepreneurs through ease of doing business. More importantly, the path of fiscal prudence is not missed while creating a growth momentum for the economy. The budget comes against the background of pioneering work done to make India more healthy through Swachh Bharat and Ayushman Bharat missions. Most of the places I visited in the last few years have seen a remarkable improvement in cleanliness. Work has also been done to make India more tax compliant. Our tax to GDP ratio for the bulk of our history was comparable to poor African nations. Through the launch of progressive taxation like GST and disruptive reform like demonetisation, the tax base has been expanded by more than 60 per cent in the last five years.

With the promulgation of insolvency laws, bankers have the authority to discipline big borrowers and recover their dues. Indians invest a large part of their savings in gold. This results in foreign exchange reserves being spent on the import of gold. India is like a patient who wants to improve her health but is donating blood rather than receiving a blood transfusion. Our import of gold is far more than the net foreign direct investment received in the last 17 years. This is despite the fact that in the last few years, India has become the largest FDI recipient in the world, overtaking China. The launch of gold bonds and the improvement in tax compliance have led to an increase in financial savings. Much has been done to tame the Mahisasur of the economy inflation. Through fiscal and monetary discipline, inflation has been brought down from double digits to low single digits. Inflation is a silent killer. It hurts the poor most.

The budget introduced the path-breaking provision of an income transfer of Rs 6,000 per year to 12 crore rural families. This will transfer Rs 75,000 crore to poor farmers every year. This, along with the increase in minimum support prices and the MGNREGA allocation, will support rural consumption. Lower-middle class taxpayers will have more disposable income because of the tax rebate for income up to Rs 5 lakh and the relaxation on capital gains with respect to investment in a second property. They will also benefit from the relaxation of tax on notional rental income of a second self-occupied property. The debt market, while taking comfort from the path of fiscal prudence, will keep a watch on RBI policy in the next week. It will be interesting to see if the RBI gives an actual policy rate cut or guidance to rate cuts in the future to support the growth momentum. The equity market will focus on Q4 business momentum and election results to chart out its next moves.

The budget, which meets the aspirations of Bharat and India, also comes up to the expectations of the global rating agencies as well as foreign investors by supporting growth with a firm grip on fiscal discipline.

After Pune and Noida, Gurugram wants to try out tyre killers

GURUGRAM: Tyre killers will be installed at some underpasses in the city to tackle wrong-side driving, which has led to several fatal accidents in the past. The project has been initiated by DLF, and the metal strips will be installed in Golf Course underpasses within three months after receiving the approval of Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran (HSVP). Pune was the first city in India to install tyre killers on a housing society road but the strip had to be removed after police objected to the project, terming it dangerous. Similarly, Noida installed tyre killers in sectors 76 and 77

earlier this month, but the move was also criticized, and later miscreants damaged the devices within a day of being installed. The strips, which have spikes pointed away from the flow of vehicles, puncture the tyres if a vehicle comes from the wrong direction. DLF has written to HSVP seeking permission to install tyre rippers (or killers) at different locations in the underpasses on Golf Course Road. "Some commuters who travel along this road resort to wrong-side driving. Due to wrong-side movement of vehicles, accidents happen very frequently.

UP farmers call off protest, but vow to return to DND if demands not met

NOIDA: Farmers from six districts of western Uttar Pradesh, seeking enhanced compensation for their land acquired before 2013, agreed to temporarily withdraw their protest on DND flyway on Saturday evening. The breakthrough came after the district magistrate gave them a written assurance to facilitate a meeting with chief minister Yogi Adityanath. The farmers, who were camping on one side of the DND flyway with tractors, tents, food, etc, insisted that they would not leave the spot despite repeated negotiations with the district magistrate and

senior police officers. As many as 10 SHOs, 10 police companies—five each from both Noida and Delhi Police—DM, SSP, SP (crime), city magistrate, SP (traffic) and over 200 police officers reached the spot to ensure that the farmers don't march to the PMO. Delhi Police had lined up ahead of the toll in the Delhi area with tear gas and bomb disposal squads on their toes. In a symbolic protest, the farmers raised their hands tied with bands, stating that the administration wanted to "suppress" their protest and arrest them. After many negotiations, the farmers

agreed to leave the spot by 3 pm, but only after the DM agreed to hand over a written document signed by himself to get meetings arranged between farmers and the chief minister as well as Yamuna Authority. They also sought a CBI probe into the land acquisitions that took place between 2008 and 2012 during the BSP rule. They questioned the land acquisition in Ghaziabad's Kachairia village for the hi-tech city project, the one at Mandola village for a housing project, land acquired in villages in Yamuna Authority area and for the Gail India pipeline project in Bihar.

Noida hands over upkeep of parks in five sectors to RWAs

NOIDA: The Noida Authority has permitted the RWAs of five sectors to carry out horticulture work in their respective areas from next month. The RWAs of sectors 19, 20, 35, 39 and 108 will maintain parks and green belts, and execute all such work like planting and pruning of trees and watering them that were carried out by private contractors hired by the Authority till now. The delegation of horticulture work

to five RWAs comes just two days after residents' associations of sectors 47, 49, 52 and 66 were given permission to execute sanitation work by Noida Authority. The decision to allot horticulture and sanitation work to the RWAs follows repeated complaints by the residents about the poor services by contractors. "We are still working out the costs. "However, we are yet to receive the cost details from the Noida Authority.

18-year-old rapes minor, arrested

NOIDA: A four-year-old girl was allegedly raped by an 18-year-old man in GNoida on Wednesday morning. The accused, Mohan, sexually assaulted the girl around 11am when she was playing on the terrace of his home. He was arrested after the girl's medical examination confirmed rape. Rabupura SHO told TBC that the child would often play at the terrace of Mohan's home. He is an acquaintance to her family, police said. "Both the survivor's home and his house are located at a few metres away from each other. An FIR has been lodged against Mohan under Section 376 of IPC and under Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.

2 builders held for not paying labour cess, RERA dues

NOIDA: Directors of two private real estate firms were arrested on Thursday for non-payment of nearly Rs 4 crore of labour cess dues and those towards the Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA), the Gautam Buddha Nagar administration said. The directors of IVR Prime IT Sez firm and PME Power Solution India were arrested in the afternoon by revenue officials in Dadri and Sadar tehsils of the district, the administration said.

Two killed, three injured in Agra-Lucknow expressway accident

AGRA: In a road accident on early Sunday morning on Agra-Lucknow expressway, BJP state general secretary Subrata Pathak’s father and uncle were killed and three other relatives were injured. The accident occurred at around 3.20am near milestone 192, Faguha Bhataa village of Tirwa police jurisdiction, Kannauj district. In the accident, Subrata’s father Omprakash Pathak (65), and his uncle Mahesh Chandra (59) were killed. Mahesh hailed from Kakadev area of Kanpur. After the accident, UP 100 and ambulance rushed

to rescue the victims and took them to the hospital. The deceased bodies were sent for autopsy in government hospital, while the injured identified as Ashok Kumar, Abha Tiwari and Jaishankar were admitted for medical treatment. Informed about the accident, district magistrate of Kannauj Ravinder Kumar and superintendent of police Amrendra Prasad Singh went to the hospital and met the victim’s relatives and assured every possible help. “The accident occurred due to dense fog.

SHO arrested for taking Rs 8 lakh bribe was former top cop’s PR man

NOIDA: Inspector Manoj Pant, who was caught red-handed inside Sector 20 police station on Wednesday accepting Rs 8 lakh bribe from a call centre owner after striking a deal to remove the latter’s name from an FIR, has had a chequered career with Uttar Pradesh Police. A 2000-batch Uttar Pradesh Police Services officer, Pant has seen both highs and lows in the 18 years he has been a cop. Till only a year ago, he was former Gautam Budh Nagar SSP Ajaypal Sharma’s public relations officer.

Wall collapses at RPF barracks, two cops injured

GHAZIABAD: Two head constables of Railway Protection Force (RPF) were injured when a wall collapsed at the RPF’s barracks in Kotegaon on Saturday. The injured officials were sitting on a bench outside the barracks when the second floor wall, which is under construction, collapsed on them. The injured officers, Satendra Singh (52) and Yashvir Singh (54), residents of Meerut, were admitted to a private hospital and the doctors have said that they need to be kept under observation for some days as

they have received serious injuries. “The contractor has used poor quality material to construct the wall,” said an RPF official. A scooter parked at the spot was also damaged. Shiv Bhusan Dixit, sub-inspector, Kotegaon told TBC that the 50-metre wall fell around 11am when the both head constables were sitting on a bench close to the building. “The wall was constructed a few days ago, but it seems the beam, required to support the wall during construction, was not installed by the contractor,” he added.

Ahmedabad cops get average of 300 cyber fraud cases a month

AHMEDABAD: Since demonetization was announced in November 2016, a huge number of people had to adopt digital transactions overnight without awareness of associated traps and pitfalls. Online fraudsters are making the most of this opportunity and allegedly online frauds have shot up with the boom in online payment adoption. The cyber cell of the city police, which has recently been granted the status of an independent police station, has been receiving 300 applications on an average per month to probe online monetary frauds.

This gang stole 300 transformers in 3 years, 10 held

GHAZIABAD: Ten members of a gang, which had stolen more than 300 transformers in the past three years, were arrested in the city on Sunday. The accused included two scrap dealers. Police have recovered transformers and their spare parts made of copper and aluminium, LT & HT cables worth over Rs 10 lakh, besides country-made pistols, live cartridges and a few vehicles from them. The accused have more than 24 cases registered against them in Ghaziabad, Noida and the adjoining districts. Their accomplices are still absconding. The accused have been identified as Aamir,

Ashraf, Suwalin, Aadil, Farman, Parvez, Kurban and Danish, all residents of Bulandshahr, Akil, a resident of Gautam Budh Nagar and Ikram, a resident of Hapur. The three accomplices who are on the run are Shahzad, a resident of Hapur, Yunus, a scrap dealer and a resident of Ghaziabad, and Nazakat, a resident of Gautam Budh Nagar. SP (rural) Arvind Kumar Maurya said the accused had a long criminal history and was involved in such thefts for the past several years and the police department was mulling imposing the National Security Act on them. He added that

the gang targeted areas on the outskirts of the main city to avoid detection by residents and police. “They would gather at a place and using cutters, would disrupt the power supply and defuse the transformer and then remove it from its place. Before fleeing the spot, they would empty the transformer oil at the spot to lessen the weight of the machine. Copper and aluminium parts inside the transformers fetch a good price in the black market,” the SP added. The police said the gang leader was Kurban, who was not only involved in stealing the transformers but also ran a scrap shop.

House collapses after fire; woman dead

GHAZIABAD : A 35-year-old woman died and seven people were injured after a building caught fire and collapsed in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad district, police said. The fire broke out in a bakery on the ground floor of the three-storey house at Ikram Nagar Colony in Loni town on the intervening night of Wednesday and Thursday, the police said. Two gas cylinders exploded one by one, following which the roof of the house came down. Apart from fire fighters, a team of the National Disaster Response Force was also pressed into service at 3.15 am, an officer said.

Student among three who killed transgender

GHAZIABAD: Three persons, including a polytechnic student, were arrested on Friday for allegedly killing a 35-year-old transgender on the night of January 29 in Muradnagar. Police said a month ago, the victim, Shabana alias Shamshad, had publicly humiliated the main accused Himanshu for inappropriately touching her in an auto-rickshaw. Himanshu had subsequently followed Shabana to her rented accommodation in Dagar colony of Muradnagar and allegedly hatched a plan to take revenge. He roped in two of his friends, Pradeep Kumar

and Keshav Thakur, to execute the murder. On Wednesday morning, police had found Shabana’s body lying inside her house. Preliminary probe indicated that she was attacked with a blunt object, but further investigation and autopsy report revealed that Shabana was shot with a country-made pistol. SP (rural) Arvind Kumar Maurya said, “The investigation revealed that after Himanshu, who is in the third year of polytechnic course, was publicly humiliated and even beaten up by Shabana, he followed her and found out the area where she lived.

SHO sent to 14-day jail, cops may search his house

Greater Noida: An anti-corruption court in Meerut has sent SHO Manoj Pant and three local reporters, arrested for taking Rs 8 lakh to alter an FIR against a call centre owner, to 14-day judicial custody. Police said they have suspended the SHO and also applied for a warrant to search his house. Noida, said the four accused were booked under sections 7, 8 and 13 (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, Section 384 (extortion) of IPC and Section 30 of the Arms Act.

Delhi Metro’s Phase-IV gets no funds as nod awaited

NEW DELHI: Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) received a grant of only Rs 414.7 crore for two of its ongoing projects — extension of corridors in Noida (Sector 32 to Electronic City) and Ghaziabad (Dilshad Garden to New Bus Adda) — in the interim budget for 2019-20. Senior DMRC officials said this is apart from the total funds allocated for all metro projects in the country, which is Rs 17,713.9 crore. In last year’s budget too, there was no separate allocation for DMRC and a grant of only Rs 50 crore was made. The

quantum of funds to be disbursed to DMRC from the consolidated fund will depend on the approval of the Phase-IV project, a source said. “We are satisfied with the grant received as it is what we had requested for. The revised estimates will be sent to the Centre in the following months. We didn’t request for any funds for Phase-IV as it is yet to be sanctioned by the Centre. As soon as we get the nod for the project, we will request for funds from the consolidated allocation,” a senior official said.

UP chief secretary sets ball rolling for international cricket stadium in GZB

GHAZIABAD: The Uttar Pradesh chief secretary Anup Chandra Pandey on Wednesday convened a meeting of GDA officials and UP Cricket Association in Lucknow over upcoming international cricket stadium in Ghaziabad's Raj Nagar Extension area. The GDA and UPCA for long had locked horns over issues of latter's demand of increased Floor Area Ratio(FAR) and exemption from acquisition fee. As per a GDA official who was present in the meeting, the chief secretary has agreed to UPCA's demand which will pave way for early

resumption of work on the proposed stadium. "The chief secretary has given a go ahead for land use change from agricultural to commercial on 10 acres of land out of total 33 acres of land where stadium will come up," said Ishtiyaque Ahmed, Chief Architect and Town Planner, GDA. "The UPCA on 10 acres of land where is proposes to construct club and shops will be brought under commercial land use where the FAR is 2.5 while in remaining 23 acres where stadium will come up the FAR will be 0.4," added Ahmed. On the issue of acquisition fee Pandey has given in principle

approval for exempting Rs. 7.7 crore of acquisition fee. "The chief secretary has in a way exempted UPCA from paying acquisition fee as the matter will be taken up with state government with recommendation that it may be exempted," said Ahmed. The association has been reluctant to pay up the acquisition fee on the ground that 34 acres of land which it acquired directly from the farmers who have been compensated and since GDA had no role to play in this it cannot demand acquisition fee from them. But GDA was in a bind as the objection was raised by CAG in which it had

questioned GDA for not taking acquisition fee. Since GDA and UPCA had locked horns over these issues as a result work on propsed stadium was stopped for an year now. But in November last year UP chief minister Yogi Adityanath had made an announced that international cricket stadium in Ghaziabad will come up shortly. It was after the announcement GDA and UPCA sat together to iron out the differences. The 35 acres of land near Raj Nagar Extension has already been purchased from the farmers by UPCA at a cost of Rs 80 crore.

Woman trying to save kids dies in blaze

GHAZIABAD: A 32-year-old woman pushing out her four children from the window of her home that had caught fire died when the two-storey building collapsed following a cylinder blast in Loni in the early hours of Thursday. Police said after Fatima had ensured the safety of all her children, she lost consciousness from the smoke emanating from the flames. The fire had possibly started from a short circuit in the ground-floor bakery owned by her husband. Minutes after the flames started spreading, two cooking gas cylinders kept in the bakery exploded, which brought a portion of the building down. The woman

died when the house collapsed, police said. One of Fatima's sons, Aneez (7), was injured when his mother threw him out of the window and he landed on the ground. The other children were caught by neighbours, who used a net. A fire tender was also injured trying to fight the flames. The fire was doused after four hours. According to police, Fatima lived with her husband Naveel Ahmad (34) and four children in the two-storey building in Ikram colony. Naveel ran a bakery along with his two brothers from the ground-floor of the house. It was in the bakery where the fire started around 1am.

NCRTC starts pile load test on Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS corridor

GHAZIABAD: A four-year-old boy was charred to death and five others, including women and children, suffered burn injuries after two adjacent hutments caught fire in Sahibabad's Bhopura Kuti area late Monday night. The injured have been admitted to GTB hospital in Delhi. The deceased has been identified as Ali Hasan, son of a rag picker. The fire first broke out from a candle around 11.30pm in a hutment next to Ali. Ali's father Rahim and Iqbal's hutments were located adjacent to each other. After the fire broke out in Iqbal's residence he ran out with his wife Rehana (25) and four children – Sania

(5), Haseena (1.5 months), Sarmin (4) and Imamuddin (2). However, except Iqbal, all others suffered burn injuries and are presently admitted in GTB hospital. Even before Iqbal could seek help and douse the fire, it spread to Rahim's house. Rahim too rushed out of the house with his wife Reshma and two-year-old daughter, Sahiba, but the family could not save Ali. However, no causality was reported in this incident. On Tuesday, circle officer of Sahibabad, Rakesh Mishra and city magistrate Yashvardhan Srivastava conducted an inspection of the area and ordered an inquiry into the death.

CBI books 2 of its officers for taking Rs 10 lakh bribe from land scam accused

GREATER NOIDA: The CBI on Sunday filed an FIR against two of its own officers for allegedly accepting a bribe of Rs 10 lakh to give a clean chit to three accused in the Rs 126-crore land scam at Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA). In the FIR, the central agency has mentioned the names of V S Rathore, an inspector at the CBI's anti-corruption unit in Ghaziabad, and Sunil Dutt, an assistant sub-inspector at the CBI academy. It also mentioned Ranveer Singh, a former YEIDA tehsildar who allegedly paid the Rs 10 lakh bribe, and unnamed police

officers. On Sunday evening, the investigating agency summoned circle officer Nishank Sharma, who had been probing the land scam before it was transferred to the CBI last year, to its headquarters in Delhi for questioning. After a few hours, Sharma was transferred to the police headquarters in Lucknow, which the police termed a routine administrative shuffle. Earlier in the day, around 11am, a team of six CBI officers raided the house of former tehsildar Singh, an accused in the YEIDA land scam, and searched for around four hours. Singh has been shown as absconding in police

records. The Rs 126-crore land scam dates back to 2013, when then YEIDA CEO PC Gupta had approved the purchase of 58 hectares in Mathura though the land had no utility. The police had named 21 YEIDA officials in connection with the scam, of whom only five, including Gupta, have been arrested so far. The case was handed to the CBI in June last year. According to the FIR registered on Sunday, former tehsildar Singh had paid Rs 10 lakh to the two CBI officers and a few policemen so that three of his "friends" who had surrendered recently in connection with the scam are

given a clean chit. "It is learnt that the accused have been managing the investigation of this case with the help of unidentified officials of Noida Police. The accused Ranveer Singh has already paid Rs 10 lakh on January 31 to the two officials for showing nil recovery report in respect of his three accomplices during their police remand," the FIR reads. It also claims that in addition to the Rs 10 lakh, the two CBI officers had demanded Rs 25 lakh from the former YEIDA official for "influencing the investigation" in his favour. The CBI said Singh had agreed to pay Rs 20 lakh to the two officers on Saturday.

2020 deadline for five stations of Aqua Line Extension

GREATER NOIDA: The first five stations of Aqua Line extension connecting Noida with Greater Noida West will be completed by 2020, officials in the Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority (GNIDA) have expressed hope. The five stations — from Sector 51 in Noida to Sector 2 in Greater Noida — will be built in the first phase. In the next stage, the metro will be extended to sectors 3, 10, 12 and Knowledge Park V. The first phase will be 9.15km long, while the second one will be 14.95km. GNIDA CEO Narendra

Bhooshan said tenders would be floated once the rates are decided. “We are deliberating on the rate for development. If the rate is similar to that of existing Aqua Line, a tender will be floated soon,” he said. The first phase of the project is estimated to cost around Rs 1,521 crore. The metro corridor will be developed by GNIDA, Noida Authority, the state and central governments. The project had been in a limbo for so long as the route was not considered economically viable because of the thin population around the proposed stations.

Factory guard shot at in Greater Noida

GNOIDA: A 38-year-old security guard at a mobile manufacturing unit was allegedly shot at by car-borne assailants around 11.15pm in Ecotech 1 area on Thursday. The victim has been identified as Dhiresh Kumar, a resident of Hardoi. He sustained gunshot wounds in his abdomen and his condition is said to be critical. Police said the accused arrived at the factory in a car and asked Kumar to guide them for an address. After Kumar told them the route, they shot at him and fled, said another guard, Hari Om Singh. The unidentified men have been booked under Section 307 of IPC.

65 per cent of country's mobile phones are manufactured in Noida: UP Dy CM

Lucknow : Sixty-five per cent of country's mobile phones are manufactured now in Noida alone, said Uttar Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Dinesh Sharma Monday, claiming that UP has a strong potential to surpass the growth of Gujarat, Maharashtra and Andhra Pradesh. UP emergence as a hub of mobile phone production has also stopped its youths' exodus to other states for jobs. "If 100 mobile phones are produced in India, Noida alone accounts for 65 such phones. It means 65 per cent of the mobile phones of the country are manufactured in UP. This

One-year-old dies as father throws her on floor

NOIDA: A one-year-old girl died after her father threw her on to the floor in a drunken stupor in Sector 71 on Wednesday evening. The girl battled for life for one night before succumbing to her injuries on Thursday morning. The accused is absconding. According to police, Pankaj, originally from Gursahayganj in Kannauj district, entered into an altercation with his wife Gudiya (28) at his rented accommodation in Garhi Chaukhandi village on Wednesday evening.

Hindon airport in Ghaziabad to be operational for UDAN flights by March

New Delhi : Tata Communications Wednesday posted a net profit of Rs 173.3 crore for the December 2018 quarter, against Rs 10.12 crore in the year-ago period, on robust data business and 'growth services'. Masked men take away two ATMs from Greater Noida, Hapur

NOIDA: Unidentified robbers took away at least two ATMs of Axis Bank, one containing Rs 10 lakh, in the past two days in Noida and neighbouring Hapur district. While five masked men allegedly uprooted an ATM from Rachna market on the NH-91 in Badalpur area on Thursday night, another ATM was taken away from Pilukhwa area in Hapur district on Friday night. Both the ATM booths were not guarded and their security depended on a locked shutter. According to police, at least five robbers were caught on CCTV taking away the ATM from Rachna market around 2.30 am on February 1.

Noida homebuyers: Will use NOTA if no funds given to finish projects

NOIDA: Claiming that they have been disappointed by the Union budget as it did not allocate a stress-fund to complete stranded residential projects in Noida, over 200 homebuyers under the umbrella body of Noida Extension Flat Owners Association (Nefowa) launched a social media protest # SayNoToNeta #SayYesToNota on Sunday. The buyers claimed they have been misled by politicians in the past and despite considerable litigation, the government has failed to resolve the issue of projects like Amrapali which has over 25,000 buyers who have

not been given their flats despite having paid up 70% to 90% of the cost. The Nefowa gathering had a significant representation from buyers of Amrapali group. “We were hopeful that the Union government would ration some amount to help agencies like the NBCC to complete the pending projects of Amrapali. An initial fund support for the government has to be created for anyone to step in and complete the pending work. We had been demanding a stress-fund for this completion as no agency can help without initial financial support,” Abhishek Kumar, president, Nefowa, said.

Out of job, 25-year-old sets self on fire

GREATER NOIDA: A 25-year-old man, an alleged drug addict, committed suicide by pouring kerosene and setting himself on fire. Bable Ram was out of job, and was residing separately from his parents. He took the extreme step on Tuesday night, police said. Ram, a resident of Sadullahpur village in Greater Noida, was rushed to the Safdarjung hospital where he was declared dead on Wednesday morning. According to police, they received information about the suicide after the hospital shared the details of Ram with them.

Thieves beat up guard, steal iron scraps of Noida Metro Rail Corporation

NOIDA: The residents welfare association (RWA) of Sector 51 has complained that there have been frequent thefts of iron scrap from the Noida Metro Rail Corporation’s warehouse situated near their sector. The residents claimed that a few people stole iron scraps on Saturday too but fled before police reached. According to the residents, around 10.20pm, the security guard posted at the sector gate saw around five to six men dumping iron scraps at Bal Udyan park in the sector after allegedly stealing it from the NMRC warehouse,

which is adjacent to the park. “After the security guard alerted us, I came out at the gate and saw five-six men loading the iron scrap onto a rickshaw. I gave information about the theft to the police through dial 100 while the security guard along with others went to nab the accused, but only one man could be caught. All others fled the spot at the time, only to return five minutes later in a car. They assaulted the guard and rescued the man who was earlier caught,” said Sanjeev Kumar, RWA general secretary of Sector 51.

जीएसटी में राजस्व वृद्धि के लिए दिया बुनियादी परिवर्तन का सुझाव

गाजियाबाद : कांफेडरेशन ऑफ इंडिया ट्रेडर्स (कैट) व प.उ.प्र. संयुक्त उद्योग व्यापार मंडल ने केंद्रीय वित्त मंत्री पत्र भेजकर जीएसटी में राजस्व वृद्धि के लिए कर प्रणाली में बुनियादी परिवर्तन का सुझाव दिया। इसमें बताया कि अनेक स्तरों पर जीएसटी लगने के बजाय पूरी सप्लाय चेन में केवल तीन स्थानों पर जीएसटी लगाया जाए। सामान लेते समय जीएसटी माल की कीमत उपभोक्ता के बिल में न जोड़ी जाए। इससे खरीदारी के समय उपभोक्ता बिल लेने से नहीं कतराएंगे और सरकार के प्रत्यक्ष एवं अप्रत्यक्ष राजस्व में बढ़ोतरी होगी। पश्चिमी उत्तर प्रदेश संयुक्त

उद्योग व्यापार मंडल के अध्यक्ष घनश्याम दास गर्ग व महामंत्री तिलकराज अरोड़ा ने ने बताया कि वास्तव में सामान्य रूप से उपभोक्ता अलग से टैक्स देने से कतराता है। माल लेते समय कर की दर की अधिकता को देखते हुए व्यापारी से बिल नहीं लेता, जिस कारण बड़ी संख्या में बिक्री रिकार्ड में नहीं है। इससे सरकार राजस्व का मोटा नुकसान झेल रही है। राज्य के अंदर व्यापार करने वाले लोगों द्वारा विभिन्न चरणों में की गई खरीद एवं बिक्री पर वैल्यू एडिशन बेहद नाम मात्र का होता है, जिस कारण सरकार को मात्र एक से दो प्रतिशत राजस्व की हानि होगी।

नामी कंपनी का लोगो लगा जैकेट बना रहा शातिर पुलिस ने पकड़ा

गाजियाबाद : मोदीनगर की गोविंदपुरी स्थित वैशाली एंक्लेव कॉलोनी में नामी कंपनी के लोगो लगाकर जैकेट बनाने वाली फर्जी कंपनी का भंडाफोड हुआ है। पुलिस ने आरोपित से भारी मात्रा में जैकेट, लोगो, सील, रेपर आदि सामान बरामद किया है। कंपनी के प्रतिनिधि ने आरोपित के खिलाफ रिपोर्ट दर्ज कराई है। पुलिस ने आरोपित को हिरासत में ले लिया है। कंपनी के प्रतिनिधि रोबिन, मोहित को पता चला कि गोविंदपुरी स्थित वैशाली एंक्लेव कॉलोनी में उनकी कंपनी के फर्जी लोगो लगाकर जैकेट बनाई जा रही हैं। वे पुलिस टीम को साथ लेकर बताए गए स्थान पर पहुंचे तो वहां उन्हें भारी मात्रा में बनी, अधबनी जैकेट बरामद हुई। जिनपर उनकी कंपनी के नकली लोगो लगे थे।

बंगलुरु की तर्ज पर शहर के नालों पर बनेंगे फुटपाथ

गाजियाबाद : बंगलुरु प्राधिकरण की तर्ज पर जीडीए सड़क किनारे बने नालों के ऊपर फुटपाथ निर्माण की योजना तैयार की है। यह फुटपाथ कामकाजी लोगों के चलने के साथ ही लोगों के लिए सैर के काम भी आएंगे। इससे पैदल यात्रियों के साथ होने वाली दुर्घटनाओं पर अंकुश लगेगा। पहले चरण में नाला निर्माण के लिए इस माह स्थान का सर्वे कराने के साथ ही मार्च में इसके निर्माण का कार्य शुरू कराया जाएगा। कुछ दिन पहले जीडीए अधिकारियों की टीम बंगलुरु गई थी। अधिकारियों ने बंगलुरु विकास प्राधिकरण क्षेत्र में नालों के ऊपर फुटपाथ बने देखे थे। इन फुटपाथों पर ही लोग चलते

हैं और सुबह-शाम सैर करते हैं। इस तकनीक को जीडीए के अधिकारियों ने प्राधिकरण क्षेत्र में तैयार कर अमलीजामा पहनाने की योजना बनाई है। जीडीए की इस योजना के तहत शहर के नालों के ऊपर फुटपाथ तैयार किया जाएगा। ताकि लोग सड़कों पर वाहनों से बचकर इस पर सुरक्षित चल सकें। जीडीए अधिकारियों का कहना है कि शहर के नाले खुले हुए हैं। इससे लगातार दुर्घटनाओं का ग्राफ बढ़ रहा है। साथ ही ज्यादातर सड़कों के बराबर में फुटपाथ नहीं है। इससे पैदल चलने वालों को दिक्कत होती है। कई बार वह दुर्घटनाओं का शिकार होते हैं। लोगों की इस

समस्या को देखते हुए योजना को तैयार किया जा रहा है। पहले चरण में इस योजना को पॉश इलाकों में लागू करने की तैयारी है। इसके बाद पूरे प्राधिकरण क्षेत्र में इसे लागू किया जाएगा। प्राधिकरण की टीम इसी माह सर्वे कर क्षेत्र का चयन करेगी। इसमें इंदिरापुरम, वैशाली, आरडीसी सहित किसी भी पॉश इलाके का चयन किया जाएगा। जीडीए उपाध्यक्ष कंचन वर्मा का कहना है कि जीडीए क्षेत्र के नालों पर फुटपाथ तैयार कराने की योजना है। पहले चरण में इसे किसी एक क्षेत्र में तैयार कराया जाएगा। इसके बाद प्राधिकरण क्षेत्र में योजना को लागू किया जा सकता है।
